ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

DANIELLE HEPBURN, MB, CLEMSON



Clemson middle blocker Danielle Hepburn was announced today as the Atlantic Coast Conference Volleyball Player of the Week, earning the league distinction for the third time this season.

Over the past week, Hepburn put up some of her best numbers of the year in two big matches against conference opponents Wake Forest and No. 14 Duke. Versus the Demon Deacons, the junior from Miami, Fla., posted 12 kills with only one error for a .440 hitting percentage with six total blocks. Against the Blue Devils, she slammed 24 kills and zero errors in 46 attempts as the Tigers defeated Duke for the second time this season. In the two matches, Hepburn averaged 5.14 kills per game with a .479 hitting percentage, 0.71 digs per game and 1.86 blocks per game, as Clemson pushed their overall record to 24-3 with two more ACC wins.

In the coming week, Hepburn and the Tigers will look to regain their place in the nation's top 25 with matchups against league foes Miami and Florida State. Clemson will host the Hurricanes Thursday night at 7:00 p.m., and then will take on the Seminoles at 7:00 p.m. on Friday evening.

On the season's opening weekend, senior setter Ali Hausfeld led the Blue Devils to three wins in three matches, including an upset win over No. 13 Purdue, on their way to the title in the Duke Invitational. In the tournament final, Hausfeld 61 assists and 14 digs to go along with three kills and three total blocks. For the weekend, she averaged 14.36 assists per game and 3.27 digs per game. For her play, she was named National Player of the Week by CVU.com.

In the second week of October, Virginia senior Sarah Kirkwood had perhaps her best two-match performance of her career in contests against ACC foes Boston College and Maryland. In the two matches, she posted 46 kills on just 76 attempts for a .575 weekend hitting percentage. Kirkwood hit for only five errors in the two showings, garnering National Player of the Week recognition from CVU.com on October 10.

Carrie DeMange, a senior middle blocker for the Duke Blue Devils, was recognized as National Player of the Week by both the AVCA and the ECAC during the week of October 22-26. In two matches the prior weekend, the Springboro, Ohio, native averaged 5.62 kills per game with a hitting percentage of .381 to go along with 4.75 digs per game and 1.50 blocks per game as the Blue Devils notched two valuable conference wins.
