MATCH #2 RECAP

Singles Play Powers Texas Past Baylor
Tenth-seeded Texas overcomes slow start to beat Baylor.

ATHENS, Ga. — Despite dropping the doubles point, No. 10 Texas was able to blow by Baylor with a 4-1 victory to reach the NCAA quarterfinals. The Longhorns swept singles play with a 4-0 mark in the individual competitions to march on at the NCAA Championships.

The Bears and Longhorns battled in doubles, splitting courts two and three to start play before the 22nd-ranked duo of Juan Benitez and Will Little emerged with a 6-4 win on the top court to seal the doubles point for Baylor and grab a 1-0 lead heading into singles competition.

Texas countered in singles with four victories to seal the come-from-behind win. First it was George Goldhoff knocking off Bjoern Petersen, 6-0, 6-2, to tie the match at one. Leonardo Telles followed with a win on the fifth court, 6-1, 6-4, to give the Longhorns the lead.

Texas then finished off the match with wins on the top two courts: 6-3, 7-5 on the second court by 36th-ranked Harrison Scott and 7-6, 6-3 on the top court by No. 25 Christian Sigsgaard, respectively, to clinch the victory over in-state rival Baylor.
