## Laker Team Notes

**Last Meeting:** Grand Valley State earned a tough road victory in the first meeting between these two teams on Dec. 12, beating the Oilers in Findlay, 70-58. The Lakers opened up a 12-point advantage with 3:13 remaining in the first half after five straight points from freshman **Briauna Taylor**, as GVSU led 27-15. Findlay scored the final eight points of the half, cutting the score to 27-23 at halftime. The Oilers would get as close as two points (37-35) with over 13 minutes left, but Grand Valley State put together a game-changing 21-6 run to lead 58-41 with six minutes remaining to put away UF. Sophomore point guard **Jasmine Padin** netted a team-high 15 points to go with three assists and zero turnovers. Freshman **Alex Stelfox** and junior **Kara Crawford** each added 12 points, as Crawford totaled seven rebounds and Stelfox shot 6-of-13 from the floor. **Briauna Taylor** finished with nine points, as junior **Elizabeth Van Tiflin** led all players with nine rebounds. GVSU has won four straight contests over the Oilers and eight of the last nine games between the two teams. The Lakers lead the all-time series, 10-4, as head coach **Janel Burgess** is 4-0 against Findlay during her three seasons at Grand Valley State.

**Freshman of the Year...Again?:** As a freshman last season, guard **Emma Veach** was voted the GLIAC Freshman of the Year after averaging 13.5 points and 5.4 rebounds per game, while tallying 88 assists. The Lakers may have the league's Freshman of the Year this season, as well. Center **Alex Stelfox** is second on the team in scoring (11.5 ppg.), third in rebounding (4.5 rpg.), and is shooting a team-best 56.3 percent from the field. She ranks third in the conference in field goal percentage and third in blocked shots (31). Her 31 blocks are eight fewer than the entire 2008-09 GVSU team and it is the most rejections by a Laker since **Julie Zeeff** swatted 85 shots in 2003-04. Stelfox has blocked a shot in 17 of 19 games this season and her 14 double-digit scoring games are the most by any Laker.

**30-Second Shot Clock:** The 54 points that Grand Valley State scored against Northern Michigan on Saturday was the team's lowest point total since Feb. 7, 2008 when the Lakers lost to Michigan Tech, 60-49, in Allendale...the 12-point margin (66-54) against the Wildcats was the largest loss of the season. Grand Valley State is now 10-1 when the game margin is 10 or more points...GVSU won its first seven games in January before dropping its final pair of games...it was the first loss for the Lakers when they total more assists than their opponents (11-1 on the year)...freshman **Briauna Taylor** has connected on more three-pointers (21-of-35) than free throws (15-of-21)...GVSU is 12-1 when it shoots better than 30% from three-point range and just 2-4 when it shoots below 30% from long range.

Two days after playing its first double overtime game in since 1996 against #4 Michigan Tech, the Lakers dropped a tough home game to Northern Michigan on Saturday afternoon. GVSU led at halftime (24-22), but the Wildcats pushed out to a 48-38 advantage with eight minutes remaining. The Lakers pulled within 53-47 with 3:33 left, but Northern Michigan hit back-to-back three-pointers and owned a double-digit lead the rest of the game. It was Grand Valley State's biggest loss of the season. NMU pulled down 12 offensive rebounds and owned a 14-2 edge in second chance points.

Freshman center **Alex Stelfox** scored 10 of her team-high 12 points in the first half, as she shot 6-of-9 from the field. Fellow rookie **Briauna Taylor** added 11 points off the Laker bench, while **Emma Veach** led the Lakers in rebounds (six) and assists (five).
