2011 GEORGIA NOTES...

Iron Bulldogs:

• Seniors Ann Dylla and Kathleen Gates have started every match (122) and played in every set (462) possible in their careers.

UGA Home Attendance In 2011:

• UGA had 14 home dates in 2011 for a total attendance of 11,957. The average home attendance of 854 is the highest in the history of the Ramsey Student Center and the highest for Georgia since the Bulldogs averaged 978 over 13 home dates in 1994 when they played in the Women's Physical Education Building.

• This year, there were five Ramsey Student Center crowds above the 1,000 attendance mark, marking the first time UGA has done that since 1994 when more than 1,000 people turned out to see the Bulldogs play at home seven times.

Season Opening Win vs. Liberty:

• Georgia won its season opening match for the second-straight year defeating Liberty, 3-0, on Aug. 26; Georgia is now 25-9 all-time in season opening matches.

UGA Finishes Runner Up In Hotel Indigo Bulldog Invitational:

• Georgia kicked off its 2011 campaign serving as host to the Hotel Indigo Bulldog Invitational. The Bulldogs opened up with 3-0 wins over Liberty and Florida A&M, but fell to Kansas, 3-0, to finish runner up in the event.

• Senior setter Kathleen Gates and sophomore outside hitter Kathleen Luft were named to the all-tournament team. Gates provided a tournament-best 100 assists while Luft had 30 kills, 18 digs and six blocks.

• Two players, sophomore transfer Elena Perri and freshman Tirah Le'au, made their Georgia debuts in the tournament. Perry had four kills vs. Florida A&M while Le'au finished the weekend with six kills and five blocks.

UGA In The Pepperdine Asics Classic:

• Georgia went 0-3 in the Pepperdine Asics Classic falling to the host Waves, Miami and UC Santa Barbara.

• Redshirt sophomore Kathleen Luft was named to the All-Tournament Team after providing 34 kills and 29 digs.

UGA In The Georgia Tech Regency Suites Invitational:

• Georgia win 1-2 in the Georgia Tech Regency Suites Invitational falling to the host Yellow Jackets and Mercer but coming away with a win over Samford, who was 8-0 entering that match and went on to win the tournament.

• Freshman Tirah Le'au was named to the All-Tournament team recording 46 kills & 16 digs.

First-Year Head Coach Lizzy Stemke:

• Georgia begins a new era in its volleyball program in 2011 under the direction of first-year head coach Lizzy Stemke, who takes the helm of a program for the first time after joining the Bulldogs from Nebraska, where she was an assistant coach for four years.

• Stemke is the sixth head coach in Georgia history.

Overseas In The Summer:

• Four members of the UGA program ventured overseas this past summer:

- Senior setter Kathleen Gates studied abroad in Croatia.

- Senior middle blocker Ann Dylla competed as a member of the Bring It Promotions/USA Development Team at the China-USA Challenge Invitational Tournament in Beijing and Weifang/ Shandong.

- Senior middle block Elizabeth Reid returned home to continue playing with her British National Team.

- Assistant Coach Brook Coulter served as a coach on the USA WJA2 team.
