## Laker Team Notes

**Last Meeting:** Findlay won the first meeting of the season between the two teams, 70-57, on Dec. 12 at Findlay's Croy Gymnasium. It was the fifth straight victory for the Oilers in the series, as UF won all four meetings last season en route to the Division II National Championship. Prior to this five-game win streak for Findlay, the Lakers had won three straight games in the 2007-08 season. In the earlier meeting this year, Grand Valley State led 25-24 at halftime behind 10 first-half points from junior **Justin Ringler**. The score was tied 27-27 before the Oilers tallied 10 straight points to up the advantage to 37-27. GVSU quickly responded with a 10-1 run of its own to cut the Findlay lead to 38-37. However, the Oilers started to slowly pull away, leading by 10 points with under five minutes remaining, as GVSU would not get within single-digits again in the game. Ringler led the Lakers with 14 points and 10 rebounds, to go with a career-high four steals. It was the third of five double-doubles for Ringler this season. Junior **Toreau Brown** added 12 points on 6-of-14 shooting, while freshman **Nick Carreri** and sophomore **Alvin Storrs** each scored nine points. Findlay leads the all-time series, 13-7, over GVSU.

**Toreau Totals Twenty-Two:** In the loss to Northern Michigan on Saturday afternoon, junior forward **Toreau Brown** led all players with 22 points. He tied his career-high in scoring by shooting 5-of-10 from the field and knocking down 12-of-13 free throw attempts. Brown added seven rebounds and also tied his career-highs in blocks (three) and steals (one). He scored 12 points on 3-of-4 shooting from the floor in the second half, while making all six free throw attempts.

**Offense vs. Defense:** The GLIAC's top-scoring offense (76.8 ppg.) is Findlay, while the conference's best defense (58.8 ppg.) is Grand Valley State. Findlay is far and away the top team in the conference in terms of scoring margin at +17.1 ppg., while GVSU is second at +4.9 ppg. In a complete contrast of styles, Findlay's offense leads the league in field goal percentage at 47.6%, while Grand Valley State is first in the GLIAC in defensive field goal percentage at 39.5%. UF (+5.74) and the Lakers (+1.37) are first and third in the league, respectively, in turnover margin.

**35-Second Clock:** In a group of firsts, GVSU's loss to Northern Michigan was the Lakers' first loss of less than 10 points, first loss when they tally more assists than their opponent, and first loss in an afternoon game...**Justin Ringler** is just 44 points shy (956 total) of becoming the 31st player in Laker history to tally 1,000 career points...**Toreau Brown's** 12 made free throws are the most by a GVSU player since **Mike Przydzial** connected on 13 freebies against Davenport on Nov. 15, 2008.

Lakers trailed at halftime by five points, but never led in the second half, as Northern Michigan snapped its six-game losing streak and put a halt to GVSU's 11-game win streak. Grand Valley State owned leads in second chance points (16-3), bench points (17-4), and points in the paint (22-14), but were outshot by the Wildcats, who connected on 42.9 percent of its field goals and made 25-of-29 free throws (86.2 percent). The Lakers made 21-of-25 freebies (84.0 percent), but shot just 33.3 percent from the floor.

Junior forward **Toreau Brown** tied a career-high with 22 points on 5-of-10 shooting, while draining 12-of-13 free throws. He added seven rebounds and a career-high three steals. Junior **Justin Ringler** totaled 11 points and eight boards in the loss.
