Seminole Quick Hits

* Florida State returns five position starters and five pitchers who saw action off the mound in 2007 including a pair of starting pitchers in senior Ryan Strauss and junior Bo O'Dell. In all, the Seminoles welcome back 13 of 31 letterwinners for the upcoming season.

* The Seminoles return three of their top four hitters from last year's squad that recorded the highest team batting average in school history with a .350 mark. Buster Posey, Jack Rye and Jason Stidham ranked two, three, four, respectively, in hitting last year.

* FSU's 2008 recruiting class, which was ranked No. 2 by Collegiate Baseball, feature 17 newcomers including 14 freshmen. Also joining the Seminoles this season is a trio of transfers in Tony Delmonico (Tennessee), Elih Villanueva (Miami-Dade Community College) and Ben Francis (Gulf Coast Community College).

* Florida State enters the season looking to build off last year's 24-6 league mark and its first ACC Atlantic Division title. The Seminoles have averaged just over 50 wins since 2000 and will chase their 31st consecutive NCAA Regional appearance in 2008, the second longest streak in the nation.

* The Seminoles will start the season ranked 12th by Collegiate Baseball and USA Today/ESPN Coaches' Poll and 13th by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. Buster Posey and Jack Rye were named Preseason All-Americans.

* Buster Posey and Jack Rye were named to the preseason watch list for the Golden Spikes Award, while Posey joined Ryan Strauss and Jason Stidham on the preseason watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award.

Opening Day

FSU has lost the first game of the season only seven times in 60 years and only two of those losses have come in Tallahassee. The Seminoles have posted a mark of 52-7-1 (.875) on opening day. In 1998, the Garnet and Gold lost to Notre Dame at a neutral site marking the last time FSU has dropped its season opener. The last time FSU lost a season opener at home was 1981 when Georgia Southern defeated the Seminoles 3-2. March 20, 1958 stands as the only other time FSU opened a season at home with loss falling to Auburn as the Tigers swept the doubleheader (4-3, 10-7). When it comes to home openers all-time, Florida State is 56-4 (.933) with only one loss coming in the last 26 years. Under Hall of Fame coach Mike Martin, FSU baseball is 25-3 on opening day.

First Series of the Season

In 60 years of FSU baseball, the Seminoles have only lost a season opening series twice. The last time the Seminoles lost a series to open the season came in 1981 when Georgia Southern took two of three games from Florida State. The only other time the Garnet & Gold lost a series to open the season came in 1958 when Auburn took both games of a two-game set. Overall, FSU is 49-2-9 in season opening series.

Florida State vs. Duquesne

Florida State and Duquesne will square-off for the first time in school history as the Dukes visit Tallahassee for a three-game set to kick-off the 2008 campaign for both teams. The Seminoles own a record of 171-44 when facing a team for the first time. Duquesne marks the eighth team from the Atlantic 10 that FSU has faced during its 61-year history of the program. The Seminoles have posted an all-time record of 41-1 against the Atlantic 10 with their lone loss coming against St. Louis at the College World Series in 1965. Florida State has faced Charlotte (2-0), Dayton (1-0), George Washington (2-0), Richmond (20-0), St. Bonaventure (1-0), St. Joseph's (14-0) and St. Louis (1-1).

ACC Preseason Poll

Despite losing 18 letterwinners including four position starters and two starting pitchers, the Florida State Seminoles were selected to repeat as Atlantic Coast Conference Atlantic Division Champions in 2007 as determined by a vote of the league's 12 head coaches. Defending ACC champion North Carolina was picked to repeat as the league champion in 2008 as well as capture its third straight Coastal Division crown. Florida State garnered 66 points including seven first place votes. The Seminoles also received two votes to capture the ACC Championship which will be held at the Baseball Grounds in Jacksonville, Fla. The tournament will be played in a round-robin format for the second year in a row May 21-25.

NEW LOOK INFIELD

As the Seminoles take the field Friday on opening day against Duquesne, two things will remain the same from opening day 2007 - Buster Posey will suit up as the Seminole catcher and Tony Delmonico will be starting at shortstop. This time around Delmonico will be sporting the Garnet & Gold as opposed to the Orange & Black of Tennessee. The Volunteers visited Tallahassee last year to open the 2007 season for both teams. The rest of the infield may look different but it will have a familiar twist. Senior Dennis Guinn returns to first base after starting 59 games at that position as a sophomore. Jason Stidham moves from third to second, while freshman Stuart Tapley will get the starting nod at third. Stidham made 61 starts at third en routing to earning Freshman All-American accolades in 2007. Delmonico is coming off an impressive sophomore campaign at Tennessee where he played both second

base and shortstop last year.

Last year, Florida State's starting infield of Posey (catcher), Brandon Reichert (first base), Tony Thomas, Jr. (second base), Mark Hallberg (shortstop) and Stidham (third base) combined to post a .978 fielding percentage. Four of those five Seminoles started all 62 games. Posey committed the fewest errors with three in his first season behind the plate.

16 Away From 1500

Florida State's Mike Martin is approaching yet another milestone as he enters his 29th season as head coach of the Seminole baseball program. The Hall of Fame coach needs just 16 victories to become the third Division I coach to reach 1,500 career victories joining Texas' Augie Garrido (1,629) and Wichita State's Gene Stephenson (1,605). Martin owns a career record of 1,484-506-4 good for an all-time winning percentage of .745 which ranks third in the NCAA among active Division I coaches.

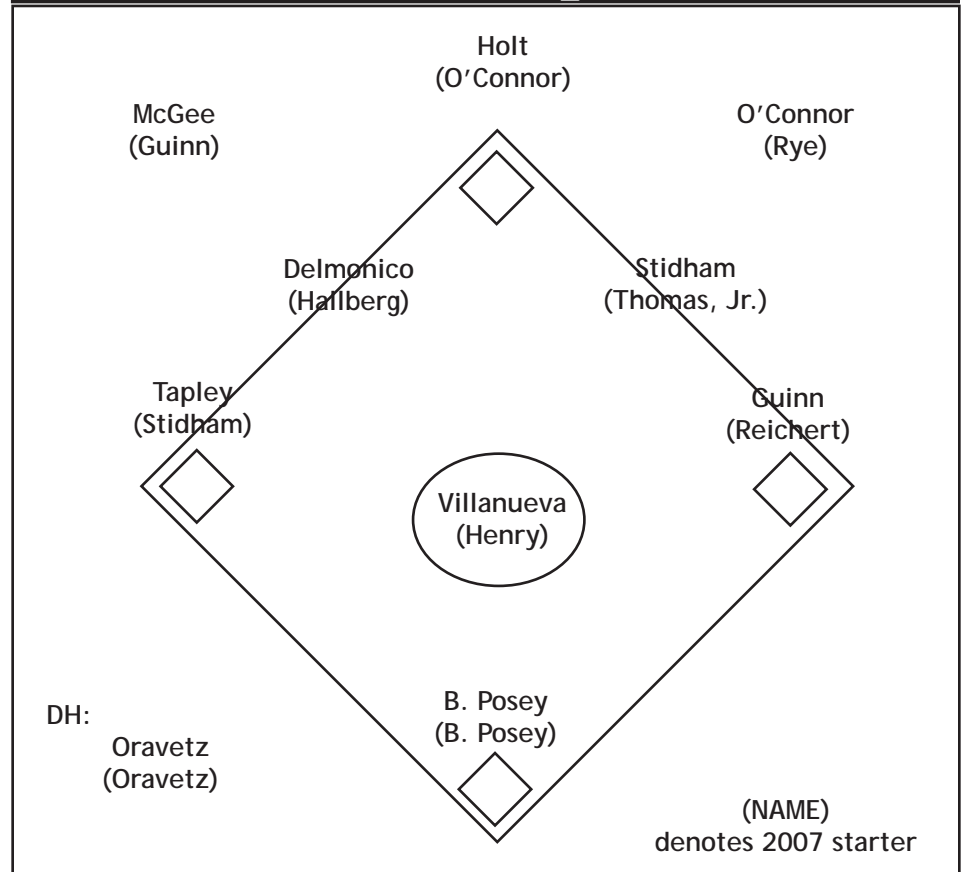
Early Recognition

The preseason accolades have poured in for the Seminoles in 2008. Junior Buster Posey and senior Jack Rye most recently were named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List for National Player of the Year. Since the inception of the Golden Spikes Award back in 1978, a Florida State student-athlete has received the award three times as Mike Fuentes (1981), Mike Loynd (1986) and J.D. Drew (1997) have all won the award. No school in America has produced more winners of this prestigious award than Florida State.

Posey has also received first team All-America honors by Collegiate Baseball, Baseball America and Rivals.com, while earning third team recognition from the NCBWA. Rye has been honored as a second team All-American by Collegiate Baseball and Rivals.com. Posey joins senior Ryan Strauss and sophomore Jason Stidham as a watch list member for the Brooks Wallace Award - an honor given to the nation's top collegiate player.

Florida State will start the season ranked in the top 25 of four major polls. The Seminoles received their highest ranking of 12 by Collegiate Baseball and the USA Today/ESPN Coaches Poll. FSU sits 13th in the NCBWA preseason poll and 21st by Rivals.com.

Florida State Pitching Probables

Friday - Junior Elih Villanueva gets the nod as the Seminoles opening day pitcher on Friday against Duquesne. Villanueva spent his sophomore season at Miami-Dade Community College where he helped Miami-Dade win the Southern Conference championship. The right hander from Miami, Fla., posted a 0.81 ERA last season striking out 109 batters in 89 innings of work. Villanueva began his collegiate career at Florida International where he compiled a 7-3 record as a freshman striking out 79 batters in 101.2 innings of work.

Saturday - Matt Fairel will make his first career start in his second season at Florida State. The sophomore south paw was a staple in the Seminole bullpen last year posting a 2.94 ERA in 21 appearances. Fairel worked 33.2 innings registering 26 strikeouts while holding opponents to a .219 average. Fairel closed out his freshman campaign setting career-highs for innings pitched (4.2), hits allowed (8) and strikeouts (6) against Mississippi State in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional.

Sunday - Freshman Mike McGee will make his collegiate debut on the mound on Sunday against the Dukes. McGee will see time as a two-way player in 2008 as the freshman right hander will also see playing time in the Seminole outfield. As a pitcher, McGee posted a 7-4 record with a 1.27 ERA as a junior at Port St. Lucie High School, the same school that produced current major league standout, St. Louis outfielder Rick Ankiel.

Florida State Hit Streaks

It's hard enough for a student-athlete to adjust to a new environment after transferring in from another school. You have to get used to the campus and where everything is as well as adapt to your new teammates. Having lived in Tallahassee before, Seminole starting short-stop Tony Delmonico has found the transition to be an easy one. What might be more challenging is for Delmonico to pickup where he left off following his sophomore year at Tennessee. Delmonico carries a career-high 12-game hitting streak into the Seminoles season opener against Duquesne. During the streak, Delmonico closed out the year batting .451 collecting 23 hits in 51 at-bats. He registered 19 RBIs, 14 runs, six doubles and five home runs. Other Seminoles who will open the season on a hitting streak include Jason Stidham (2 games), Jack Rye (1 game) and Stephen Cardullo (1 game).

Rye On The Mend

The Seminoles will be without the services of senior outfielder Jack Rye for at least the first two weeks of the season as Rye suffered a broken right thumb during preseason practice. The Irvine, Calif., native has started 183 games in a Seminole uniform posting a career batting average of .348. Rye is the Seminoles leading home run hitter as he hit 10 a season ago.

2008 Schedule

Eleven teams on this year's schedule recorded 30 or more wins a season ago. Eight schools earned a bid to participate in an NCAA Regional in 2007, while three teams finished last year ranked in the top 25. For the second time in as many seasons, the Seminoles will travel to Clearwater, Fla., to face the Philadelphia Phillies on Tuesday, February 26. Last year 4,676 fans packed Bright House Networks Field for the exhibition contest.

Seminole Leadership

Florida State's five returning position starters, including Buster Posey, Jack Rye, Jason Stidham, Dennis Guinn and Ruairi O'Connor, have combined to play in 590 games. Last year, those returning Seminoles combined to hit .352 on 340 hits in 967 at-bats. Five hurlers enter the 2008 season with a combined 244 innings of work while senior Ryan Strauss has the most starts under his belt with 16, all coming a season ago. Jimmy Marshall is the top returning reliever for the Seminoles as he posted a 2-0 record and a 1.39 ERA last year.

'08 Class Highly Ranked

The Seminoles were recognized by Collegiate Baseball with the nation's second best recruiting class in 2007. Since associate head coach Jamey Shouppe took over recruiting coordinator duties in 1990, FSU has had a class ranked in the top 25 each year while 12 of his 17 classes have been ranked in the top 10. Four freshmen were selected in the MLB Draft but opted to postpone their major league career and attend college. Those individuals include John Gast, Taiwan Easterling, Mike McGee and Mark Peterson.
