Accomplishments in the 2003 season

- Established a partnership with the University of Houston to promote community outreach objectives of All-N-One and the UH
- Developed a strong initial base of 67 key Sponsors for the program
- Established a permanent tailgating area for visiting kids at the John I. Prestwood Family Pavilion
- Reached over 2000 area youth during the 2003 season
- Provided tailgating, souvenir shirts, and game day activities for Little Coog attendees and chaperones
- Established an office in the Athletic Alumni Center to coordinate activities with student athletes and area youth

Goals for the 2004 Season

- Visit 20 elementary schools during Operation Education
- Reach over 200 area students in the Summer Camps
- Organize and sponsor a UH/All-N-One First Annual Banquet to kickoff the 2004 football season.
- Increase our sponsorship group to 150 participating Sponsors
- Purchase dedicated sections of season seats in the South end zone of Robertson Stadium
- Grow the program to over 3000 area youth for the 2004 football season
- Enhance the tailgating and pre-game experience for attending area youth
- Develop relationships with other UH Athletic Programs, in addition to football
