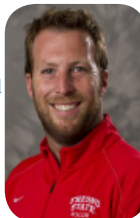
### Fresno State Head Soccer Coach

## Camper Information

### Camp Overview - Field Player

The Bulldog Residential Camp is designed to develop players in the advanced techniques and tactics necessary to excel at the college level. You will be assigned to a group where you will be coached by one of our elite, college-level staff coaches. Your skills will be analyzed and you will be provided with the very best information and practices to help you reach your potential as a player.

Within your group you will learn offensive and defensive techniques and tactics that will serve you no matter what position, and formation, you and your team play. You will also take part in position specific sessions with a coach who specializes in teaching your position. Additionally you will participate in games to practice and refine these new ideas with individual feedback from your staff coach.

### Camp Overview - Goalkeeper

The Bulldog Residential Camp is also a fully incorporated goalkeeper camp. You will be paired with a college-level goalkeeper coach who will work with you personally to develop your game to the very highest level.

You will take part in demanding Goalkeeper only sessions where your techniques will be refined and honed. You will take part in sessions incorporating field players to develop your tactical and leadership skills. Finally, you will take part in 11 a-side games so that you can test out your technical skills in real situations, as well as focusing on the decision-making skills that are paramount in becoming a great goalkeeper.

### SAQ Session

All campers will have the opportunity to learn about and participate in a soccer specific Speed, Agility and Quickness session. This session will demonstrate specific drills and practices that will help your game by improving your ability to get to the ball quickly, change direction quickly, and maintain your speed, balance and control of the ball whilst under pressure.

- Any and all Field Players who are committed to developing their play to the very highest level.
- Goalkeepers who are focused on reaching their potential both technically and tactically.

### Costs:
