UNETHICAL CONDUCT (NCAA Bylaw 10.1): Unethical conduct by a prospective or enrolled student-athlete or a current or former institutional staff member may include but is not limited to:

- a. Refusal to furnish information relevant to an NCAA investigation;
- b. Knowing involvement in arranging for fraudulent academic credit or false transcripts;
- c. Knowing involvement in offering or providing a student-athlete an improper inducement or extra benefit or improper financial aid;
- d. Knowingly furnish the NCAA or FSU false or misleading information concerning involvement or knowledge of matters relevant to an NCAA regulation;
- e. Receipt of benefits by an institutional staff member for facilitating or arranging a meeting between a student-athlete and an agent or financial advisor.
