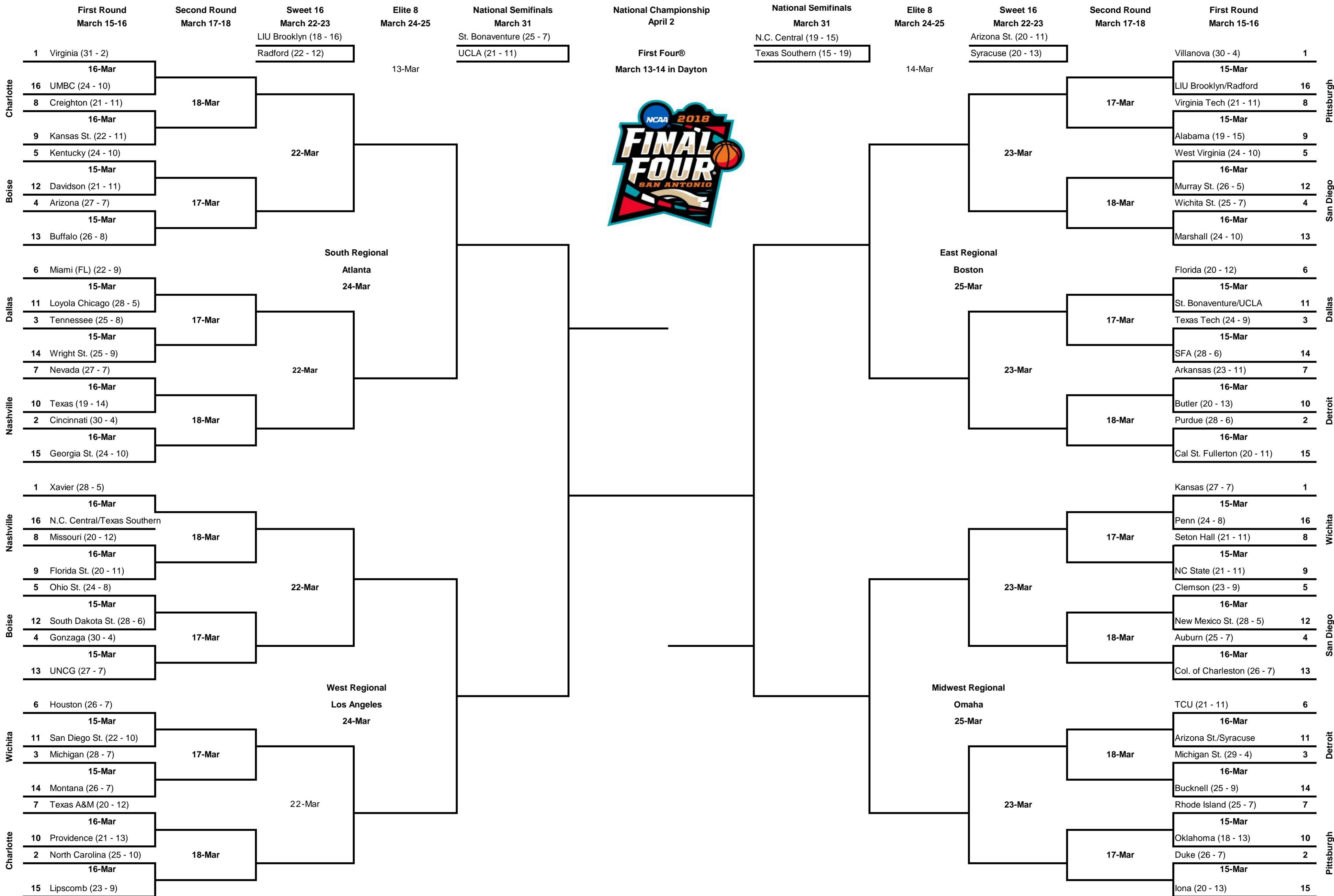


2018 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship
