Teams will be paired in threesomes according to seed for the first and second rounds as determined by the men's golf committee. Pairings for the third and fourth rounds will be according to actual results. Ties will be broken using the non-sudden-death tiebreaking procedure.

CARTS AND CADDIES

Carts, pull carts or caddies may not be used by participants in the championships, including practice rounds.

Golf carts will be provided for members of the games committee and selected tournament officials. The use of carts by any other personnel (including coaches, players and spectators) must be approved by the appropriate NCAA golf committee. The only exception to this policy would be if the participant is permanently disabled. A written request must be submitted to the appropriate golf committee with accompanying medical statements requesting the use of a cart or pull cart.

SPECTATORS

Spectators should remain on cart paths or in the rough and approximately 15 yards from the players. There may be no communication between players and spectators that could be deemed advice of any nature for the duration of the 18 holes. The designated coach is the only person permitted to dispense food or drinks to players. All institutional personnel, with the exception of the designated coach, are considered spectators. Permanently disabled spectators who may attend the championships should contact the host institution before arrival to assist with accommodations.

OFFICIALS

The NCAA Golf Committee along with representatives of the official governing body will serve as the officials and will make all decisions pertaining to the conduct of the championship such as pairings, setting up the course, rules of golf, etc.

Dear Athletic Trainer or Coach,

Congratulations on the success of your golf teams during the 2006-2007 season. We hope you have an enjoyable trip to Grand Valley State University and The Meadows Golf Course. A Certified Athletic Trainer will be on site at The Meadows during practice rounds and competition.

We will have hot packs, ice bags, and basic first aid supplies available at the clubhouse during the tournament. Electrical stim modalities and ultrasound will be available in the athletic training room at the Fieldhouse. Check at the Fieldhouse upon arrival for the location of the athletic training room.

If your team is not traveling with an athletic trainer, any athletes currently receiving treatment must bring written protocols for any modality treatment. A letter, hand carried by the student-athlete or coach and presented to our athletic training staff will suffice.

The athletic training room, will be available for treatments Monday May 21 – Friday May 25 from 9:00am – 5:00pm and Sunday May 20th by appointment only. Should you need access to the athletic training room during times other than what is listed, please contact me to set up an appointment.

There are two hospitals in downtown Grand Rapids, Spectrum Health Care and St. Mary's hospital. These hospitals are only several blocks apart. GVSU primarily uses St. Mary's because of our team physicians' affiliation with this hospital. Dr. VanNoord at MetroHealth in Jenison will be on call during the tournament. Dr. VanNoord's phone number is listed on the Medical Staff Phone List included in this packet.

Welcome Golfers!

1. The cost of this parking package is \$60 and is good for the length of the tournament. Payment is required before parking unless arrangements are made with Tom Conrad (616) 456-3290.
2. There is a parking pass for each day, allowing in and out privileges to the DeVos Place parking garage. The garage is to the north of the Amway Grand Plaza Hotel. The garage parking has two entrances, one off of Lyon Street and the other off of Bridge Street. The garage is below street level.
3. The pass allows for in and out privileges multiple times each day.
4. You can not use the pass for another vehicle, one set of passes per car. Attempting to use the serial numbers passes for another vehicle may result in forfeiture of monies and parking privileges in the garage.
5. If payment on entry is required, show the booth attendant your pass. If the operation is pay upon exit, pull a ticket to enter and present both the ticket and the daily parking pass to leave without having to pay.
6. Parking passes must be displayed in open view on the dashboard of the vehicle while parking overnight.

Directions

From Gerald R. Ford International Airport to the Amway Grand Plaza:

Exit the airport and turn right onto Patterson Avenue SE.

Go about two miles to 28th street and turn right.

Go about one-half mile to I-96 West to Grand Rapids.

Then take I-96 to Downtown Grand Rapids. Take exit 77-C, Ottawa Avenue.

Go three blocks to Pearl Street, turn right. Go one block and a half.

The Hotel is on the corner of Pearl and Monroe.

From the Amway Grand Plaza to the Meadows Golf Course:

Exit the hotel and take Pearl Street west, merge onto Lake Michigan Drive and continue heading west. Go about 10 miles on Lake Michigan Drive to 48th street and turn left. Go to the first stoplight, West Campus Drive, and turn left. The Meadows Golf Course parking lot is on the left hand side.



Restaurant Directions

(All directions are from the M-45 campus entrance)

The Meadows Restaurant: On Grand Valley State University's campus at 4645 West Campus Drive (located at the Meadows Golf Course).

Main Street Pub: Take the immediate "Michigan Left" out of campus. Take M-45 West to the light at 48th Ave. Turn right at 48th Ave. Entrance is on the left 1/8 mile down 48th Ave.

BFE (Sports Bar/Casual Dining): Turn right at light. Take M-45 to the Linden Ave. "Michigan Left." Take a right onto Linden. Left at first stop sign. Restaurant is at dead end of the street. *(Note: This restaurant is only serving dinner at this time.)*

Mancino's/China One: Take the immediate "Michigan Left" out of campus. Take M-45 west less than 1/2 mile. Restaurants are on the right hand side just past the Speedway gas station.

Subway: Take the immediate "Michigan Left" out of campus. Take M-45 west less than 2 miles. Restaurant is on the right hand side just past the Family Fare Grocery Store.

Rivertown Crossings Area: (includes Outback Steakhouse, Carrabba's Italian Grill, Red Lobster, Applebees, Max & Irma's, Olive Garden, Kobe Japanese Steakhouse, South of the Border, TGI Fridays, IHOP, Bob Evans, Logan's): Take a right out of campus on M-45. Take M-45 east to Wilson Ave (M-11). Make a right on Wilson. Take Wilson to I-196 West toward Holland. Take expressway to the "Rivertown Parkway" exit. At light, make a left onto Rivertown Parkway. The restaurants are approx. 1/2 to 1 mile down Rivertown Pkwy.

Alpine Avenue area: (includes BW3, Olive Garden, TGI Fridays, Bennigans, Outback Steakhouse, Logan's, Fire Mountain, Perkins, Damons, Applebees): Take a right out of campus on M-45. Take M-45 east to Wilson Ave (M-11). Take a left on Wilson. Take Wilson to 3-mile road. Right on 3-mile. Take 3-Mile to Fruitridge. Make a right onto Fruitridge. Then make an immediate right onto I-96. Take I-96 to the Alpine Ave. 3-Mile exit. Make a left off the exit onto 3-Mile Rd. Then make another left onto Alpine. Restaurants are straight ahead.
