Coach has compiled an amazing record in her tenure as Head Softball Coach at Florida State University. In 30 seasons, she has compiled a record of 1,399-450-6, which ranks first in all time wins amongst Div. I Softball Coaches. Graf has been named ACC Coach of the Year numerous times and Regional Coaching Staff of the Year in 2001, 2002 & 2004. The Lady Noles have won ten ACC Championships. Under Coach Graf, Florida State has been to the NCAA College Worlds Series seven times and finished 3rd in 2002 and 1990. Graf continues to be one of the leaders in the sport, encouraging her players to succeed on and off the playing field. Her summer camps are renowned for their advanced approach and the strength of her camp staff. She was inducted into the NFCA Hall of Fame in December 2003.



Louie Berndt Camp Coordinator

In her 24th season coaching Div. I Softball, Berndt has the Lady Noles swinging their way back to the top 10. Working primarily with the hitters the Noles have increased their batting averages in the past seven seasons. Prior to Florida State, Louie spent 6 years as the Head Coach building a program at Marshall University. She was an assistant coach at Ohio State, Florida State and Nicholls State. A graduate of Western Michigan and a two-time All-American, Berndt led the Broncos to World Series appearances three times and was the team leader in hitting for three straight seasons and ended with a career .321 batting average. She was inducted into Western Michigan's Hall of Fame in November 2003.



Barb Sherwood Pitching Coordinator

The four year letter winner, starting catcher and team captain for three years at Troy State University is glad to be back in the sunshine state. Barb began her coaching career at Troy University in 1998 after graduation. While at Troy, Barb recruited three All-Region athletes, including Jocelyn McCallum of Australia. McCallum was named the Atlantic Sun Pitcher of the Year for the 2005-06 Season and holds the single season strikeout record at Troy. In 2005 Barb went to University of Wisconsin as their pitching and catching coach. While there, Wisconsin's pitching staff ERA was ranked No. 4 in the Big Ten for the 2007 season.

Other Staff

One of the signature items of JoAnne Graf's camps are the individuals that make up the camp staff. This years staff includes collegiate coaches from Div. I, Div. II, NJCC, NAIA, and high school coaches from all over the United States. Come and enjoy the excitement, enthusiasm and the knowledge that these coaches bring.

Camp Dates, Ages and Fees

SESSION I JUNE 9-12 *Fastpitch*

The second session is for sophomores, juniors and seniors in high school. This session is designed to teach and push the camper at a faster pace and gear them towards the college level. A recruiting seminar with a FSU Compliance Director is included.

This session is designed to teach campers the basic mechanics of pitching and catching, along with advanced techniques for the more experienced player.

Registration will be on Tuesday, June 17, at Seminole Oaks between 9:00-10:45 a.m. First session will begin at 12:00 p.m. at the FSU Softball Field. Camp will be completed on Wednesday, June 19, at 5:00 p.m. The times for this session will be 9:00-11:30 a.m. and 2:00-5:00 p.m. We will eat and swim at Seminole Oaks during the break. This is a day camp, however, campers may register to spend the two nights at Seminole Oaks.

Location and Facilities

The camps are held on the campus of Florida State University, in the heart of Tallahassee. All sessions will be held at athletic facilities on the campus at FSU and Messer Park. Camp headquarters will be at the new state of the art softball stadium.

Lodging and Meals

Resident Campers will stay at Seminole Oaks, a modern air conditioned facility. This is a self-contained dorm so the campers do not ever leave the dorm. Camp coaches and Seminole Oaks Staff, live in the dorm during camp and are available for campers. Seminole Oaks also provides a 24 hour front desk and nighttime security in order to ensure camper comfort. **Room assignments will be assigned at random, unless otherwise noted on the registration form in the roommate preference area.** All you can eat meals will be served buffet style while in the dorm. Campers also have use of the video games, pool tables and supervised time at the pool.

Day Campers may purchase meal cards at registration for Sessions I & II for a cost of \$60.00. Session III day campers will cost \$5.00 for a meal.
