Format and Pairings: 72 Holes of Competition, 18 Holes of Competition each day

The NCAA Golf Committee will pair three teams in groups of three according to their seed for the first and second rounds. During the second round, players' positions within their teams may change based on first round scores. For the third and fourth round pairings teams will be by position according to score. For purposes of ranking individuals for first and second rounds, the individuals with the higher ranking will maintain their pairing position. For purposes of ranking individuals for the third and fourth rounds, the individuals with the lowest total score will maintain their pairing position.

Merchandise:

Merchandise will be sold at registration on Sunday, May 7 from 6-8pm at The Meadows' Clubhouse and again at the Welcome Diner on Monday, May 8 from 6-8pm at the Kirkhof Center in the Pere Marquette room. Merchandise sales will continue on Wednesday, May 10 from 9am-6pm throughout the rest of the tournament outside the clubhouse in the merchandise kiosk.

Banquets:

There will be a welcome dinner for participants only on Monday, May 8 at 7pm in the Pere Marquette Room in the Kirkhof Center, casual dress. On Tuesday, May 9 at 7pm the NCAA Banquet will take place at the Alumni House for participants only, professional dress. And on Thursday, May 11 at 6:30pm at the Main Street Pub the NGCA will host their banquet and family/fans are permitted to attend with the purchase of a ticket. Tickets are \$15 for coaches/team members and \$25 for guests. Tickets may be purchased at the Check-in on Sunday or from the starter's table on Monday and Tuesday. The tickets need to be purchased by Tuesday at 10:30am.

CARTS AND CADDIES

Participants will be allowed to use manual pull carts for all practice and competition rounds during the championship. No caddies are allowed during the practice or competition rounds.

Golf carts will be provided for members of the games committee and selected tournament officials. Each competing institution may use one cart. Only an institutional representative (a non-athlete) may drive or ride in the assigned golf cart for that institution during a tournament round. Spectators will **not** be allowed to rent, drive or ride in golf carts. If a spectator has a disability that does not allow him/her to walk the course, approved tournament personnel may transport him/her onto the course. Tournament personnel will do their best to place the spectators in areas where they may have the best vantage point to see as many holes as possible.

SPECTATORS

Spectators should remain on cart paths or in the rough and approximately 15 yards from the players. There may be no communication between players and spectators that could be deemed advice of any nature for the duration of the 18 holes. All institutional personnel, with the exception of the designated coach, are considered spectators.

Ringers on devices must be turned off. Spectators are asked to refrain from smoking near the players or in the clubhouse. Carts will not be provided for spectators.

OFFICIALS

The NCAA Golf Committee along with representatives of the official governing body will serve as the officials and will make all decisions pertaining to the conduct of the championship such as pairings, setting up the course, rules of golf, etc.

Dear Athletic Trainer or Coach,

Congratulations on the success of your golf teams during the 2005-2006 season. We hope you have an enjoyable trip to Grand Valley State University and The Meadows Golf Course. A Certified Athletic Trainer will be on site at The Meadows during practice rounds and competition.

We will have hot packs, ice bags, and basic first aid supplies available at the clubhouse during the tournament. Electrical stim modalities and ultrasound will be available in the athletic training room at the Fieldhouse. Check at the Fieldhouse upon arrival for the location of the athletic training room.

If your team is not traveling with an athletic trainer, any athletes currently receiving treatment must bring written protocols for any modality treatment. A letter, hand carried by the student-athlete or coach and presented to our athletic training staff will suffice.

The athletic training room, will be available for treatments Tuesday May 9th – Friday May 12th from 9:00am – 5:00pm and Saturday May 13th by appointment only. Should you need access to the athletic training room during times other than what is listed, please contact me to set up an appointment.

There are two hospitals in downtown Grand Rapids, Spectrum Health Care and St. Mary's hospital. These hospitals are only several blocks apart. GVSU primarily uses St. Mary's because of our team physicians' affiliation with this hospital. Dr. VanNoord at MetroHealth in Jenison will be on call during the tournament. Dr. VanNoord's phone number is listed on the Medical Staff Phone List included in this packet.

Directions

From Gerald R. Ford International Airport to the Sleep Inn, Allendale:

Exit the airport and turn right onto Patterson Avenue SE, turn right onto M-11/28th Street SE, merge onto I-96 W via the ramp on the left toward GD Rapids/Muskegon, take I-96 W towards Downtown GD Rapids/Holland, take the Lake Michigan Drive exit –Exit 75- toward M-45 W, stay on Lake Michigan Drive W for about 11 miles, turn right onto 48th street, the Sleep Inn will be on your left hand side.

From the Sleep Inn to The Meadows Golf Course:

Exit the hotel parking lot, turn right onto 48th street, cross over Lake Michigan Drive (course will be on your left hand side) to West Campus Drive, turn left at the light, golf course parking lot is on the left had side (approximately ½ mile from the hotel to the golf course).



Restaurant Directions

(All directions are from the M-45 campus entrance)

The Meadows Restaurant: On Grand Valley State University's campus at 4645 West Campus Drive (located at the Meadows Golf Course).

Main Street Pub: Take the immediate "Michigan Left" out of campus. Take M-45 West to the light at 48th Ave. Turn right at 48th Ave. Entrance is on the left 1/8 mile down 48th Ave.

BFE (Sports Bar/Casual Dining): Turn right at light. Take M-45 to the Linden Ave. "Michigan Left." Take a right onto Linden. Left at first stop sign. Restaurant is at dead end of the street. *(Note: This restaurant is only serving dinner at this time.)*

Mancino's/China One: Take the immediate "Michigan Left" out of campus. Take M-45 west less than 1/2 mile. Restaurants are on the right hand side just past the Speedway gas station.

Subway: Take the immediate "Michigan Left" out of campus. Take M-45 west less than 2 miles. Restaurant is on the right hand side just past the Family Fare Grocery Store.

Rivertown Crossings Area: (includes Outback Steakhouse, Carrabba's Italian Grill, Red Lobster, Applebees, Max & Irma's, Olive Garden, Kobe Japanese Steakhouse, South of the Border, TGI Fridays, IHOP, Bob Evans, Logan's): Take a right out of campus on M-45. Take M-45 east to Wilson Ave (M-11). Make a right on Wilson. Take Wilson to I-196 West toward Holland. Take expressway to the "Rivertown Parkway" exit. At light, make a left onto Rivertown Parkway. The restaurants are approx. 1/2 to 1 mile down Rivertown Pkwy.

Alpine Avenue area: (includes BW3, Olive Garden, TGI Fridays, Bennigans, Outback Steakhouse, Logan's, Fire Mountain, Perkins, Damons, Applebees): Take a right out of campus on M-45. Take M-45 east to Wilson Ave (M-11). Take a left on Wilson. Take Wilson to 3-mile road. Right on 3-mile. Take 3-Mile to Fruitridge. Make a right onto Fruitridge. Then make an immediate right onto I-96. Take I-96 to the Alpine Ave. 3-Mile exit. Make a left off the exit onto 3-Mile Rd. Then make another left onto Alpine. Restaurants are straight ahead.
