In basketball, coaches and non-coaching staff members with responsibilities specific to basketball **MAY NOT** be employed in any capacity (e.g., counselor, guest lecturer, consultant) in a non-institutional, privately owned camp or clinic **UNLESS** the camp is for non-prospect age students.

PART II: CAMP OR CLINIC QUESTIONNAIRE (For Camp/Clinic Administrator – Check all that apply)

3. The camp or clinic is open to any and all entrants (limited only by number and age). Note the camp/clinic may not select participants on an invitation-only basis or reserve spots for specific prospects.
4. The camp or clinic does not employ or give free or reduced admission privileges to any high school, preparatory school or two-year college athletics award winners, or GW recruits.
5. The cost of awards received from the camp or clinic are included in the admission fees charged to participants of the camp or clinic.
6. A booster representing GW's athletics interests is not paying any prospect's expenses to attend the sports camp/clinic.
7. The camp or clinic does not permit or arrange for a prospect (e.g., high school, prep school or 2-year college student) or current Division I, II or III student-athlete to operate a concession to sell items related to or associated with the camp.
8. There will be no recruitment activities (e.g., recruitment presentation, highlight videos).
9. **Basketball Only:** The camp or clinic **DOES NOT** involve participants who have started classes for the 9th grade (this includes 2- and 4-year college students).
10. **Coaches Clinic:** High school prospects (individuals who have started 9th grade) will not serve as demonstrators at the clinic.
