GW HEADS TO BLUEGRASS' WKU FOR ROAD TV GAME

George Washington takes to the road for the first time this season to face Western Kentucky in a contest televised on the Hilltopper Sports Satellite Network (HSSN) and Fox College Sports Atlantic (FCS-Atlantic). Jeff Younglove will call the action with Paul Sanderford providing analysis.

The Colonials return to Kentucky state and Bowling Green for the first time in more than a decade after the Lady Toppers paid a visit to the District for GW's Thanksgiving Classic last November. GW used a 14-2 run early in the second half after leading 37-35 at the break to pull away for an 80-63 victory over WKU in the Classic finale last Nov. 24.

The teams' split the previous two meetings in a home-and-home series spanning the 1996-97 and 1997-98 seasons. GW climbed into the Top 25 for the first time in the 1996-97 season with an 88-63 home win over #22 WKU on Feb. 8. The following January, #19 WKU handed GW a 78-53 loss at Diddle Arena.

BENCH BEATS COPPIN

First-year head coach Mike Bozeman planned on "shortening the rotation" in GW's previous outing against Coppin State Monday night. That plan didn't last long as the Colonials jumped out to a 20-point lead just over 11 minutes into the game and cruised to a 77-36 victory in which their bench outscored both the Eagles (45-36) and own starting five (45-32). Freshman Kay-Kay Allums led with 12 points in 24 minutes off the bench, while senior Jazmine Adair hit her first five shots for 10 points, all in the first half.

This Is GW

The main campus of The George Washington University is located just four blocks from the White House in the north-west quadrant of Washington, DC, in the historic Foggy Bottom neighborhood. The western border of campus is a couple of blocks from the Kennedy Center and the Watergate complex. The U.S. State Department is GW's next-door neighbor to the south. The GW Hospital is credited with saving the life of then-President Ronald Reagan after the Hinckley assassination attempt in 1983 and also has treated current vice president Dick Cheney on several visits. There are a total of 20,001 students enrolled at GW, the majority of whom are graduate students pursuing advanced degrees. Prominent alumni include the late Red Auerbach, Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis and Colin Powell.

2008-09 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

A CLOSER LOOK AT...WESTERN KENTUCKY

Western Kentucky will play a third straight opponent that participated in last year's NCAA Tournament with GW Friday night after hosting Murray State and 12th-ranked Vanderbilt last weekend. WKU sped past the Racers, 95-78, last Friday behind **Arnika Brown's** 27-point, 17-rebound double-double. Despite another double-double from Brown (20p/16r), the Lady Toppers fell to the nationally ranked Commodores 90-72 Sunday night. Brown, the reigning Sun Belt Freshman of the Year, earned conference Player of the Week honors for her back-to-back double-double debut. Senior **Dominique Duck**, who was named to the GW Thanksgiving Classic All-Tourney Team last year, is the Sun Belt's Preseason Player of the Year after averaging 11.5 points and 4.4 boards for a Lady Toppers team that finished 26-8 overall and won the SBC regular season and tournament titles to reach the NCAA Tournament.

GETTING SOME SUN

Western Kentucky is the first of three Sun Belt Conference opponents for GW this season with a Thanksgiving meeting against South Alabama and Dec. 16 contest against Troy still looming on the schedule. The Colonials are 5-3 all-time against current Sun Belt members, including a combined 4-1 versus the Lady Toppers and Jaguars (2-0).

GRAND OPENING

GW improved to 19-15 all-time in season openers - 12-2 in openers at Smith Center - with a 75-56 victory over UMBL in first-year head coach **Mike Bozeman's** debut Saturday afternoon. The Colonials fell behind by 15 points just over eight minutes into the game, but closed the first half on a 27-9 run and trailed only briefly in the second half to post their third straight season-opening victory over the Retrievers.

Senior **Antelia Parrish** narrowly missed just the third triple-double in school history with 19 points, 10 rebounds and six assists. Senior **Jessica Adair** added 15 points and nine boards and rookies **Tara Booker** and **Tiana Myers** combined for 24 points and 11 rebounds to offset Carlee Cassidy's career-high 31-point outburst. Booker's 13 points were the most for a true GW freshman since Ugo Oha scored 14 in her debut in Nov. 2000.

BOZEMAN ERA BEGINS AT GW

The 2008-09 season marks a new era in George Washington women's basketball as for the first time in nearly two decades a new head coach will appear on the Colonials' bench. First-year head coach **Mike Bozeman** takes over the reins of the program after three seasons as an assistant under Joe McKeown, who assumed head coaching duties at Northwestern this offseason after 19 years in Foggy Bottom. The eighth head coach in the 34-year history of the GW program, Bozeman helped GW to a 78-20 overall record, three NCAA Tournament appearances and a pair of trips to the Sweet 16 in 2007 and 2008 during his three seasons as assistant coach. Bozeman is no stranger to handling the main duties for GW. He served as interim head coach three times during the 2006-07 season, including an upset of #11/10 Georgia and a win over host San Diego State to claim the Surf 'N Slam Classic in Dec. 2006.

NEW LOOK, SAME GW

GW lost three starters from last season - Kimberly Beck, Sarah-Jo Lawrence and Whitney Allen - to graduation, but return senior starters **Jessica Adair** and **Antelia Parrish** as well as six other letterwinners for the 2008-09 campaign. The Colonials also welcome seven newcomers - six freshmen and Wake Forest transfer **Yolanda Lavender** - to their lineup. Despite the roster and coaching staff makeovers, GW was still picked to finish second in the Atlantic 10 this season, behind two-time defending conference tournament champion Xavier. The Colonials also are receiving votes in the Associated Press Top 25 poll.

JESSICA ADAIR ON WOODEN WATCH

Senior center **Jessica Adair** was named one of 30 preseason candidates for the 2008-09 Women's Wooden Award All-American Team on Nov. 5. The two-time All-Conference First Team selection led GW in scoring (15.2 ppg), field-goal percentage (.520) and blocks (1.2 bpg) and was second on the team in rebounding (6.1 rpg). She entered the 2008-09 season with 1,049 career points -- 21st all-time at GW -- and is on pace to enter the program's career Top 10 in both scoring and rebounding.

DC'S TEAM

Eight of 20 members of GW's coaching staff and roster have strong ties to the DC Metro area. Head coach **Mike Bozeman** played and coached at Bishop McNamara High School, the alma mater of GW senior **Antelia Parrish** and freshman **Tiana Myers**, prior to becoming an assistant coach for the Colonials in 2005. Seniors **Jessica** and **Jazmine Adair** (Anacostia) and **Yolanda Lavender** (Archbishop Carroll) each attended high school in their hometown of Washington, DC. Two-time *Washington Post* All-Met freshman **Brooke Wilson** shined at Eleanor Roosevelt HS, just over Northeast DC's border. Assistant coach **Katie Rokus** was a two-sport star at Northwest's St. John's College HS.

SMITH CENTER DOMINANCE

GW owns the nation's 13th longest home court winning streak with 15 consecutive victories on the Smith Center hardwood. The Colonials, who had a 15-game home streak snapped by nationally ranked Rutgers last season, have won 30 of their last 31 games in Foggy Bottom, nearly 90 percent (130-of-145) of their home games over the past decade and 77.6 percent (339-98) in the facility's 33 seasons. The University is currently in the process of a \$15 million fundraising initiative to add to the Smith and Kogod families' generous \$10 million gift for renovations to the Charles E. Smith Center. Part 1 of a three-step renovation plan is slated to begin at the completion of the 2008-09 basketball seasons.

A LOOK BACK AT 2007-08

The George Washington women's basketball team celebrated another highly successful season in 2007-08:

▶ The Colonials (27-7 overall) advanced to their second consecutive and fourth overall Sweet 16 courtesy of Sarah-Jo Lawrence's game-winning, buzzer-beating put-back in a 55-53 second-round victory over California.

▶ GW ranked No. 14 in final *USA Today*/ESPN Top 25 poll and No. 20 in final AP Top 25 poll. The No. 14 final ranking is the third highest in program history.

▶ Ranked in *USA Today*/ESPN Top 25 for all 21 weeks and in AP Top 25 for 17 weeks. GW ranked in *USA Today*/ESPN Top 25 for school-record 40 consecutive weeks.

▶ Set Smith Center single-season program records for total attendance (27,723) and average attendance (1,848).

2008-09 SCHEDULE HIGHLIGHTS

▶ GW is scheduled to appear on television three times during the regular season, highlighted by *CBS College Sports* broadcasts from Smith Center Jan. 21 against Villanova (NCAA Pack the House) and March 1 against Temple (Senior Day). The Colonials' Nov. 21 game at Western Kentucky will air on *Fox College Sports Atlantic*.

▶ GW will face 13 teams that qualified for either the 2008 NCAA Tournament or 2008 Postseason WNIT.

▶ GW hosts 17 home games -- the most for the program in 12 years -- including the second annual GW Thanksgiving Classic (w/ South Alabama, Hartford and Liberty) and two-time defending national champion Tennessee Dec. 2.

▶ The Colonials also will face a trio of non-conference powers its has seen multiple times in the past two seasons. GW battles Auburn for the fourth time in 24 months, Rutgers for the third time in 13 months and Texas A&M for the third time in 22 months.

ABIONA RETURNS

Ivy Abiona returns to the Colonials' active lineup after redshirting in 2007-08 to rehab a knee injury. The red-shirt sophomore started and played 16 minutes in GW's exhibition loss to DT3, scoring five points (2-3 FGs), grabbing a team-high tying nine boards and adding a block and steal in her first game action in 20 months.

WAITING GAME

GW will benefit greatly from the addition of senior Wake Forest transfer **Yolanda Lavender**, but head coach **Mike Bozeman** and the rest of the Colonials will have to wait for her to make her impact on the court. The 2007 All-ACC honorable mention selection will sit out the fall semester due to NCAA transfer rules until she becomes eligible 10 games into the season for the Dec. 21 matchup against Princeton.

GAME 1 - GW 75, UMBC 56

WASHINGTON, DC (Nov. 15, 2008) - Despite a rough start, first-year George Washington women's basketball head coach **Mike Bozeman's** debut was a resounding success as the Colonials overcame a 15-point first-half deficit to defeat the UMBC Retrievers, 75-56, in a fast-paced season opener at Charles E. Smith Center Saturday afternoon.

After falling behind by 15 early in the first half, GW (1-0) clamped down on UMBC's Carlee Cassidy, who finished with a career-high 31 points, and turned to returning leading scorers **Antelia Parrish** and **Jessica Adair** to give Bozeman his first collegiate coaching victory.

Parrish led GW with a 19-point, 10-rebound double-double and added a team-high six assists to finish just shy of a triple-double. Jessica Adair followed with 15 points and nine boards, and contributions from freshmen **Tara Booker**, who finished with 13 points and seven rebounds, and **Tiana Myers**, who added 11 points, helped the Colonials fend off the upset-minded Retrievers.

UMBC (0-1) rode the hot start of sharp-shooting guard Cassidy to put GW in a 15-point hole early in the first half. Cassidy scored 16 of her team's first 18 points to help the Retrievers to a 24-9 lead just over eight minutes into the game.

Parrish, Adair and Booker jumpstarted the Colonials' momentum-turning rally, combining for 18 points in a 27-9 spurt that put the hosts ahead, 36-33, at halftime.

The much-larger Colonials grabbed 63 rebounds, six shy of matching the school record, and outscored the Retrievers 40-16 in the paint. The two teams' combined for 143 shots and 108 rebounds.

GAME 2 - GW 77, COPPIN ST. 36

WASHINGTON, DC (Nov. 17, 2008) - The George Washington women's basketball team spread its scoring among 11 different players and limited Coppin State to just 21 percent shooting in a 77-36 victory Monday night at Charles E. Smith Center.

GW's (2-0) bench scored 45 points, led by freshman **Kay-Kay Allums'** game-high 12 and senior **Jazmine Adair's** 10, and Coppin State (0-1) suffered through a 13-minute field-goal drought in the first half in the one-sided contest.

Senior **Antelia Parrish** hit the second of her three 3-pointers on the night to give GW a 15-6 lead 4:02 into the game. Shante Cummings answered with a jumper 16 seconds later, but Coppin State wouldn't hit another shot from the floor for nearly 13 minutes and GW went on a 20-6 run during the span and eventually led 42-21 at the break.

GW's lead never dipped below 20 points in the second half, reached 32 on **Lisa Steele's** three-pointer with 11:44 remaining and ballooned to 40 on sophomore **Ivy Abiona's** cutting lay-in set up by freshman **Sara Mostafa** with 2:58 left.

Parrish and freshman **Kayla Miller** chipped in nine points, while Abiona and rookie **Tara Booker** added eight apiece. 11 different players grabbed rebounds, paced by seven from Abiona and Jazmine Adair, and 12 players handed out assists, led by four from Parrish.

The Colonials assisted 22-of-29 baskets and shot 50.9 percent from the field, including 8-of-14 from beyond the three-point arc.
