Head Coach Ricky Fried



Ricky Fried is now in his 13th season at the helm of the Hoya program after serving as a Georgetown assistant coach in 2003 and 2004. In his first 12 seasons, Fried has led the Hoyas to a 130-88 overall record and a 64-15 record in BIG EAST regular season games. During the 2014 season, he became the winningest coach in program history following a 13-6 win over Temple on April 19.

Under Fried, Georgetown has earned seven BIG EAST regular season titles, made six trips to the BIG EAST Tournament Championship Game, winning in 2010, and has advanced to the NCAA Tournament seven times, reaching the quarterfinals twice.

Fried has coached 22 All-Americans as well as the National Goalie of the Year, two BIG EAST Attackers of the Year, two Midfielders of the Year and five Defensive Players of the Year to go along with 67 All-BIG EAST first and second team selections. Additionally, he and his staff have won BIG EAST Staff of the Year on two occasions.

In 2016, Georgetown went 6-11 with a mark of 4-3 in BIG EAST Conference play. The squad earned a BIG EAST Championship berth marking GU's 10th-consecutive trip to the conference postseason. The Blue & Gray had one player named all-region and four All-BIG EAST honorees.

Fried was named associate head coach for the Hoyas in November 2003 and was involved in all aspects of the Hoya program but focused on an offensive unit that became one of the most potent in the nation. On the other side of the field in 2003, Georgetown led the nation in caused turnovers.

Prior to Georgetown, Fried was an assistant coach at Johns Hopkins University for nine seasons. While at the school, Fried served as the recruiting coordinator and helped build Hopkins in to a Division I Top 20 program after aiding in the transition from a strong D-III program.

A 1988 graduate of the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC), Fried was an All-America midfielder for the Retrievers lacrosse team. As a senior, he served as team captain, was named the team's Most Valuable Player and earned the team's Leadership Award. He was named to UMBC's All-Time Team in 1990.

Fried arrived at Hopkins following a two-year stint as an assistant coach at the Gilman School and serving a season as an assistant at his alma mater. He also played professionally with the Philadelphia Wings from 1989-92 and 1997 and the Baltimore Thunder from 1993-94.

Fried is also active in the Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Coaches Association (IWLCA) and has served as the organization's vice president, on the board of directors, on its ethics and recruiting tournaments committees. Currently, he is on the Regional All-American Committee and is a member of the Tewaaraton Trophy Committee.

After serving as an assistant coach for the U.S. Women's Lacrosse Elite Team for three years, Fried was named the head coach of the national team in August of 2009.

After leading Team USA to an undefeated gold medal in 2013 at the Federation of International Lacrosse World Cup in Oshawa, Canada, his position was renewed through 2017. It marked his second World Cup gold after winning in the summer of 2009 as an assistant in Prague, Czech Republic.

As the head coach of the national team, Fried appoints assistant coaches, identifies talented players for the squad and advises on the direction women's lacrosse takes in the United States.

He, his wife Halyna, and their children, Jack (13) and Paige (11), reside in Columbia, Md.

With the Marquette win, the Hoyas earned a BIG EAST Tournament berth for the 11th-consecutive year. They are the only team to qualify every year of its existence.

Nonconference

Georgetown finished out nonconference play with a record of 3-5. In those eight games, GU played four ranked opponents.

Road Trip

The Penn game marked the first of a four-game road trip for the Blue & Gray. The Hoyas don't return home until Saturday, April 1. In fact the team plays six total road games in March and five are on the road. The lone home game was a win over George Mason on March 4.

Cycle For Survival

The women's lacrosse team was one of a few from Georgetown and players were some of hundreds who participated in the Cycle For Survival on Saturday morning. The event raises money for rare cancer research including brain, pancreatic, ovarian, stomach, all types of pediatric cancers, and many others. Player raised money while spinning at Equinox in DC.

Getting His Start

Ricky Fried spent nine seasons at Johns Hopkins as an assistant coach and serving as a recruiting coordinator. He aided the program from Division III to Division I. He has played JHU every year of her tenure as a head coach and is 8-5 all-time against the Blue Jays including one meeting in the NCAA Tournament in 2014.

Alma Mater

Nick Williams played lacrosse and football at Towson. As a four-year member of the Tigers men's lacrosse team, Williams played 61 career games and helped Towson to a pair of CAA championships. He scored 29 goals with 22 assists in his career, including a career-best, four-goal game against Cornell in the 2005 NCAA Tournament. The Baltimore, Md., native also was a football standout at Towson and is the fifth-leading rusher in school history with 1,985 yards during his career. As a sophomore, Williams rushed for 911 yards in 11 games, including a career-high 169

yards in a win over Delaware. He was a Third Team All-Atlantic 10 selection at running back following his sophomore year.

Friendly Sidelines

There was a familiar face on the sidelines against GW. Kelyn Freedman was an All-BIG EAST honoree for the Hoyas graduating in 2014. The midfielder is one of the program's all-time leaders in draws, points, goals and caused turnovers. She is one of many Fried players that have gone on to coach at different levels.

Whitehurst Preseason AA

Francesca Whitehurst was named Inside Lacrosse Preseason Third Team All-American when the organization announced its preseason honors. This is Whitehurst's first career preseason honor.

Captains

Maddy Fisher, Jenny Schwalje, Kate Snouffer and Sarah Cheney were selected as the 2017 team captains.

Fried to Coach in 2017

After leading Team USA to its seventh world championship in July, 2013 Georgetown University Head Women's Lacrosse Coach Ricky Fried has been selected as head coach for the 2017 U.S. Women's National Team. Fried will lead Team USA as head coach through the 2017 Federation of International Lacrosse (FIL) World Cup in Surrey, England, where the U.S. will seek a third-consecutive world title and eighth overall. He led Team USA to a perfect 7-0 mark at the 2013 FIL World Cup in Oshawa, Ontario, where the U.S. outscored its opponents by a record 13.2 goals per game, including a 19-5 victory over Canada in the gold medal game. The U.S. also set records for goals in a tournament (127) and goals per game (18.1).

2016 National Letters of Intent

Ricky Fried announced the signing of nine student-athletes to National Letters of Intent. The attackers are Cameron McGee from Roland Park Country School and Anna Farley from Bel Air High School. Farley will be a two-sport athlete on the Hilltop also joining the field hockey squad. The midfielders are the largest group with four coming to the Hilltop. Mary Pagano from Pingry High School, Caroline Frock from Westminster High School, Madison Ascione from Queen Anne's County High School, and Megan McCrady from Fox Chapel Area High School will all work for time in one of the midfield lines. On defense, Mollie Miller and Wynne Whitley from St. Stephen's & St. Agnes School will join the backline. Nicole Leska from Vestal High School comes in as the lone goalie.

Whitehurst on the National Team

Francesca Whitehurst was named to the 2017 U.S. Women's National Team following a three-day tryout at the organization's national team training center. The 36 players will train in the lead up to the 2017 Federation of International Lacrosse (FIL) Women's World Cup in Guildford, England. Ultimately, 18 players will represent the United States as the team goes for a third consecutive and eighth overall world title.

Etrasco Joins the Squad
