The series between GVSU and Northwest Missouri State is tied 1-1. GVSU claimed the most recent matchup in the 2005 NCAA DII National Championship game, 21-17.

- Grand Valley State is 277-114-3 (.710). The Lakers have the best winning percentage in DII football history (.710) and the second-best winning percentage in college football since 2000 (.909).

- The Lakers' 85 victories since the 2000 campaign also ranks second in college football. GVSU is 89-11 in its last 100 games. The Lakers are 85-9 since 2000.

Grand Valley State quarterback Cullen Finnerty extended his NCAA college football record as the all-time winningest starting QB in terms of total wins to 509. Finnerty is 50-4 as a starting QB.

- Grand Valley State has won a school-record 27 straight games overall. GVSU's last loss was Nov. 27, 2004 at North Dakota in the NCAA Northwest Regional final.

- GVSU has the second best winning percentage of football playing schools in the State of Michigan, behind Michigan's 860-280-36 (.745) mark. GVSU is 277-114-3 (.710).

GVSU PLAYOFF HISTORY: Grand Valley State is making its 11th NCAA Division II playoff appearance in school history. GVSU is 20-2 in its last 22 playoff games since the 2001 season...GVSU has won seven straight playoff games...Grand Valley is 20-7 all-time in the DII Playoffs and 1-1 in the NAIA playoffs. GVSU has held six of its last 12 playoff opponents to 14 points or less, including five that have scored seven points or less.

- The Lakers are 84-5 in their last 89 games with three National Championships (2002, 2003, 2005).
- Grand Valley State is 85-9 since the 2000 season with three NCAA DII National Championships (2002-2003-2005).
- The GVSU senior class enters the Northwest Missouri State game with a 51-4 overall mark and two National Championships.

Grand Valley State entered the 2006 season ranked number one in the AFCA Division II Coaches Poll, D2football.com and Don Hansen's Football Gazette GVSU has opened the season as the top ranked team in the AFCA coaches poll four of the last five years. GVSU has opened the season as the top ranked team in DII football in at least one poll each of the last five years. The Lakers were ranked number one by Sports Illustrated prior to the 2005 campaign and number one in AFCA coaches poll in 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2006.

- The Lakers are 48-2 when being ranked number one since 2002.
- GVSU has been ranked in the AFCA top 25 in 77 straight polls.
- Grand Valley State has been ranked number one in the country in 54-of-the-last-68 polls since the opening game of the 2002 season...GVSU has finished the year ranked in the top 10 (2001-2, 2002-1, 2003-1, 2004-9, 2005 -1) in five straight postseason polls.
- Since 2001, the Lakers are 45-3 at home, 33-2 in their last 35 road games and 35-3 in all games away from Lubbers Stadium in their last 38.
- **Rushing Defense** - Grand Valley State is yielding 97.4 yards per game this season via the ground. Grand Valley State has held 35-of-its-last-53 opponents under 100 yards rushing. Laker opponents are averaging 87.3 yards rushing per game during that 53-game stretch.

• Senior RB Astin Martin rushed for 1,076 yards and eight TDs on 212 carries this season...He has broke the 100-yard rushing mark three times this season and 12 times in 27 career games for the Lakers. Martin ranks 9th in Laker annals with 2,429 career rushing yards in just 27 games...Astin has 3,650 collegiate rushing yards (2,429 at GVSU/1,221 at Toledo).

• **QB Cullen Finnerty • One of three finalists for 2006 Harlon Hill Award as the top player in DII football...2006 GLIAC Player of the Year...First-Team All-GLIAC QB** for second straight year...**First-Team Daktronics All-Northwest Region**...Finnerty is 13-1 at a starting QB in the NCAA playoffs and 50-4 during his career...Finnerty is 3rd on the NCAA DII all-time total offense list 12,948 yards. (2,268 rushing/10,680 passing).

• Finnerty is one of four college football players to pass for over 10,000 yards (10,680) and rush for more than 2,000 yards (2,265) in their career. **Brad Smith (Missouri, 2002-05), Steve McNair (Alcorn State, 1991-94), James McNear (Condordia-St. Paul, 2002-05).**

Finnerty has accounted for 139 TDs in his career (109 passing/30 rushing).

2006 NCAA PLAYOFFS: Completed 45-of-82 passes for 841 yards and 11 TDs in NCAA playoffs...Has a pass efficiency rating of 180.42...Rushed for 137 yards and a TD on 29 carries...Completed 16-of-30 passes for 365 yards and a career-high six TDs vs. Delta State in national semifinals. Completed 15-of-29 passes for

248 yards and three TDs vs. North Dakota. Rushed for 85 y ards on 16 carries and accounted for 333 yards of total offense vs. UND... Connected on 14-of-23 passes for 228 yards and two TDs vs. South Dakota. Rushed for 27 yards and a TD for 255 yards of total offense.

Two-time GLIAC Offensive Player of the Week...Completed 13-of-18 passes for 296 yards and a career-high six TDs at Northern Michigan. Accounted for a then season-high 325 yards of total offense...Named GLIAC Offensive Player of the Week vs. Ferris State. Completed 11-of-15 passes for 182 yards and four TDS...Completed 164-of-280 passes for 2,630 yards and 34 TDs...Rushed for 440 yards and seven TDs...Finnerty has 3,070 yards of total offense and has accounted for 41 TDs.

Finnerty became GVSU's all-time passing leader last week vs. Delta State. Cullen has now thrown for 10,680 yards in his career. Ranks 10th in career rushing yards at GVSU with 2,268...Finnerty is 9th in DII history in all-time passing yards with 10,680...

Finnerty moved into second in the GLIAC record books with 9,150 yards of total offense, second behind Curt Anes' 9,746 yards. In addition, Finnerty is sixth in all-time passing yards with 7,606 yards.

DL Mike McFadden • 2006 GLIAC Defensive Lineman of the Year for second straight year...**First-Team All-GLIAC** for second straight year...**First-Team Daktronics All-Northwest Region**...McFadden is NCAA DII all-time record holder for career QB sacks with 36.0...Mike moved into fourth all-time in DII career tackles for loss with 58.0...Ranks 15th in career tackles for loss per game (1.11)...GVSU career record holder in QB sacks (36.0) and TFL (58.0)...McFadden tied the NCAA college football all division record for consecutive games with a QB sacks with 17 earlier this season. A streak that included the final game of 2004, all 13 games in 2005 and the first three games in 2006.

• McFadden has 54 tackles, 12.5 tackles for loss (-53) and 7.0 QB sacks (-41) this season...McFadden was named the **GLIAC Defensive Player of the Week** for his efforts at Ferris State...**PLAYOFFS:** Tallied five tackles, 1.5 QB sacks (-9) and 1.5 TFL (-9) vs. Delta State...Recorded three tackles vs. North Dakota (12/2)...Tallied three tackles, a QB sack and a TFL vs. South Dakota (11/25)
