## **Community Service Highlights**

- The Department won the National Consortium for Academics and Sports award at their annual conference for the most successful outreach and community service program for the 2005-06 academic year
- Student-Athletes completed more than 5300 hours of community service this year – the most ever for a single year
- Women's golf won the coveted Athletics Directors Cup for Service, performing more than 60 hours per person over the course of the year
- 8 teams completed over 200 hours, with 4 teams performing over 330 hours
- Football, Softball, Women's basketball, Volleyball, Track and field, and Cross Country all participated in the Special Olympics 1K and 5K Fundraising Run/Walk (1/27)
