ISU Faces Houston In Final Non-Conference Road Test

Cyclone Notebook

▶ Iowa State (7-4) travels to Houston (7-1) on Sunday in its final non-conference road game of the season...this will be the first of three trips to the state of Texas for the Cyclones...ISU begins Big 12 Conference play at Texas (Jan. 10) and will play at Texas A&M on Feb. 28.

▶ ISU will wrap up its non-conference portion of the season with three consecutive home games (Mercer, SIU-Edwardsville, Houston Baptist) after the Houston game.

▶ ISU will try and regroup after a 65-58 loss at home to South Dakota State on Tuesday... it was the first time the Cyclones lost to the Jackrabbits, falling to 5-1 lifetime vs. South Dakota State.

▶ The Cyclones never could quite get on track vs. SDSU, committing a season-high 16 turnovers and shooting 37.7 percent from the field, including a season-half-low 27.6 percent in the second period.

▶ Craig Brackins and Lucca Staiger have been two of ISU's most consistent performers in recent games...Brackins, who has scored in double figures in 10 of 11 games this year, ranks seventh in the Big 12 in scoring (17.1) and fifth in rebounding (7.6)...Staiger has made 19-of-37 shots (51.4 percent) from 3-point range in his last five games.

Head Coach Greg McDermott



Greg McDermott was introduced as the 18th men's basketball coach in Iowa State history on March 21, 2006. McDermott, who elevated the University of Northern Iowa program to unprecedented success with three consecutive NCAA appearances, is considered one of the nation's best young coaches.

McDermott has compiled a 29-34 mark in two seasons as the Cyclone mentor, coaching three players who have earned All-Big 12 recognition in Mike Taylor, Wesley Johnson and Jiri Hubalek. Taylor, who was one of McDermott's first recruits, was drafted in the second round of the 2008 NBA Draft and is currently on the roster of the Los Angeles Clippers.

McDermott's meteoric rise in the head coaching ranks occurred in his five seasons as the head coach at his alma mater (2002-06). After taking over a program that had not posted a winning season since 1997, McDermott's recipe for success launched the UNI program into the national spotlight. In his third season with the Panthers, McDermott led UNI to the 2004 Missouri Valley Conference Tournament title and its second NCAA Tournament appearance in school history while recording a 21-10 mark. He followed that season with two more NCAA Tournament appearances in 2005 and 2006.

The 44-year-old McDermott compiled a 90-63 record at UNI. McDermott received his first head coaching job at Wayne State (Neb.) from 1995-2000. He led the Wildcats to four-straight 20-win seasons, one Northern Sun Conference title and a pair of NCAA Division II Tournament appearances.

Last Time Out

► Iowa State never got on track in its last game, falling 65-58 to South Dakota State on Tuesday...ISU committed a season-high 16 turnovers and shot 37.7 percent from the floor, its second-lowest output of the season.

► ISU was up at the half, 32-30, but shot just 27.6 percent from the field in the second half.

► It was just the fourth time this season where the Cyclones shot worse than their opponent (42.6%-37.7%)...ISU is 0-4 in those games.

► ISU's 58 points scored was the second-lowest total of the season...the Cyclones have been held below 60 points three times this season (Hawaii, Iowa, South Dakota State).

► ISU, which ranked 18th nationally and second in the Big 12 in assist/turnover ratio (1.28), had more turnovers (16) than assists (13) for only the fourth time this season.

► ISU was led by Craig Brackins, who tallied 18 points and five rebounds...Brackins currently ranks seventh in the Big 12 in scoring (17.1) and fifth in rebounding (7.6)...Brackins is averaging 17.8 points and 10.5 rebounds in his last six games.

► Lucca Staiger recorded 12 points on 3-of-6 shooting from 3-point range...Staiger made two late 3-pointers to keep ISU's chances alive vs. SDSU on Tuesday...Staiger ranks eighth in the Big 12 in 3-pointers made per game at 2.4.

► Staiger has dramatically increased his productivity in recent games...the sophomore is averaging 13.2 points and is shooting 19-of-37 (51.3 percent) from 3-point range in his last five games...he is shooting 44.1 percent from 3-point range to rank ninth in the league and it rates as the seventh-best percentage in ISU's season 3-point percentage charts (minimum 20 made).

► Diante Garrett totaled five points, seven boards and five assists in the loss...it marks this sixth time this season where Garrett handed out five or more dimes in a game.

► ISU currently ranks first in the Big 12 in field goal percentage defense (37.8 percent)...SDSU was just the second team this season to shoot above 40 percent from the field against Iowa State.

► Bryan Petersen scored eight points and recorded four assists for ISU...Petersen drilled 2-of-6 shots from downtown to give him 64 treys in his career...he now ranks 18th all-time in school history in career 3-pointers.

Cyclone-Cougar Quick Facts

► Iowa State and Houston will meet for the fifth time...UH owns a 3-1 all-time mark vs. the Cyclones, winning the last three meetings.

► ISU won the first meeting on Dec. 3, 1956 in Ames (92-73)...ISU All-American Gary Thompson set a school record by making 19 free-throws in the game.

► UH won the last meeting in Charlotte, N.C., 87-72 on Nov. 30, 1990...the two teams have only met once in Houston, a 83-82 win for the Cougars on Jan. 10, 1990.

► UH head coach Tom Penders, who is in his 35th season as a head coach, has a 1-1 record vs. Iowa State...he coached against the Cyclones twice when he was head coach at Texas from 1989-98...his Longhorns upset No. 7 ISU in 1997, 57-56 in Austin...ISU returned the favor the next season in Penders' final year at UT, 85-82 in Ames.

► ISU is 12-9 all-time vs. Conference USA teams.

► UH assistant coach Kevin Lewis was an assistant coach at Baylor from 1999-2001, facing the Cyclones four times.

► Former Cyclone Sam Mack, who played one season at ISU (1988-89), ended his collegiate career at Houston...he later went onto a successful career in the NBA.

► ISU and Houston have one common opponent this season in Mississippi Valley State...UH downed the Delta Devils, 92-58 and the Cyclones won their game vs. MVSU, 77-59.

A Closer Look At Houston (7-1)

- ▶ Houston is off to a great start with a 7-1 mark...the only Cougar blemish was a 65-63 loss to Georgia Southern in the season opener.
- ▶ UH won at Toledo in its last game, 71-63...junior guard Kelvin Lewis tallied 21 points and junior Aubrey Coleman posted a double-double with 15 points and 13 boards.
- ▶ Lewis ranks 61st nationally in scoring at 19.1 ppg and is a serious threat from downtown...Lewis is averaging 4.1 3-pointers per game to rank fourth nationally, connecting on 33-of-74 from 3-point range (44.6 percent)...he has four 20+ games this season.
- ▶ Lewis' backcourt mate Aubrey Coleman is averaging 16.4 points and ranks fourth nationally in steals per game at 3.4 spg.
- ▶ Freshman point guard Desmond Wade is averaging 8.5 ppg and has a team-high 50 assists...his 6.3 apg average ranks 25th nationally.
- ▶ 6-11 center Marcus Cousin nearly averages a double-double (14.5 pts.; 9.8 reb.) through eight games...Cousin ranks 26th nationally in rebounds per game.
- ▶ UH averages 79.9 ppg (27th nationally) and is holding its opponents to 36.5 percent from the floor (14th nationally).
- ▶ Like ISU, the Cougars don't turn the ball over often...ISU ranks 10th nationally in fewest turnovers per game (11.8 tpg), but the Cougars rank No. 1 in the nation in least amount of turnovers, averaging, just 9.1 tpg.
- ▶ UH's 1.62 assist/turnover ratio is third nationally.

Bombs Away!

- ▶ I guess the ISU basketball team did not get the memo that the 3-point line was moved back a foot.
- ▶ ISU is averaging 8.1 3-pointers made per game at a 36.6 percent clip...ISU is fourth in the Big 12 in 3-pointers made.
- ▶ The Cyclones have netted 10 or more treys five times this season, including a school-record 15 on 27 attempts (55.6%) vs. UW-Milwaukee...ISU failed to hit double digit 3-pointers in a single game once last season...two of the best team 3-point shooting games in ISU history have occurred in the first 11 games of this year.
- ▶ At its current 8.1 3FG made per game rate, ISU is on pace to shatter its previous mark for 3-pointers made in a season...the current mark is owned by the 2005-06 squad at 6.7 3FG made per game.
- ▶ The Cyclones' top-five bombers (Lucca Staiger, Wes Eikmeier, Bryan Petersen, Sean Haluska, Jamie Vanderbeken) have combined for 76 of ISU's 89 treys.
- ▶ Staiger made eight 3-pointers, including his first six attempts, vs. Drake to fall one shy of the ISU single-game school mark...the sophomore has recorded four games with four or more 3-pointers this year...he ranks ninth in the Big 12 in 3-point accuracy (44.1 pct) and eighth in 3-pointers per game (2.4 3FG pg).
- ▶ Petersen ranks as one of the most accurate 3-point shooters in school history ranks 18th all-time on ISU's career 3-pointers made chart (64).
- ▶ Eikmeier, a true freshman, has made 16 treys...Eikmeier is on pace to be one of the best rookie sharpshooters in school history.

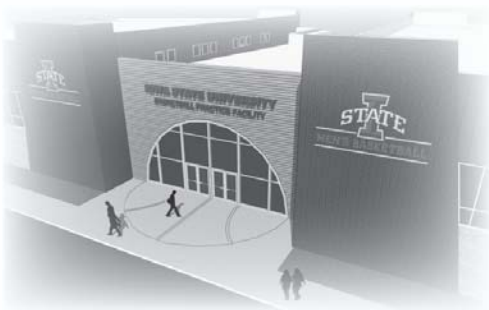

ISU's New Practice Facility



Iowa State University announced plans for a 35,000-square foot basketball practice facility. Ground was broken in August of 2008 and the new facility is slated to open as soon as October of 2009. The state-of-the-art facility is located on two acres of land on the west side of Ames that is being donated to the Iowa State University Foundation for this purpose by local developer Dickson Jensen.

The facility will cost approximately \$8 million and will be funded entirely with private support. The facility will be dedicated exclusively to the men's and women's basketball programs, including separate gymnasiums, locker rooms, weight room, film room, player lounges, and coaches' offices for each team.

"The addition of a basketball practice facility is a key component to the future of our men's and women's basketball programs. The proposed facility will be equal to any college practice facility in the country. The opportunity to move our basketball program into a full-service, basketball dedicated facility in just over a year is a huge recruiting tool for our staff."

60 Is The Magic Number

► Greg McDermott's Cyclone teams have always had the reputation for solid defense...ISU has held all but five teams this year to 60 points or less and have allowed just two teams (Iowa, South Dakota State) to shoot above 40 percent from the field this season.

► Now in his third year at the helm, McDermott is a perfect 21-0 when an opponent fails to score 60 points.

Stingy Defense

► Through 11 games, ISU has allowed just two opponents (Iowa, South Dakota State) to shoot above 40 percent from the field this season, keeping its opponents at a 37.8 percent clip to lead the Big 12 in field goal percentage defense.

► The Cyclones are holding their opponents to 61.2 ppg (ranking second in the Big 12) and have allowed just one opponent to score over 70 points.

Assists Are Up; Turnovers Down

► The Cyclones have done a remarkable job so far taking care of the basketball while being efficient on the offensive end.

► ISU has handed out 17 or more assists in six of 11 games, including dishing out 20 or more twice...the Cyclones have tallied more assists than turnovers in seven games this season and have recorded two games with under 10 turnovers.

► ISU ranks in the top-15 nationally and first in the Big 12 in fewest turnovers (11.8 tpg).

► ISU is on pace to break the season school mark for fewest turnover average per game of 12.9 set by the 1998-99 squad.

► ISU currently ranks second in the Big 12 in assist/turnover ratio at 1.3.

► Diante Garrett ranks sixth in the Big 12 in assist/turnover ratio (2.1 a/t).

Petersen One of ISU's Most Efficient Playmakers; Shooters

▶ Senior Bryan Petersen ranks in ISU's career top-11 in both assist/turnover ratio and 3-point accuracy.

▶ Petersen's 1.67 assist/turnover ratio rates as the ninth-best in school history with a minimum of 100 assists...he currently ranks 10th in the Big 12 in a/t ratio this season at 1.9 a/t.

▶ Petersen has made 64-of-170 3-pointers in his career for a 37.6 percentage...that percentage is 11th-best in school history with a minimum of 50 made...his 64 career ranks 18th all-time in the career record book.

Brackins Taking The Next Step

▶ Craig Brackins was one of the highest-rated recruits to ever sign with the Cyclones and the sophomore is living up to the hype.

▶ Brackins is seventh in the Big 12 in scoring (17.1), tallying 10 or more points in 10 of 11 games, including four 20+ games and one 30-point outing.

▶ Brackins has started all 43 games and has nine 20-point games in his career.

▶ Brackins tallied his second 30-point game of his career with 32 points and 16 boards at UNI...he is the 21st Cyclone in school history to have multiple 30-point games.

▶ He earned co-Big 12 Player of the Week (Dec. 8) after averaging 22.5 points and 13.0 rebounds in wins over Northern Iowa and Oregon State.

▶ He was the first Cyclone to register a 30-point/15-board performance since Loren Meyer tallied 31 points and 15 boards vs. Nebraska on March 5, 1995.

▶ Brackins, who ranks fifth in the Big 12 in rebounding (7.6 rpg), is averaging 10.5 rpg in his last six games.

▶ He grabbed a career-high 17 boards vs. Jacksonville State, the most by a Cyclone since Jared Homan registered 20 rebounds vs. North Carolina (3-20-05).

▶ Brackins has posted double-doubles in three of the last six games.

Garrett Is ISU's Playmaker

▶ Sophomore Diante Garrett's improvement has been a key to ISU's success this season...Garrett is second on the team in scoring (10.5 ppg) and ranks fifth in the Big 12 and in the top-50 nationally in assists (5.3 apg).

▶ Garrett, who dished out a career-high 11 assists vs. Loyola-Marymount, has the sixth-best assist/turnover ratio in the Big 12 (2.1 a/t).

▶ Garrett has dished out five or more assists in six games...he has two double-digit assist games (11 vs. LMU; 10 vs. Drake).

▶ The Milwaukee, Wis., native poured in a career-high 26 points at Hawaii, making 10-of-10 from the free-throw line...it was just the 16th time in school history where a Cyclone was perfect from the charity stripe with 10 or more attempts.

because he played on a German club team that had two players receive extra compensation according to the NCAA...Staiger did not receive any money or extra benefits, but the NCAA declared his team as "professional" because the two players received extra compensation.

► This season started slow for Staiger after undergoing knee surgery in October...he is slowly getting back into shape and the Cyclones are reaping the benefits.

► Staiger is averaging 8.3 ppg and leads the team in 3-pointers made (26) and 3-point accuracy (44.1 pct.)...Staiger ranks ninth in the Big 12 in 3-point percentage and eighth in 3-pointers made per game (2.4).

► The Blaustein, Germany native had a breakout game vs. Drake, scoring a career-high 24 points behind a career-high eight 3-pointers (8-11 FG)...he made his first six 3-point attempts in the game...his eight treys ties for second in school history for most 3-pointers made in a game.

► He was named Big 12 Rookie of the Week (Dec. 15) after averaging 16.5 points and making 11-of-16 shots from downtown (68.7 pct.) in games vs. Drake and Iowa.

► He has three games this season with four or more treys.

► In his last five games, Staiger is averaging 13.2 points and has netted 19-of-37 shots from downtown (51.4%).

Eikmeier Sparks ISU From Bench

► True freshman Wes Eikmeier has given the Cyclones a needed lift from the bench this season, averaging 6.1 ppg.

► An outstanding shooter, opposing defenses must be aware where the rookie is at all times on the court...Eikmeier is second on the team in 3-pointers made with 16.

► Eikmeier has made a trey in all but four games and has five multiple 3-pointers made games, including a career-high five treys vs. LMU, which is the third-best single-game output by an ISU freshman in school history.

Hilton Magic

► Hilton Coliseum has long been considered one of the toughest places to play in college basketball...built in 1971 and playing in its 38th season, ISU has recorded a 74.1 percent winning mark, compiling a 415-145 record.

► ISU has recorded four undefeated seasons at home since Hilton was erected (1985-86, 1992-93, 1999-00, 2000-01).

► ISU ranked 23rd nationally in attendance in 2007-08 (13,316).

It's In The Genes

► ISU has a number of players on its roster with outstanding athletic genes.

► Sophomore Charles Boozer and senior Sean Haluska have brothers who played in the NBA...Boozer's brother, Carlos, is one of the top post players in the NBA, making the NBA All-Star game the last two seasons...Boozer averaged 21.1 points and 10.4 rebounds in 2007-08...he was also a member of the USA Basketball team that won the Gold Medal at the 2008 Olympics in Beijing.

► Haluska's brother, Adam, who played one year at Iowa State (2002-03) before transferring to Iowa, was on the Miami Heat and Houston Rockets roster last season...Haluska led the Big Ten in scoring in 2006-07, averaging 20.5 ppg while earning first-team all-Big Ten honors.

► Sophomore Diante Garrett also has outstanding basketball roots...his father, Dick, played five seasons in the NBA for the Los Angeles Lakers, Buffalo Braves, New York Knicks and Milwaukee Bucks, averaging 10.3 ppg...Garrett played in the 1970 NBA Finals (Lakers) and the 1974 NBA Finals (Bucks).

► Freshman Justin Hamilton's parents were both elite athletes at Brigham Young in the mid-1980s...his father, Larry, was a two-sport star with the Cougars...he was a two-time

► ISU has seven newcomers on the team this year- five freshmen, one transfer from a Division I school and one junior college transfer.

► Scott Christopherson is the only Cyclone on the roster who is ineligible to play this year...he transferred from Marquette and will sit out as a redshirt under NCAA rules.

► Not one player on the ISU roster played a single minute in head coach Greg McDermott's first season at ISU two years ago (2006-07).

► ISU has 15 players on the roster...13 are on scholarship and two are walk-ons...senior Sean Haluska and sophomore Cameron Lee are the only two players on the team not on scholarship.

► Senior Bryan Petersen was a recruited walk-on, but has been placed on scholarship in both of his two seasons with the Cyclones.

► 11 of the 15 players on the roster are freshmen or sophomores.

► ISU has players from eight states (Iowa, Wisconsin, Michigan, North Carolina, California, Utah, Nebraska and Kansas) on the roster and two international players (Canada and Germany)...Jamie Vanderbeken is the first Canadian to play for ISU and Lucca Staiger is the first German to suit up for the Cyclones.

► ISU head coach Greg McDermott is the first native Iowan to coach the Cyclones since Clayton Sutherland (1948-54)...McDermott is from Cascade; Sutherland was from Nashua.

Iowa State Inks Strong Recruiting Class

► ISU signed just two players in the early period, but they are both good ones.

► The Cyclones got signatures from Marquis Gilstrap (6-6, 210, F, Covington, Ga.), who is competing at Gulf Coast Community College, and Chris Colvin (6-2, 175, G, Chicago, Ill.), one of the best prep players out of Illinois.

► Gilstrap will have one year of eligibility next year and has already put up strong numbers in his first year at Gulf Coast.

► Colvin is ranked as the 92nd-best player in the nation by Rivals.com and Scout.com lists him as the 10th-best point guard in the class of 2009.
