Dear Principal:

The response and participation from Metro Atlanta schools for the Jacket 2 Jacket Reading Program has been tremendous. We are excited to partner with schools again this season for this educational program. Jacket 2 Jacket is an initiative sponsored by the Georgia Tech Women's Basketball team to promote and encourage children to learn through reading. The longstanding program was refreshed in 2015 thanks to a program sponsorship from Georgia United Credit Union! Additionally, we are ecstatic that the Atlanta Dream will be partnering with us again this year for this initiative. We are excited for the new prizes and incentives that will surround the program! The following is an overview of the program:

Eligible Participants:

Elementary and middle school students, from schools in Metro Atlanta, are eligible to participate.

Rules:

- Each child will record the number of pages read each day during the designated one month period. Parents and guardians must initial the student's reading sheet as provided. In addition to books, newspapers will also count and each full page read will count as two book pages. Please total the number of pages read on the reading sheet.
- Parents may read to their children.
- The name of the book is requested to provide information to the teacher as to the types of books the children are reading at home. Please ensure the books are geared to help the children learn and grow.

Awards:

Students participating in the program are eligible for several prizes, including a plaque, bookstore gift certificate, free admission to a Georgia Tech Women's Basketball game and recognition at halftime of the Women's Basketball game on **December 10th, 2017**. Every student who participates in the program will gain free admission to the **Georgia Tech vs. UT-Arlington** game on December 10th and every child in attendance at the game will receive a Georgia United goodie bag. In addition, the top classes with the most pages read will receive a visit from the Georgia Tech Women's Basketball team in the Spring Semester. Prizes will be awarded for the following categories:

- Highest School Total (Elementary and Middle School)
- Highest Class Total from Each Grade
- Highest Individual Total (Elementary and Middle School)
- Highest Individual from Each Grade
- All Participants (in seat recognition and Georgia United goodie bag)



School Participation

We are requesting a Reading Program Coordinator to volunteer to be our contact person from each school.

This volunteer will do the following:

- Coordinator confirms school's participation by Friday, September 22nd.
- Collect the Classroom and School Totals by Thursday, November 2nd (we are requesting students submit to their teachers on Wednesday, November 1st).
- All materials need to be submitted to Brittini Oliver (boliver@athletics.gatech.edu) by Wednesday, November 8th.
- Coordinate Award Winners for Presentation on December 10th.
- Inform all participants that they will receive free admission to Georgia Tech's game on December 10th (no ticket will be required for children).
- Distribute awards for those unable to attend the presentation on December 10th
- Coordinate Spring Visits by Georgia Tech Women's Basketball if your school has classroom winners.

Sunday, October 1st

Month-long program kicks off!

Tuesday, October 31st

Conclusion of reading program!

Wednesday, November 1st

Teachers collect reading sheets from the students.

Thursday, November 2nd

Teachers collect remainder of the sheets from students. Give classroom total sheets to the program coordinator.

Wednesday, November 8th

Program Coordinator sends all materials to Brittini Oliver (boliver@athletics.gatech.edu).

Friday, November 17th

Winners are announced via email.

Sunday, December 10th

The winners will be recognized at halftime of the Georgia Tech vs. UT-Arlington game. Every participant will be admitted free of charge – no ticket required.

April – June 2018

Georgia Tech Women's Basketball team will make a visit to the winning schools and classrooms (exact dates to be arranged).
