

# FLORIDA STATE SEMINOLE FOOTBALL TICKET INFORMATION

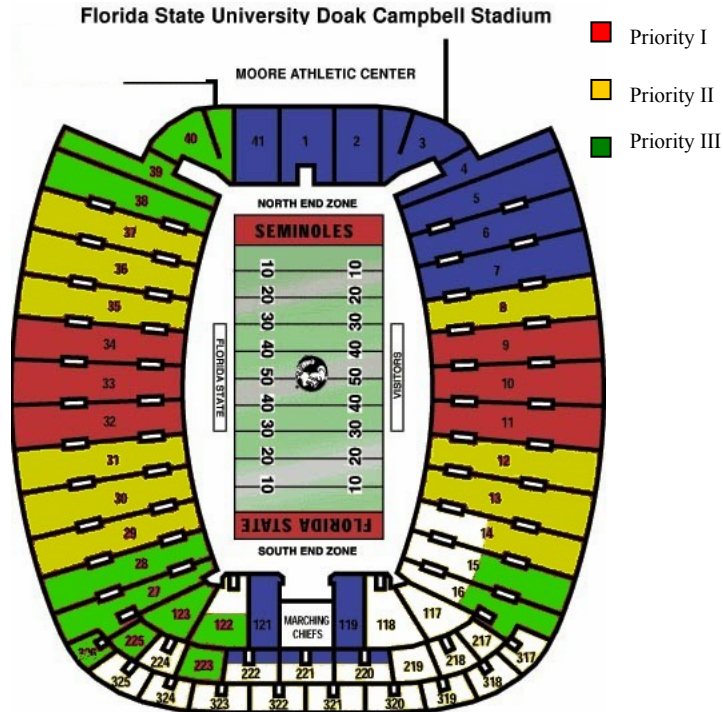
## INFORMATION FOR SEASON TICKET BUYERS

**DEADLINE FOR RENEWING SEASON TICKETS:** To renew your current season seats, your order **MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE April 4<sup>th</sup> DEADLINE.** The Seminole Ticket Office reserves the right to change any seat assignments without prior notice. Conditions that cause changes are: 1.) late orders, 2.) non-compliance with Seminole Booster policy and 3.) extenuating circumstances.

**RENEWABILITY OF SEASON TICKETS:** The following donation scale will determine the maximum number of renewable/priority seats. Please note that your pledge must be made to Seminole Boosters, Inc. by April 4, 2008. The ability to purchase tickets over these limits is subject to the availability of tickets.

**PRIORITY POINTS:** All seating is handled in priority point order from the highest to the lowest. Priority points will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- A. 2007 football season ticket holder: 2 points.
- B. Continuous years as a football season ticket holder: 1 point for each year (10 points max).
- C. Current year Seminole Booster contribution: see contribution scale below.
- D. Continuous years as a Seminole Booster contributor: 1 point for each year (5 points max).
- E. Total Seminole Booster contribution for the previous 5 years: see contribution scale below (Does not include current year contribution).
- F. Florida State University faculty or staff: 2 points.
- G. Varsity letterman: 2 points.
- H. Member of the Florida legislature: 2 points.
- I. Dues-paying member of the FSU Alumni Association: 2 points.
- J. President's Club member: 4 points. (Min \$10,000 gift)

**SEMINOLE BOOSTERS:** All Seminole Booster contributors receive ticket & parking considerations on a priority basis, a year's subscription to REPORT TO BOOSTERS, weekly online Spear Point newsletter, subscription to FLORIDA STATE TIMES, access to booster member online ticket and hotel exchange and a Seminole Booster license plate. Unrestricted contributions are 80% deductible, because all donors accumulate priority points. All restricted contributions continue to be 100% tax deductible. Pledge opportunities with payment schedules are available.

**PLACING YOUR TICKET ORDER:** For priority consideration, place your season ticket order by April 4, 2008. You may order your season tickets and single-game tickets online at [seminoles.com](http://seminoles.com) or through the mail. *We will not accept season ticket orders by phone or fax.*

**SEAT IMPROVEMENT REQUESTS:** In general, it is very difficult to improve season ticket locations, as the season ticket turnover rate is usually very low. To be considered for seat improvement you must include a request in writing along with your season ticket order. All renewing season ticket orders, in compliance, are placed in their previous year's seats before any seat improvement requests are considered. Requests for seat improvement and new season tickets are handled in priority point order. When priority seats do become available, first consideration will be given to qualifying ticket holders with seats outside their priority area. They will be allowed to purchase up to four (4) season tickets in the priority section before ticket holders who already have seats in the priority section may add additional seats.

**NEW AND/OR ADDITIONAL SEASON TICKETS:** The only ticket orders that can be guaranteed are season ticket renewals received on or before the deadline, which are in compliance with Florida State priority seating guidelines. The number of new and/or additional season tickets available cannot be determined until after the end of the renewal period. All ticket orders are subject to availability. Deposit of your payment is not a guarantee that tickets are available to fill your order. In the event that demand exceeds the supply, we reserve the right to establish order limits based upon the renewal policy and contribution levels. Refunds will be made for the portion of the order not filled.

**ADDING SEASON TICKETS:** You may add to your season ticket order by indicating your additional purchase in the "Additional Orders" portion of your order application and enclosing the appropriate payment. You may order as many tickets as you like; however, all orders are subject to availability. Should additional tickets be available, it is unlikely that your additional seats can be placed next to your existing seats. We will not move your existing seats unless you tell us that all of your seats must be together. Please be advised that in order to get all of your seats together it may be necessary to sacrifice location.

**SEATING PROCESS:** After the renewal deadline, all renewing season ticket holders are placed in their previous year's seats. Then all requests for seat improvements and orders for new or additional season tickets are reviewed in priority point order. All requests will be reviewed but due to the volume of orders, personal consultation is not feasible. The Seminole Ticket Office will make every effort to assign seats as requested. Seating decisions are based upon the best judgment of the ticket office staff. By placing your order with the Seminole Ticket Office, you indicate that you accept our distribution of tickets.

## INFORMATION FOR SINGLE-GAME TICKET BUYERS

**ORDERING PROCEDURE:** Orders may be placed for most Florida State home and away games. The only exception is the home game versus University of Florida. There are no single-game tickets available for this game. It is available only as part of the full season ticket package. Requests without payment are being accepted for home games versus VA Tech and Clemson as well as away games at Miami and at GA Tech. You may request as many tickets as you wish for these games. Once we have made a determination of which orders can be accommodated and what order limits (if any) are necessary, we will bill you accordingly. Determinations on these games will be made in July. At that time, bills will be mailed to those customers whose orders we can accommodate. Those whose orders we cannot accommodate will be notified at that time. We do not anticipate having single-game tickets available for the Florida home game.

The Florida State Seminoles will take on Colorado in the River City Showdown on Saturday, September 27<sup>th</sup> in Jacksonville, Florida at Jacksonville Municipal Stadium. Tickets for this game will be sold through the Seminole Ticket Office.

Ticket prices and locations for this game are as follows:

Club Level (sideline between 20-yard lines w/ club amenities)	\$75
Lower Level Prime (sideline from 20-yard lines to back of endzones)	\$50
Champion's Club (lower level South endzone with access to Budzone)	\$50
Lower Level Endzone (lower level North endzone)	\$40

The Seminole Ticket Office is taking requests without payment for all price levels for this game. If necessary, limits will be determined based on the FSU Ticket Priority Policy and bills will be mailed in July.

**SINGLE-GAME SEATING:** The availability of home single-game tickets is based upon the number of tickets requested by the visiting team. Single-game tickets are available only in the areas held for visiting teams. For away games, the location of the allotment available to Florida State is determined by the host team. Single-game ticket orders are based upon: 1.) the buyer's priority point total and 2.) date received. The assignment of single-game tickets could begin as soon as July 1. Single-game tickets cannot be seated with season tickets.

**YOUTH TICKETS:** Youth tickets are available for advance purchase to the Florida State home games with Western Carolina, UT-Chattanooga, Wake Forest and Boston College. These tickets may only be used by persons 18 and under. Youth tickets cannot be seated with season tickets.
