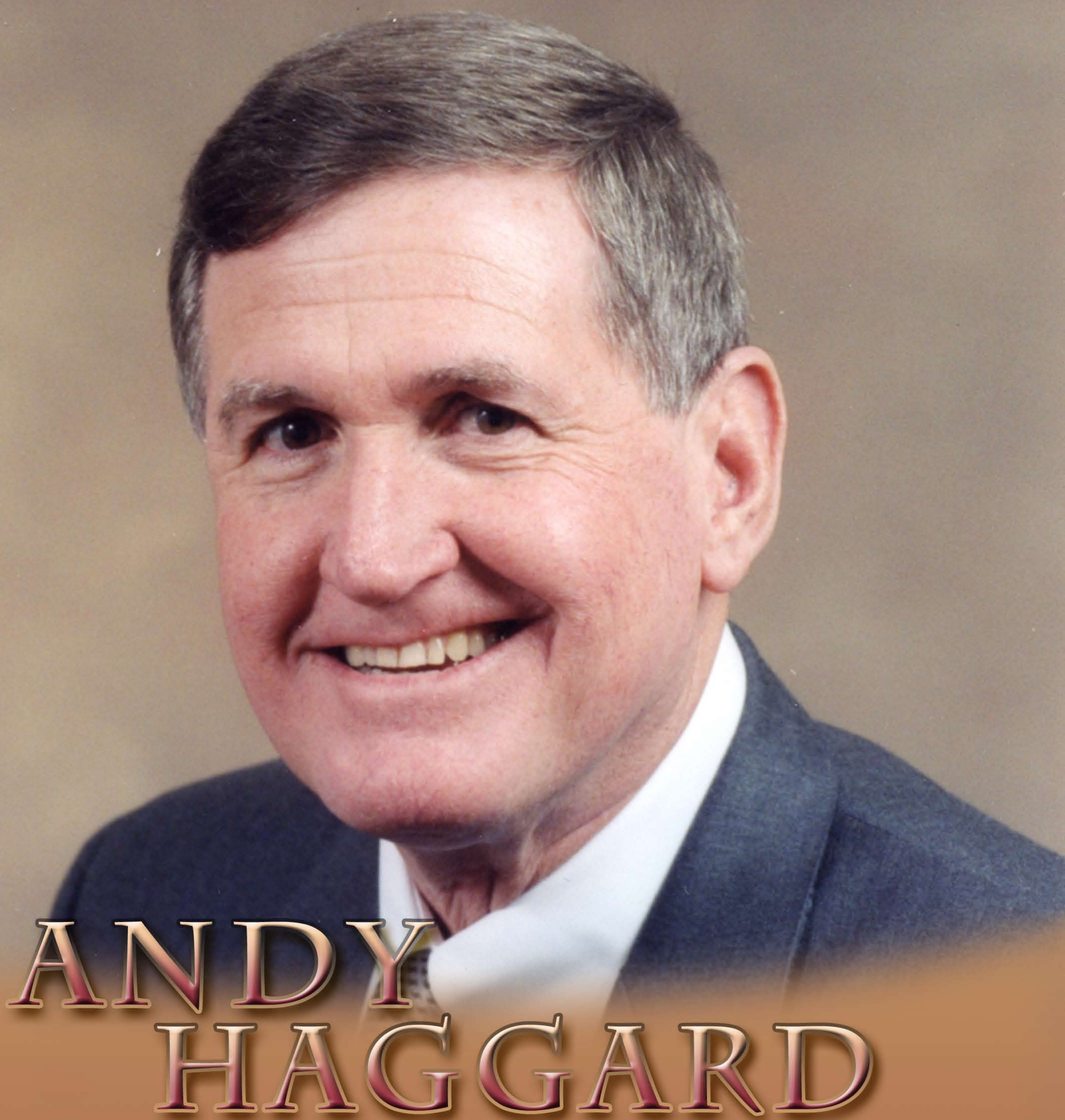


MOORE-STONE AWARD RECIPIENT



Andy Haggard, '64, epitomizes dedication and generosity to his alma mater. Now serving his second term as a member of the Florida State Board of Trustees, he has accepted leadership roles throughout the university. A nationally recognized trial lawyer, he was instrumental in Florida State's successful battle to retain the Seminole name in honor of the unconquered spirit of the Seminole Tribe of Florida.

In 1998, Andy served as the national chairman of the Board of the Florida State University Seminole Boosters. He has served as chairman of the Florida State University College of Arts & Sciences Leadership Counsel as well as a member of the Board of Directors of the FSU Foundation. In 1993 he was a member of the Presidential Search Committee, and he is currently serving on the university's external component of the Strategic Planning Committee.

He and his wife Carole are long-time Golden Chief Booster supporters and generous contributors to the Florida State University Foundation and Endowed Scholarship fund. They have been honored as members of "The '77 Club" of the Seminole Club of Miami.

Andy's leadership efforts were recognized in 2004, when he was presented with the prestigious FSU Alumni Associations "Circle of Gold" award. His love for Florida State's athletic program extends beyond football, leading to his service as chairman of the FSU Baseball Stadium Restoration Committee.
