FURMAN VS. APPALACHIAN STATE SERIES (ASU leads 36-27)

► Saturday's game will mark the 64th meeting between the Paladins and Mountaineers in a series that began during the 1971-72 season and which ASU leads 36-27. The Mountaineers and Paladins split the season series with Furman winning in Boone, 73-56, and ASU claiming a 58-53 decision in Greenville. Appalachian State sports a 6-1 SoCon Tournament record against Furman, including last year's 63-60 first round triumph in Chattanooga. **In Greenville:** Furman leads 15-13. **In Boone:** Appalachian State leads 17-11. **SoCon Tourney:** Appalachian State leads 6-1.

NOTING THE FURMAN PALADINS

FURMAN SOCON TOURNAMENT HISTORY...Since its first Southern Conference Tournament in 1984, Furman has compiled a 22-24 record in league tournament action, including two championships (1995 & '00) — both under former head coach Sherry Carter. The Paladins' defeated East Tennessee State, 88-85, in Asheville, N.C., to win the 1995 SoCon Tournament title and dethroned UNC Greensboro, 68-49, in Greenville to claim its 2000 SoCon Tournament crown. Furman has also made five other SoCon Tournament championship game appearances (1989, '90, '92, '93, and '94). Under current head coach Sam Dixon, the Paladins have compiled a 5-7 mark.

SENIOR SALUTE...The 2009-10 season marks the final campaign for four senior Paladins: guard **Kali Holtfreter** (Hendersonville, Tenn.), center **Mollie Petersen** (Asheville, N.C.), guard **Lee Stephens** (Cincinnati, Ohio), and center **Susan Troutman** (Greenville, S.C.) — all of whom will graduate this May. Holtfreter, who is majoring in business administration,

has accepted a sales and marketing position with Proctor & Gamble beginning in June. Petersen, a physics major with concentration in environmental studies, plans to study in Costa Rica immediately following graduation and will work with either the Student Conservation Corps or AmeriCorps next year before beginning graduate work in environmental studies. A double major in accounting and Spanish, Stephens is set to begin her professional career as an auditor with Ernst & Young and pursue a master's degree in accounting at Notre Dame. Troutman is majoring in psychology.

FURMAN SNAPS 10-GAME SKID... Getting a game high 23 points from Lee Stephens, Furman used a sustained second half comeback to erase a 15-point deficit en route to a 73-67 win over Davidson in SoCon Tournament first round action on Thursday. The Paladins, who trailed 51-36 with 15 minutes remaining, outscored the Wildcats 29-14 over the next 15 minutes to tie the game at 65-65 with three minutes to go. The victory snapped a 10-game losing skid and marked the Paladins' first win since Jan. 19 (vs. UNC Greensboro). The 10-game skid was the longest by Furman since the early 1980s when the Paladins lost 10 straight, nine of which came at the end of the 1980-81 campaign, plus the 1981-82 season opener. Furman's 23 losses this year are the most in program history.

A LOOK BACK... Furman split its two-game series with Appalachian State this year, winning 73-56 in Boone on Dec. 21 and dropping a 58-53 verdict in Greenville on Feb. 1.

Game 1 (Dec. 21: Furman 73, Appalachian State 56): Furman capitalized on 34 Appalachian State turnovers and got 14 points from Raegan Thompson and 13 points from Kali Holtfreter en route to a 73-56 thumping of the Mountaineers in Boone. Kaitlin Murphy and Kendra Berry chipped in 12 points each for Furman, and Lee Stephens finished with nine points along with Lakyn Ledford. Appalachian State was paced by Ashlen Dewart's 16 points. Furman out-shot Appalachian State, connecting on 24-of-55 field goal attempts (43.6%) to the Mountaineers' 24-for-62 (38.7%). In addition, the Paladins forged a big advantage at the free throw line, draining 20-of-30 attempts to Appalachian State's 7-of-14. The Paladins took control of the contest on the strength of an 18-0 first half run. Trailing 21-18 with just under eight minutes to go, Kali Holtfreter delivered a 3-pointer to ignite the run that would see the senior guard tally 10 of 18 points on the way to a 36-21 advantage following her own layup 58 seconds before intermission. Appalachian State opened the second half with back-to-back baskets to cut the Furman advantage to 38-29, but the Paladins responded with a 9-0 burst, highlighted by a Thompson 3-pointer, to push the margin to 47-29 at the 15:24 mark and cruised to the win.

Game 2 (Feb. 1: Appalachian State 58, Furman 53): Sam Ramirez scored 16 points and keyed a late surge by Appalachian State that clipped Furman, 58-53, in Greenville. With the Mountaineers trailing 53-49, Ramirez drained a 3-pointer from the left wing with a minute left in the game to help Appalachian State finish the contest on a 9-0 run to secure the victory. After Ramirez's bucket, ASU's Kelsey Sharkey stole the ball on Furman's ensuing possession and converted a layup to give the Mountaineers a 54-53 lead with 53 seconds remaining. After another Paladin turnover, Ramirez drew a foul and drained a pair of free throws with 29 seconds to go to stretch the advantage to 56-53. Anna Freeman added two more free throws with nine seconds remaining to complete the decisive run. Furman scored its final points with 2:43 to go on a jump shot by Kendra Berry for a 53-49 lead, but the Paladins went scoreless the rest of the way, missing five shots and turning the ball over twice in their final seven possessions. Lee Stephens paced Furman with 16 points.

STEPHENS ON FURMAN CAREER LEDGERS... Lee Stephens' 19-point performance in Furman's 69-56 loss at Chattanooga on Dec. 5 put her over 1,000 points, thus making her the 18th player in Furman history to top the 1,000-point plateau. Heading into Saturday's SoCon Tournament clash against Appalachian State, she now has 1,257 points in her career, which ranks ninth in program history. She also ranks eighth all-time in steals (212), second in 3-pointers made (165), ninth in 3-point field goal percentage (36.1%), and fourth in free throw percentage (83.1%)

FRESHMAN IMPACT... Furman sports a pair of solid freshmen contributors in forward Lakyn Ledford and guard Raegan Thompson, who have combined to average 15.8 points and 8.9 rebounds per game this year. Ledford (8.3 ppg, team leading 5.0 rpg) has connected on 50.3 percent of her field goal attempts and recorded 13 double figure scoring performances in 26 starts this year, including a season high 22-point outing versus Mercer. Thompson (7.5 ppg, 3.9 rpg), meanwhile, has logged 15 starts and owns a season high 22-point scoring effort vs. Wofford in Greenville.
