



# 1 Kentavious Caldwell-Pope

Guard, 6-5, 205, So., Greenville, Ga. (Greenville HS)

## 2012-13 Season

- 2013 SEC Player of the Year, as selected by SEC coaches, as well as Associated Press. Also a member of the each's All-SEC 1st team. The first Bulldog since Dominique Wilkins (1981, also as a soph.) to sweep the major POY awards.
- Georgia's leading scorer in 29 of 32 games; its leading rebounder in 16 contests.
- One of just nine players in all of NCAA Division I to score in double figures in each of his team's games.
- Ranked among the SEC leaders in nine of the 13 categories for which individual stats were kept.
- Recorded consecutive double-doubles in December after playing 39 collegiate games without one. Finished the season with seven double-doubles.
- Scored 19 of his 25 points vs. Southern California in the 2nd half, 12 in the first five minutes of the half.
- Had the 2nd-highest scoring sophomore season in UGA history; 9th-best rebounding season for UGA soph.
- Career scoring high of 32 points came in season finale vs. LSU; scored 25 in the second half as Georgia nearly overcame a 20-point halftime deficit. Also in the LSU game, he became the 43rd player in UGA history to surpass 1,000 career points.
- Elevated his play in clutch situations. Scored 31 percent of his 332 points in SEC games during the last five minutes, shooting 65 percent from the field, 63 percent from 3-point range and 83 percent from the FT line.
- Coaches' Pre-Season All-SEC Pick by the league's 14 coaches. SEC Player of the Week on Feb. 5 after leading Georgia to consecutive wins.

## 2011-12 Season

- Named to the Coaches' Freshman All-SEC Team.
- Led the team in minutes, rebounds and steals throughout the season; also its No. 2 scorer.
- Earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors Dec. 19 after scoring a game-high 21 pts. in win at USC.
- Season-high 25 points vs. Ole Miss were the most by a UGA freshman in almost 13 years; his final scoring total of 422 points were also the fifth most by a UGA freshman ever.
- Hit go-ahead 3-pointers in the final minute in both of Georgia's road wins in 2012: at Southern Cal and Miss.State.

## Prep Highlights

- The first McDonald's All-America honoree to sign with UGA in 20 years.
- Rated the nation's No. 3 shooting guard prospect, the No. 12 prospect overall, by recruiting analysts for Rivals.com. Also awarded the same rankings by Scout.com recruiting evaluators.
- Averaged 31 points and 8.2 rebounds per game as a senior at Greenville High School.
