



**Postgame Notes**  
**No. 1 Cincinnati 56, No. 3 Houston 55**  
Records: Cincinnati (30-4); Houston (26-7)

Cincinnati clinches the American Athletic Championship game over Houston.

The title is Cincinnati's first league tournament championship since 2004.

Cincinnati is the second straight team to win The American men's basketball regular-season and tournament championship.

Houston G Corey Davis Jr. totaled 15 points hitting five three-pointers in the first half.

Cincinnati F Gary Clark registered his AAC-best 12<sup>th</sup> double-double of the season and 30<sup>th</sup> of his career with 20 points and 12 rebounds.

The Cougars outscored the Bearcats in fast-break points (13-2).

The Bearcats outscored the Cougars in second-chance points (17-4).

Cincinnati shot one of their lowest percentage from behind the three-point arc at 28.6%.

Houston shot 20% (6-for-30) from the field in the second half and did not hit a three-point field goal (0-for-10).
