## **Wolfe and Bonomini named Volleyball Players of the Week**

INDIANAPOLIS – Butler University junior **Jessica Wolfe** has been named Horizon League Volleyball Offensive Player of the Week, while Cleveland State University senior **Maggie Bonomini** has earned Defensive Player of the Week honors for the period of Aug. 31-Sept. 6.

Wolfe, an outside hitter from Plainfield, Ind., collected 75 kills (4.69 kps) and hit .282 for the Bulldogs last week. She also registered six blocks, 35 digs and 81.5 points (5.09 pps) in 16 sets.

Wolfe was named to the Marquette Invitational All-Tournament Team after helping Butler to 3-0 wins over Binghamton University and Texas State University on Saturday.
