MEET

The Georgia Intercollegiate Invitational is a college only invitational involving teams from Georgia schools. All athletes representing intercollegiate teams must be eligible according to respective NCAA rules.

All running events will be run as heats against time finals. Throwing and horizontal jump events will allow all competitors four attempts with no advancement to a final. For seeding purposes, please enter your athletes' best 2012 projected performances only. This meet will not be a scored meet.

TRACK

The George C. Griffin Track is 400m with a Mondo surface. There are eight 42" lanes. Use ¼" PYRAMID SPIKES ONLY for all running, jumping, and javelin events. LJ, TJ, JT, HJ, and PV approaches are Mondo. SP, HT, and DT circles are concrete.

Distances for approaches:

PV	150'
JT	120'
HJ	80' (longer on oval if needed)
TJ	200' (North) / 160' (South)
LJ	240' (North) / 200' (South)

ENTRIES

Entry into the meet must be done on-line through www.directathletics.com.

ONLINE ENTRY OPENS AT 1:00 PM(EST) ON TUESDAY, MARCH 13, 2012 AND CLOSSES AT 3:00 PM ON WEDNESDAY, MARCH 14, 2012.

NOTE: PLEASE MAKE THESE YOUR FINAL/DECLARED ENTRIES.

ENTRY FEE

An entry fee of \$25.00 per athlete entered up to \$350.00 per team. Men and women's teams are considered separate entries. You may pay your entry fee at the main entrance to the track when picking up your packet. Checks can be made payable to "GTAA".

PACKET PICK-UP

Friday, March 16, 2012 – Packets will be available starting at 7:00 AM.

Saturday, March 17, 2012 – Packets will be available starting at 10:00 AM.

TRACK PRACTICE SCHEDULE

There will be no time open for practice on the track.

COMPETITORS' NUMBERS: to be worn by all athletes on front of uniform.

SHOWER FACILITIES: There will be no shower or dressing facilities available.

WARM-UP AREA

ABSOLUTELY NO shot put, discus, hammer, or javelin warm-ups should take place in the warm-up area; warm-ups for these events should be done at the event site on the infield of the track. There will be hurdles available for warm-up in the warm-up area.

CLERK

Running event athletes will be called to check in with the clerk approximately 20 minutes prior to their event. Field event athletes will be allowed to enter the infield 30 minutes prior to the start of their event and should check in with the head official of their event at this time. Running event athletes will be allowed onto the track at the conclusion of the event prior to theirs. Running event athletes will be given hip numbers to be worn on the right hip in the clerk's check-in area. Coaches, please encourage your athletes to check-in on time.

MINIMUM DISTANCE FOR MEASUREMENT:

There will be no minimum distances.

STARTING HEIGHTS

Starting heights will be determined by event officials at the site of competition.

IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN

Friday	7:00 – 8:00 AM	Hammer (M/W)
	8:00 – 10:00 AM	Javelin, (M/W), Shot (M/W), Discus (M/W)

Implement weigh-in will take place behind the track stands at the single door section of our equipment room. The door will have a sign signifying the weigh-in area. Implements that pass inspection will be brought out to the event site 45 minutes prior to the start of the event. Those that do not pass inspection will be available for pick-up 1 hour after the event conclusion.

SCHEDULE

We will make every effort to run this meet as close to the enclosed schedule as possible. Depending upon number of entries, the schedule may be revised. If the schedule is revised, it will be posted on Thursday, March 15, 2012 at www.ramblinwreck.com.
