

TICKET INFORMATION

COMPETITORS GUEST TICKETS/ WILL CALL

The distribution of competitors' guest tickets will be the responsibility of each institution. School tables in the Box Office located on 22nd Street Entrance will be provided. Each institution shall have a representative designated to staff their particular table to ensure that all NCAA regulations pertaining to guest ticket distribution are followed. A general will call window will be available and staffed by the George Washington University.

HANDICAP SEATING

The handicap seating areas are located at Press Row in front of sections 109 and 117.

STUDENT TICKETS

Student tickets will only be available from an Atlantic 10 institution or The George Washington University. A valid student identification card from an Atlantic 10 institution must be shown when purchasing student tickets. Student tickets will be limited to one per ID.

TICKET POLICY

All seats in the Smith Center will be sold as general admission tickets. Each institution must purchase a minimum of 50 adult ticket packages. Institutions will receive reserved seating passes for each game in which they participate. The passes will be color-coded for each game. Seats will be held behind each bench to enable pass-holders to sit behind a particular team's bench for their game only. If the demand exists, pass-holders for the next game will have preference for those seats.
