Georgetown Crew has its roots in the founding of the Georgetown University Boat Club in 1876. Throughout its history, Hoya rowers have proudly represented the University up and down the Eastern Seaboard, across the country, and around the world.

Fifty-three years have passed since Georgetown students found their way back to rowing on the river. From a single squad of 20 students in 1958 to four squads totaling 160 participants today, there has been an unbroken line of Hoyas racing their shells on the Potomac. The commitment, discipline, and difficulty involved in this athletic endeavor have collectively resulted in many good crews for the Blue and Gray. More importantly, thousands of rowers, good women and men alike, have gone on from Georgetown to lead productive lives of purpose.

Recent years have seen medals at the International Rowing Association (IRA) Championship Regatta and competition in the prestigious Henley Royal Regatta on the Thames River in England. Over the years, the Georgetown Crew has produced members of the United States National Team.
