HEAD COACH TOM PENDERS

University of Houston head coach Tom Penders is in his fourth season as Houston's head coach and enters the Southern game with a 65-40 record at the school.

Penders is in his 34th season overall as a head coach with a 592-401 career record, and needs just eight more victories to join a elite list of NCAA Division I coaches who have won 600 games. With Houston's win against Toledo, Penders tied former UH head coach Guy Lewis in career victories with 592.

His 57 victories in his first three years gave him the best three-year start for any UH basketball coach. He also has led the Cougars to two NIT tournaments, three upsets over nationally-ranked teams, and their first win in a postseason tournament since 1988 after Houston beat BYU in the first round of the 2006 NIT. In addition, the Cougars also won back-to-back games over nationally-ranked teams for the first time since 1984 as well.

With his 591 career victories, Penders is seventh among the NCAA Division I active coaches. Penders joins Bob Knight, Jim Calhoun and Lute Olson as the only four coaches who have coached 34 or more seasons. Knight is entering his 42nd season, while Calhoun in his 36th year and Olson coached 34 seasons before his leave of absence earlier this year.

In addition, Penders also is one of six coaches who have coached more than 950 games, entering the Toledo having coached in 992 games throughout his career.

Penders came to Houston after spending three years as an analyst for ESPN and Westwood One Radio. He also coached three years as head coach at George Washington from 1998-2001, compiling a 49-42 record and led the Colonials to the 1999 NCAA Tournament.

Penders also coached at Texas, Rhode Island, Fordham, Columbia and Tufts during his career. He spent 10 seasons at Texas, and set a school record with 208 victories while leading the Longhorns to three Southwest Conference Championships and eight NCAA Tournaments, including the Elite Eight in 1990 and the Sweet 16 in 1997.

He went to Texas after leading Rhode Island to the 1988 NCAA Sweet 16. In his first year, he was named the Atlantic 10 Co-Coach of the Year after leading the Rams to a 20-10 record and to a NIT berth despite taking over the team two weeks before the season began.

He also led Fordham to five straight NIT appearances in his eight years there. Penders also led Columbia to back-to-back winning seasons and a second-place finish in the Ivy League in 1977-78.

He began his collegiate coaching career at Tufts where he took over a 1-17 team and turned it around with 12-8, 22-4 and 20-6 records in the next three years.

In the Fall of 2004, Tufts awarded Penders its "Outstanding Achievement Award". In 2006, he was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame and earlier this year, he was named the City of Houston's Mr. Sportsman 2007 by Interfaith Charities.

Penders and his wife, Susie, have three children—Wendy, Tommy, Jr., a current basketball coach at Angleton High School in Angleton, Texas, and Karli.

GAME PREVIEW

The University of Houston men's basketball team will try to win their eighth straight game and improve its record to 9-1 when the Cougars play host to Southern University on Saturday, Dec. 8 at Hofheinz Pavilion. The Cougars enter the game coming off a 67-56 victory over Toledo last Tuesday night in Hofheinz Pavilion. Houston began its winning streak against Marist, and also beat Charleston, Texas Southern, Grambling State, Coastal Carolina and Middle Tennessee State.

Southern enters the game with a 1-5 record following a 56-39 loss at Stephen F. Austin on Dec. 4. It was the fifth straight loss for the Jaguars after Southern began the season with a 75-61 victory at SMU on Nov. 10. The Jaguars also suffered losses against Paul Quinn College in Dallas on Nov. 11, at Missouri on Nov. 16, at Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 20 and at LSU on Nov. 30.

HOUSTON VS. SOUTHERN

Houston will be playing against Southern for the first time Saturday night. The Cougars enter the game with a 13-4 record against teams from the Southwestern Athletic Conference. UH defeated Texas Southern and Grambling State earlier this season and will face Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Dec. 29. The Cougars beat Texas Southern 73-66 on Nov. 21 and Grambling State 95-53 on Nov. 24.

SCOUTING THE COUGARS

Picked to tie UAB for second place in a poll of Conference USA coaches, Houston enters the Southern game looking to improve its record to 7-0 in home games this season. The Cougars opened the season with a victory over Morehead State, and have beaten Texas Southern, Grambling State, Coastal Carolina, Middle Tennessee and Toledo in home games this season. The Cougars have won nine straight home games dating back to last year.

The Cougars are led by preseason All-Conference USA selection Robert McKiver, who is averaging 20.8 points, 4.4 rebounds and 1.9 assists per game.

Senior forward Dion Dowell averages 12.8 points per game and is the team's rebounding leader with an 8.3 average.

Senior point guard Lanny Smith leads the team in assists with 4.1 per game after handing out three assists against Toledo and five assists each against both Grambling State and Coastal Carolina. He sat out the Middle Tennessee game with the flu.

Freshman guard Brockeith Pane is averaging 13.9 points per game and has scored in double figures seven times this season. He was named the Conference USA Player of the Week on Nov. 26 after scoring a career-high 26 points against Grambling State and leading the Cougars with 20 points against Texas Southern.

MCKIVER NAMED C-USA CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK

McKiver has been named the Conference USA Co-Player of the Week on Dec. 3 after averaging 26.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists in Houston's two victories against Coastal Carolina and Middle Tennessee State.

McKiver poured in 32 points and tied his own school record of nine 3-point field goals made for the second time this season in Houston's 83-68 victory over Middle Tennessee State.

see State. He began the week scoring 21 points, grabbing five rebounds and handing out three assists in an 86-79 victory over Coastal Carolina on Nov. 26.

The other co-Player of the Week was sophomore forward Walter Sharpe of UAB. Sharpe led the Blazers to a pair of wins over Louisiana-Lafayette and Cincinnati. He posted 23 points and nine rebounds against the Ragin' Cajuns, and collected 15 points, six rebounds and three assists against the Bearcats.

LAST TIME OUT

Houston combined an inside scoring attack with some timely three-point shooting to defeat Toledo 67-56 in Hofheinz Pavilion last Tuesday night.

The Cougars fell behind early in the game 11-0 as Toledo hit their first five shots from the field. Marcus Cousin scored Houston's first two points when he made a lay-up with 16:09 left to play in the first half.

After Cousin's lay-up, Houston got itself back into the game by passing the ball inside to Cousin and Dion Dowell. Cousin made two more lay-ups and Dowell added another to help the Cougars closed to within 15-9. After Robert McKiver made his first of four three-point baskets, he and Dowell combined to make five free throws. Then, McKiver added another try to tie the score at 19-19 with 6:38 left to play in the first half.

Brockeith Pane made a jump shot in the lane after Cousin blocked Ridley Johnson's jump shot to give the Cougars their first lead of the game at 21-19. The Cougars never trailed again and led 30-28 at halftime.

The second half began just as the first half did when Jonathan Amos stole the ball from Dion Dowell and passed ahead to Tyrone Kent for a lay-up.

But, this time Houston answered with McKiver hitting a three-point shot from the top of the key and Kelvin Lewis making two straight jump shots to give Houston a 37-30 lead. The Cougars extended their lead to as many as 12 points, 60-48, with 3:24 left to play. Houston clinched the victory hitting six straight free throws down the stretch.

FAST STARTS

The Cougars enter the Southern game having produced its best start since 1991-92, when Houston began the season with a 9-1 record.

EIGHT STRAIGHT WINS

Houston enters the Southern game looking to win its eighth straight game. The Cougars have beaten Marist, Charleston, Texas Southern, Grambling State, Coastal Carolina, Middle Tennessee and Toledo in their last seven games. The seven straight wins is Houston's longest winning streak since 2005-06 when the Cougars also won eight straight games. The eight-game winning streak also is Houston's longest non-conference winning streak since 1991-92 when the Cougars also won eight straight non-conference games. The last time Houston won nine straight non-conference contests was in 1983-84.

TAKING CARE OF THE BASKETBALL

Houston recorded the 20 turnovers against Toledo, and this was the first time in 35 games that the Cougars have had 20 turnovers, dating back to Dec. 2, 2006 when Houston had 22 turnovers at VCU.

That stopped a six-game streak in which UH had 13 or fewer turnovers. The Cougars had a season-low two turnovers against Grambling State, 8 turnovers versus the College of Charleston, 10 turnovers against Texas Southern, 11 turnovers versus both Marist and Coastal Carolina, along with 13 turnovers against Middle Tennessee.

FREE THROW SHOOTING ACCURACY

Houston made 22 of its 24 free throws for a free throw percentage of .917 against Coastal Carolina. It marks the fourth time in the last three seasons Houston has shot 91 percent or better at the free throw line.

The Cougars also made 93.3 percent (14-15) of its free throws at UCF on Feb. 28, 2007 and 92.9 percent (13-14) at Southern Miss on Feb. 19, 2007.

Houston tied a school record in the semifinals of the 2006 Conference USA Tournament with a percentage of .950 (19-20) at Memphis on Mar. 10, 2006.

In their last game, the Cougars shot 80 percent against Toledo after making 20 of their 25 free throws against the Rockets.

FORCING 20 TURNOVERS

The Cougars forced 20 turnovers by Toledo. It was the third time this season the Cougars have forced 20 or more turnovers in a game. The other two teams were Grambling State (20) and Morehead State (28).

DEFENSE, DEFENSE

The Cougars held Grambling State to just 29.3 percent (17-58) shooting from the field. It marks the fourth game this season in which Houston has held its opponent under 40 percent shooting from the field. The Cougars held Texas Southern to 35.7 (25-70) percent, Morehead State to 38.0 (19-50) percent and Marist to 38.2 (21-55) percent shooting.

COUGARS FINISH FOURTH AT PUERTO RICO

Houston finished in fourth place at the ESPNU Puerto Rico Tip-Off on Nov. 15-18. The Cougars finished with a 2-1 record at the tournament. Houston suffered a 73-72 loss against VCU in the first round before recording a 64-58 win over Marist and an 84-69 victory over the College of Charleston.

This marked the first time in school history, Houston played in Puerto Rico. It marked the ninth time that the Cougars played in a tournament outside the continental United States. Houston played in the Suntory Classic (1982-83) in Tokyo, Japan, the Top of the World Classic in Fairbanks, Alaska (1999-00), the Rainbow Classic (1967-68, 1976-77, 1987-88 and 2006-07), the Chaminade Classic (1983-84) and the Maui Invitational (2001-02) in Hawaii.

MCKIVER NAMED TO ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Senior guard Robert McKiver was named to the All-Tournament team at the ESPNU Puerto Rico Tip-Off after scoring 71 points and six steals in three tournament games. The 71 points were the most points scored by an individual player. In addition, his career-best of 37 points against Charleston was the most points scored in a single game. In he tied his own school record for most three-point field goals in a game with nine against Charleston as well.

HOUSTON STORY LINES

- Houston looks to improve its record to 9-1 and win its eighth straight game when the Cougars play host to Southern in the sixth game of an eight-game home stand for the Cougars.
- Tom Penders enters the Southern game with a 592-401 career record. He tied former UH head coach Guy V. Lewis' career total of 592 wins with Houston's victory over Toledo.
- Robert McKiver was named Conference USA Co-Player of the Week on Dec. 3. He is the second Cougar to attain the honor this year. Brockeith Pane was named C-USA Player of the Week on Nov. 26.
- McKiver was named a Preseason All-Conference USA selection in a vote of league coaches.
- Senior forward Dion Dowell recorded his first double-double this season with 22 points and a career-best of 16 rebounds against Coastal Carolina.
- Lanny Smith has handed out five assists in two of his last three games. He also dished out a season-high eight assists against Charleston.
- Freshman guard Brockeith Pane recorded his third 20-point game against Grambling State with a career-best 26 points.

HOUSTON IN REGULAR SEASON TOURNAMENTS

The 2-1 record at the ESPNU Puerto Rico Tip-Off gives Houston an all-time record of 107-57 in regular season tournaments. The Cougars have won 29 tournament championships in school history. The last time the Cougars won a regular season tournament was in 1991-92 when they were co-champion with USC at the Disneyland Freedom Bowl Classic in Irvine, Calif. That tournament was a round-robin tourney with USC and Houston finishing with a 2-0 record. The last time Houston won an outright regular season tournament championship was in 1989-90 at the USF Holiday Classic in Tampa, Fla.

SIXTY-THREE SEASONS OF COUGAR BASKETBALL

Houston is in its 63rd season of intercollegiate basketball and enters the Southern game with an all-time record of 1,051-705. The Cougars have an all-time record of 650-197 in home games and own a 6-0 mark in home games this season.

Houston has played in 18 NCAA Tournaments, and has an all-time record of 26-23. The Cougars have advanced to five NCAA Final Fours and were NCAA Finalists twice.

UH has played in the NIT Postseason Tournament nine times, including two of the past three years. Houston advanced to the second round of the NIT for the first time since 1988 with a 77-67 victory over BYU in 2005-06. The Cougars advanced to the 1977 NIT Championship game.

GETTING TOUGH AT HOME

The Cougars enter the Southern game with a 42-7 record in home games under head coach Tom Penders. Houston has a 6-0 record in home games this season and posted records of 11-3 in 2006-07, 13-2 in 2005-06 and 12-2 in 2004-05 on the Guy V. Lewis Court at Hofheinz Pavilion.

The Cougars have a 431-124 all-time record on Guy V. Lewis Court. Houston will tie a school record by playing 18 home games throughout the regular season. The only other time that UH played 18 home games was during the 1972-73 campaign.

EARLIEST START

When Houston opened this season against Morehead State, it was the earliest season-opening game in school history. The previous earliest season opener was Nov. 13 when the Cougars won a 102-99 decision at Rhode Island to open the 2006-07 campaign.

HOUSTON IN NOVEMBER

Houston closed out the month of November with an all-time record of 59-33 after opening the 2007-08 season with a 6-1 record.

HOUSTON IN DECEMBER

Houston enters the Southern game with a 2-0 record during the month of December and owns an all-time record of 318-192 during December. Last season, the Cougars had a 1-5 mark in games played in December, giving UH an all-time record of 11-9 under Tom Penders during December. Houston posted a 5-2 record in 2004-05 and was 4-2 in 2005-06.

PENDERS RANKS SEVENTH IN WINS

Tom Penders ranks seventh among the nation's active NCAA Division I coaches with 592 career victories. His 592 wins also ties him with former UH legendary coach Guy V. Lewis for 34th place among all-time NCAA Division I coaches. Penders also is in 16th place among NCAA Division I coaches with eleven, 20-win seasons.

Coach Lewis ended his 30-year career with an all-time record of 592-279 in his 30 seasons as head coach at Houston. Earlier this year, he was inducted into the new College Basketball Hall of Fame on Nov. 18, 2007. The College Basketball Hall of Fame is located in Kansas City.

ESPN'S PAT FORDE LISTS TOM PENDERS

In his Nov. 5 Ford Minutes and Counting column, ESPN senior writer named Houston head coach Tom Penders among the five coaches doing an underrated job. The other four coaches he listed were Derek Whittenburg of Fordham, Blaine Taylor of Old Dominion, Scott Sutton of Oral Roberts and Doug Wojcik of Tulsa.

PENDERS NAMED MR. SPORTSMAN 2007

University of Houston head men's basketball coach Tom Penders received the "Mr. Sportsman 2007" from Interfaith Charities, Inc. on Nov. 6 at the Houstonian Hotel.

Each year Interfaith Charities honors an outstanding Houstonian for supporting IFC's purpose and leadership in the community. Proceeds from the dinner go directly to the IFC scholarship fund, which benefits a variety of Interfaith organizations from homes for the aged, to activities for inner-city schools to non-sectarian hospitals.

Penders joins former UH coaches Guy V. Lewis, Bill Yeoman and Pat Foster as UH coaches who have been named Mr. Sportsman. Lewis was honored in 1970, while Yeoman received the award in 1976 and Foster earned the honor in 1992.

FIVE SENIORS ON ROSTER

Houston has five senior players on its 2007-08 roster. They are Lanny Smith, Robert McKiver, Marcus Malone, Dion Dowell and Tafari Toney. Smith is a three-year letterman, while the other four began their Cougar careers in 2006-07.

TWO COUGARS WITH 20 POINTS IN A GAME

Seniors Dion Dowell and Robert McKiver became the first two UH players to score 20 points in the same game against Coastal Carolina when Dowell netted a game-high 22 points and McKiver tallied 21. It was the second time Dowell and McKiver has scored 20 or more points in a game this season. Dowell opened the season with a career-high 25 points against Morehead State, while McKiver equaled his career-high of 37 points against the College of Charleston.

MCKIVER AND 30-POINT GAMES

Robert McKiver recorded his second 30-point game of the season with 32 points against Middle Tennessee. He also scored a career-best 37 points against Charleston earlier this season. He has scored 30 points in six games during the past two years and is the first Cougar to record six 30-point games since Tim Moore accomplished the feat in 1993-95. McKiver is the seventh Cougar to register six 30-point games in their careers. The others are Elvin Hayes, Otis Birdsong, Rob Williams, Don Boldebuck, Ollie Taylor, Louis Dunbar and Moore.

DOWELL AND DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Dion Dowell also became the first Cougar to record a double-double this season when he registered 22 points and a career-best of 16 rebounds against Coastal Carolina. Dowell has recorded four double-doubles in his career. Last season, he had 24 points and a career-best 16 rebounds against Charlotte, 15 points and 11 boards against Creighton and 16 points and 12 rebounds against Rice.

DOWELL AND DOUBLE-FIGURE REBOUNDING GAMES

Senior forward Dion Dowell's 16 rebounds against Coastal Carolina gives him three double-figure rebounding games this season. Dowell also pulled down 12 rebounds against Marist and 11 boards against Texas Southern.

Dowell is leading Houston with 9.0 rebounds per game throughout the season.

DOWELL IN THE BLOCKED SHOTS COLUMN

Dion Dowell has blocked 14 shots in Houston's last five games. Dowell recorded one blocked shot against Toledo and Middle Tennessee after blocking two shots against Coastal Carolina, four shots versus Grambling State and a career-best of six shots against Texas Southern. He has led the Cougars in blocked shots during eight of Houston's nine games this season. He rejected three shots against Marist and one in Houston's other three games.

BOB COUSY AWARD CANDIDATE

Lanny Smith entered the 2007-08 season listed among the candidates for the Bob Cousy Award, given to the top point guard in the nation by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame. Smith is one of four UH point guards in school history to register 1,000 points and 375 assists during their career.

SMITH AMONG UH SCORING LEADERS

Lanny Smith enters the Southern game in 25th place among Houston's career scoring leaders with 1,137 points. Two seasons ago, he became the 40th Cougar to record 1,000 career points. He needs to score two points to move past Donnie Schverak for 24th place and 26 points to pass Don Boldebuck for 23rd place. Smith needs to score 100 more points to become one of the Top 20 scoring leaders in school history.

SMITH AND UH CAREER ASSISTS LEADERS

Smith also is ranked fifth among Houston's career leaders with 427 assists in 101 games during his collegiate career. He has averaged 4.2 assists per game throughout his career and that ranks ninth on the school's career list.

PANE AND 20-POINT GAMES

Freshman guard Brockette Pane registered his third 20-point game of the season when he netted a career-high 26 points against Grambling State. Pane also scored 20 points to against Texas Southern and 21 points against VCU in the first round of the ESPNU Puerto Rico Tip-Off.

TONY IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Senior post man Tafari Toney scored 11 points against Grambling State. It is the first time he scored in double figures this season. He previous season-high was nine points against Charleston. Toney scored in double figures three times last season.

NIXON IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Freshman guard Zamal Nixon made his first career start against Toledo after he registered career-bests of 14 points and seven assists against Middle Tennessee. He has scored in double figures four times this season. He also netted 12 points against Grambling State, 11 points versus VCU and 10 points against Texas Southern. Nixon tallied three points, two assists and two steals versus Toledo.

COUSIN IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Junior center Marcus Cousin recorded a season-best 10 points against Toledo, and that marked the third time this season he has scored in double figures this season. Cousin also scored 10 points against Coastal Carolina and Grambling State. Cousin netted a career-best 11 points against Morgan State as a sophomore at Seton Hall.

COUSIN ON THE BOARD

Marcus Cousin grabbed a career-best 10 rebounds against Morehead State in his UH debut. Cousin also grabbed eight rebounds against Toledo and Coastal Carolina. In between those two games, he pulled down seven rebounds against Middle Tennessee.

NEW FIREPOWER OFF THE BENCH

Freshman forward Yan Moukoury came off the bench to three points and two steals in eight minutes against Middle Tennessee after he registered five points and four rebounds in 16 minutes of action against Grambling State. Moukoury made his only three-point attempt against Middle Tennessee both of his field goal attempts, including his only shot behind the three-point line against Grambling State.

FIVE TRANSFERS ON 2007-08 ROSTER

Houston enters the 2007-08 season with five players who played at another NCAA Division I school previously. They also could appear on the court at the same time this year. They include Robert McKiver, Dion Dowell, Marcus Malone, Marcus Cousin and Kelvin Lewis. McKiver transferred to Houston from San Jacinto Junior College in Pasadena, Texas after playing his freshman season at Providence.

Dowell is a transfer from Texas, Malone played as a freshman at DePaul before playing his sophomore season at Lee College in Baytown, Texas.

This year, Cousin joins Houston's lineup after transferring from Seton Hall, and Lewis is a transfer from Auburn.

SIX RETURNING LETTERMEN

In addition to McKiver, Dowell and Malone returning from last season, Houston has three other lettermen returning from the 2006-07 campaign. They are senior forward Tafari Toney along with sophomores Nick Mosley and Kyle Hatcher.

JUNIOR COLLEGE ALL-AMERICAN

For the third straight year, Houston inked a junior college All-American player when DaShaun Williams of Monroe College signed with the Cougars. Williams was a Third-Team All-America selection after he ranked 22nd nationally with 6.2 assists per game to go along with 17.8 points and 5.2 rebounds per contest.

FOUR FRESHMEN JOIN 2007-08 ROSTER

Houston also added four freshman players to its 2007-08 roster, the most freshmen that have signed with the Cougars under Tom Penders. They are Brockeith Pane from Carter High School in Dallas, Horace McGloster from Genesis One Christian Academy and Shabazz High School in Newark, N.J., Yan Moukoury from Christian Life High School in Baton Rouge, La., and Zamal Nixon from Boys and Girls High School in Brooklyn, N.Y.

TALLEST COUGAR UNDER TOM PENDERS

Junior Marcus Cousin is the tallest player to play at Houston under head coach Tom Penders. The 6-foot, 11-inch Cousin transferred to Houston from Seton Hall following the 2005-06 season.

Following the Southern game, Houston closes out its eight-game homestand when the Cougars play host to the University of Kentucky on Dec. 18 and Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Dec. 29.
