DUTCH NATIONAL TEAM – Spent the latter part of the summer of 2005 and parts of the fall playing with the Dutch National Team as they prepared for World Cup qualifying...was called into national team camp in February held in Gran Canary Island...competed against Japan with the Dutch National team prior to the 2004 Summer Olympics...has nine caps with the full national team...33 caps, and 10 goals with the U-19 national team...named MVP versus Spain in a European Championship match played in 2003...was a member of the Dutch National Team that participated in the UEFA European Women's U-19 Championship in 2003...helped lead the Netherlands past Spain in the Dutch's first ever match in a final tournament at the UEFA European Women's U-19 Championship...also recorded caps with the U-17 national side.

U.S. NATIONAL TEAM – Was called in to play with the U-21 National Team in the summer of 2007...member of the U.S. U-20 Women's National Team...missed the first three games of the 2006 season while competing in the FIFA U-20 World Championships in Russia...appeared in 15 games and made 12 starts for the U-20's in 2006...only four players have started more games than Wagenfuhr that year...has three goals and two assists playing on the backline for the national side...has started three of the team's five international matches...only two players have played more minutes in international play in 2006 than Wagenfuhr...both of her assists have come in those three internationals...scored two goals in a friendly versus a German U-21 Regional Team and added her third goal in a friendly versus Vanderbilt University...recorded an assist versus El Salvador in the quarterfinals of the CONCACAF qualifying tournament...notched the game-winning assist in the U.S.'s 4-1 opening win over Jamaica in the CONCACAF qualifying tournament...invited to U-17 National Team camp in 2004.
