Bulldogs Set Sights on WAC Championship

The Fresno State women's golf team heads to the desert to compete in the 22nd annual WAC Championship for a shot at an automatic bid to the NCAA Regional. The tournament is held at the 6,163-yard, par-72 Longbow Golf Club in Mesa, Ariz. for the third year in a row. San Jose State is the three-time defending champion while Idaho's Kayla Mortellaro returns to defend her individual title. Last year, the Bulldogs shot a season-low 290 during the final round to move from last place into third and Shaylee Yano led the 'Dogs with a season-best eighth place finish with an 11-over.

Regular Season a Wrap for 'Dogs

The Fresno State women's golf team wrapped up their 2011-12 regular season with a 13th place finish at the Pacific Coast Intercollegiate in Half Moon Bay, Calif. The Bulldogs shot a season-low 294 during the final round and were led by Madchen Ly's 5-over which put her in a tie for 32nd place.

Uhalde Honored for Stanford Title

Sophomore Christine Uhalde was awarded both the WAC Golfer of the Week and Bulldog Student-Athlete of the week for her performance at the Peg Barnard Invitational in Stanford, Calif. Uhalde tied for the individual title at the tournament hosted by Stanford, her first medalist honor of her collegiate career. She fired a 1-under, 70 during the first round, marking both her lowest round of her career and the only under-par performance on the day. Uhalde finished the two-round tournament at 3-over par (70-75--145).

Madchen Ly (Fr.): (Clovis HS) Won back-to-back CIF Valley Championships in 2009 and 2010, the first player to do so in the event's 15-year history ... defended her title by shooting a 3-under, 70 ... in 2010, won the JGANC Players Championship, Len Ross Fresno City Amateur, Phil Markey Sacramento City Junior Championship and Yosemite Junior Golf Classic ... represented the JGANC in the Mary Cave Cup and a member of the North team for the North vs. South JGANC matches ... California Junior Girls State Championship semifinalist in 2010 ... in 2009, won the Central Section individual tournament by a stroke with a 2-over, 74 ... three-time Tri-River Athletic Conference (TRAC) Most Valuable Player (2008, 2009 and 2010) ... three-time TRAC Player of the Year (2008, 2009 and 2010) ... four-time First-Team All-City (2007-10) ... four-time First-Team All-TRAC (2007-10) ... four-time Southern Section Qualifier (2007-10).

Christine Uhalde (So.): (2010-2011) Competed in six of 11 tournaments, including the WAC Championship ... averaged 78.69 strokes per round ... had her best finish at the WAC Championship where she finished tied for 11th (75-80-71--226) ... shot a low round 71 on the final day of the WAC Championship ... compiled 32 birdies, fourth most on the team.

Louisa Lies (Sr.): (2010-11) Named second-team All-WAC for second year in a row ... competed in 10 out of 11 tournaments ... best finish was third at CU Heather Farr Memorial with rounds of 72-69-81--222 ... recorded four Top 10 finishes ... led the team with a 76.21 scoring average ... lowest round of the team with a 69 at the CU Heather Farr Memorial ... led the team with 70 birdies and a 4.25 Par 4 Scoring average ... named team MVP and Most Inspirational Player ... earned Academic All-WAC. **(2009-10)** Named second-team All-WAC ... competed in all ten tournaments ... won the Dr. Donnis Thompson Invitational in Hawai'i with scores of 66-76-74--216 ... selected the Golf World National Player of the Week after her performance in Hawai'i ... led the team with a 76.31 scoring average ... shot the lowest round on the team with a 66 ... led the team with four rounds of par or better ... named team's Top Dog. **(2008-09)** Competed in seven of the nine tournaments ... came in a tie for second place at the WAC Championships with rounds of 70-73-74--217 ... averaged 76.48 strokes per round ... shot the lowest round on the team with a 70 ... compiled 37 birdies ... first round scoring average was 74.57, which was first on the team by two strokes ... during the summer, beat the No. 1 team in Germany in a match play competition ... Dean's List.

Shaylee Yano (Jr.): (2010-11) Competed in 10 out of the 11 tournaments ... recorded a season-best eighth place finish at the WAC Championship (75-78-71--224) ... compiled a 78.88 scoring average ... shot a low round 71 at the WAC Championship ... had 44 birdies, second-best on the team ... named the team's Top Dog award ... earned Academic All-WAC. **(2009-10)** Competed in five tournaments ... had an average score of 80.33 ... shot a low round of 76 at the Anteater Invitational.

Krysta Clark (So.): (2010-11) Competed in 10 out of 11 tournaments ... best finish was a tie for fourth at the CU Heather Farr Memorial with rounds of 77-77-71 ... averaged 79.19 strokes per round ... posted a low round of 71 at the CU Heather Farr Memorial ... named the team's Bulldog Award ... earned Academic All-WAC.
