UCF FASTBREAK

• With only two regular-season contests remaining, the Knights head to Houston for a key Conference USA game. UCF is one game behind the Cougars in the C-USA standings.

THE COACHES

• **Kirk Speraw** (Iowa, 1980) is in his 15th season as UCF's head coach. He owns a 247-199 record at UCF. In his 18th year as a head coach, he has a 329-220 mark. In 2006-07, he was named the Conference USA Coach of the Year.
• **Tom Penders** (Connecticut, 1967) is 78-46 in his fourth year at Houston. In 34 years as a head coach, he is 605-407.

SERIES INFORMATION

• The Cougars have a 4-2 edge in the all-time series with UCF. In Houston, each team has claimed a victory. On Feb. 2 in Orlando, the Cougars made 16-of-42 3-point field goal attempts to hold on for an 84-81 win over UCF. Jermaine Taylor totaled 31 points for the hosts, while Houston's Robert McKiver also finished with 31 points.
• Last year when the squads met in Houston, UCF led by 20 points at halftime, but McKiver scored 25 of his game-high 36 points after halftime to lift the Cougars to a 73-70 win in overtime. Lavell Payne made 13-of-16 free-throw attempts for the Knights and recorded 26 points.

ABOUT HOUSTON

• The Cougars feature one of the nation's top scorers in Robert McKiver. The shooting guard is second in Conference USA, averaging 23.1 points. On Feb. 27, he scored 52 points in a win over Southern Miss.
• Houston is 15-2 at home this season. On the year, the squad is averaging 78.9 points and nearly 11 3-pointers per game.
• On Saturday, McKiver scored 29 points as Houston fell 84-83 at East Carolina. McKiver hit four triples against the Pirates and is connecting on 4.3 treys per game. Dion Dowell is averaging 11.1 points and a team-high 6.6 rebounds.

UP NEXT FOR THE KNIGHTS

• The Knights will conclude the regular season on Saturday at Tulsa. The contest will mark the first time since the program joined Conference USA in 2005 that UCF will conclude the regular season with a road game. The all-time series with Tulsa is tied, 3-3. On Jan. 12, UCF topped the Golden Hurricane 97-91 in triple overtime in the inaugural Conference USA contest inside the new UCF Arena. Jermaine Taylor totaled seven of his 28 points in the final extra session, including a pair of 3-pointers.

LAST TIME OUT

• Jermaine Taylor scored 20 points and Dave Noel added 19 points as UCF held on for a 68-60 win over Rice on Saturday at the new UCF Arena. Noel and UCF's four other seniors were playing at home for the final time. The Knights finished with a 38-31 edge on the glass.

CONFERENCE USA SUCCESS

• Since joining Conference USA prior to the 2005-06 campaign, the Knights have won 27 league contests, a mark that ranks fourth among the 12 C-USA programs during that span. Memphis has won 44 C-USA games in the last three years, followed by Houston (29) and UAB (29).
• UCF entered C-USA with five other programs and has won the most games among the new schools. Besides the Knights, UTEP (24) and Tulsa (22) have posted the most league victories among the new members.
• With the move to C-USA, the Knights have faced the biggest increase in competition, having previously competed in the Atlantic Sun. Rice, SMU, Tulsa and UTEP joined C-USA from the Western Athletic and Marshall came to the conference from the Mid-American. In 2006-07, UCF went 11-5 in C-USA play to finish second in the 12-team league.

ONE OF FLORIDA'S FINEST

• In the last six years, head coach Kirk Speraw's UCF program has enjoyed great success, winning 122 games. Dating back to the start of the 2002-03 campaign, the mark ranks second among the 11 programs in the state of Florida that have sponsored Division I basketball during that entire time. UCF is ahead of both Florida State (105) and Miami (91) of the Atlantic Coast Conference during the span.

FAMILIAR TERRITORY

• The contest against the Cougars will serve as the Knights' fourth game in Texas this season and third trip to the Houston-area this year. The squad has already faced Sam Houston State and Rice. The Knights also met SMU in Dallas.
• Since joining Conference USA in 2005, UCF has played nine games in the Lone Star State.

WELCOME BACK

• Houston native Chip Cartwright will be playing in front of his friends and family when UCF faces the Cougars. Cartwright attended Phillis Wheatley High School in Houston. In his two years with the Knights, Cartwright has already played in the Houston-area on four occasions.

JUMP START

• In the Knights' previous two games at Houston, UCF dominated in the first half, outscoring the Cougars 71-44 before intermission. A year ago, the Knights led 35-15 at the break. During the 2005-06 matchup, UCF took a 36-29 edge into halftime.

• The Knights shot a combined 54.5 percent overall in the first half in the two previous meetings in Texas.

DAY ONE

• The Knights are 5-1 when playing on Wednesday in 2007-08. UCF will be playing a road game on a Wednesday for the first time this year when it faces Houston.

• UCF has averaged 85.4 points on 54.2 percent shooting from the floor during its Wednesday games.

ON TARGET

• In league games, the Knights pace Conference USA in field goal percentage. The squad is shooting 47.4 percent from the floor against conference foes.

THE SCORE

• Against Conference USA opponents, the Knights are averaging 77.4 points. UCF has scored at least 80 points against conference foes on six occasions.

• In non-conference games in 2007-08, UCF averaged 71.6 points. Last year, the Knights averaged 69.6 points in C-USA contests.

FRESH START

• After using just one starting lineup through the first 16 contests of the season, Kirk Speraw has utilized four different lineups in the last four games. Nine different Knights have started during that span: Mike O'Donnell (4), Dave Noel (4), Jermaine Taylor (2), Stanley Billings (2), Kenrick Zondervan (2), Mike Battle (1), Chip Cartwright (1), Tony Davis (1) and Taylor Young (1).

• Battle and Cartwright both earned the first starts of their careers on Saturday against Rice on senior night. Young became the first freshman to start for the Knights since the 2002-03 season when he appeared in the lineup versus Tulane on Feb. 27.

TRIPLE PLAY

• After making just 20 total 3-pointers in their previous four contests, the Knights made 40 triples in their last four games. The squad shot 43.5 percent from deep in those contests.

HALF NELSON

• This season, the Knights are 16-2 when leading at halftime. In the last two years, the squad is 33-6 when taking a lead into intermission.

• In the first half of games this season, UCF boasts a +6.0 scoring margin. The team is shooting 45.9 percent from the field before intermission.

THE GIVING SEASON

• The Knights have been sharing the ball in Conference USA play. The squad paces the league, averaging 15.6 assists versus conference foes. The Knights have recorded at least 15 assists in nine of their 14 league games.

• On two occasions against league foes, UCF has recorded 25 assists. Three Knights have registered at least 80 assists in 2007-08, led by Chip Cartwright with 96.

SCORING MACHINE

• Jermaine Taylor is fourth in Conference USA and 17th nationally in scoring, averaging 21.2 points per game. The junior has paced the Knights in points in 23 of UCF's 28 contests this season and has scored at least 20 points on 19 occasions.

THE REST IS HISTORY

• This season, Taylor has scored 593 points. The total is the most by any Knight since the school joined the Division I ranks in 1984. The 593 points are good for ninth on the school's single-season scoring register.
 • Bo Clark scored a UCF-record 806 points during the 1976-77 season. All-time, UCF players have recorded more than 600 points in a campaign on only eight occasions.
 • Taylor is the first Knight to score over 500 points in a campaign since the 2003-04 season, when Dexter Lyons recorded 567 points. A year ago, Josh Peppers was the Knights' leading scorer. In 31 games, he totaled 442 points for a 14.3 average.

ON THE RISE

• In just his third season in Orlando, Taylor ranks 13th all-time at UCF with 1,118 points. On Feb. 6 against Marshall, he totaled a career-high 34 points and in the process, became just the 14th 1,000-point scorer in program history.
 • He became the second member of his family to join the 1,000-point club at UCF. His cousin, Darryl Davis, scored 1,540 points with the Knights from 1991-95. Davis played for head coach Kirk Speraw for two seasons.
 • Paul Reed (1999-02) is 12th at UCF with 1,182 points.

ON POINT

• Taylor has been accurate shooting the ball this year, connecting at a 48.7 percent clip from the floor. The percentage ranks 13th in Conference USA. Against league foes, he is shooting 51.1 percent overall.

DIALING IN FROM LONG DISTANCE

• Taylor has connected on 69 3-pointers this season. That number is good for ninth on UCF's single-season register.
 • He is eighth all-time at UCF with 149 triples. His rise on the career 3-pointers chart is impressive, as he hit just 17 treys as a rookie in 2005-06.

NUMBERS GAME

• Prior to this year, a UCF player had not scored at least 30 points in a game since the 2004-05 campaign. Taylor has achieved the feat on four occasions this season. He scored over 30 points in consecutive games (vs. Houston - Feb. 2; vs. Marshall - Feb. 6), becoming the first Knight to log back-to-back 30-point performances since the school moved to Division I in 1984. He totaled 31 points against Houston and recorded a career-best 34 points versus Marshall.
 • He is the first UCF player to have more than three 30-point performances since the school joined the Division I ranks. Ken Leeks had the previous high with three 30-point games in 1991-92.

SUNSHINE SCORER

• Not only does Taylor rank 17th nationally in scoring, he is tops among all players in Florida as well. Thirteen schools in Florida sponsor Division I basketball and Taylor's average is first among all players from those programs. Miami's Jack McClinton (17.0) is second in the state in points per game.

GETTING TO THE GLASS

• Despite standing 6-foot-4, Taylor is second on the team in rebounds per game (4.7). Against Conference USA opponents, he is averaging 5.0 boards. This year, 47 of his 85 boards (55.2 percent) have come on the offensive end.

BIGGER AND BETTER

• Each season at UCF, Taylor has shown great improvement on the court. In 2006-07, he averaged 12.7 points as UCF's sixth man. As a freshman the previous season, Taylor averaged 4.3 points in 11.7 minutes per game. He shot just 39.5 percent overall and 30.4 percent from 3-point range as a rookie.

BIG MAN ON CAMPUS

• Following his 24-point performance in just 22 minutes against UTEP on Jan. 23, Taylor was named one of three "Big Men On Campus" during ESPN's *College GameNight*. Taylor made 9-of-12 field goals in the win over the Miners and hit three 3-pointers.

WEEKLY WONDER

• Taylor has garnered a pair of Conference USA Player of the Week honors this season. After leading the Knights to a 2-0 start in C-USA play, Taylor won the award on Jan. 14. He averaged 20.5 points and 8.5 rebounds in a pair of contests.
 • In the Knights' '97-91 triple-overtime victory over Tulsa, Taylor played a career-high 49 minutes and led all players with 28 points. He also paced UCF with nine boards.
 • On Dec. 31, he was named the C-USA Player of the Week for the first time in his career. He earned the award after averaging 25.2 points in a pair of games.

KNIGHT COURT

• The Knights' inaugural season at the new UCF Arena was a success. Not only did the team go 12-4 at home, but the program also established a new attendance record.

• A school record 78,253 fans attended 16 home contests for an average of 4,891. A year ago, a then-school record 43,296 spectators witnessed the Knights play 16 home games at the old UCF Arena.

• This year, 10 of the top-12 crowds in school history were recorded. A UCF record 7,097 fans were on hand on Jan. 12 as the Knights hosted Tulsa in the inaugural Conference USA game at the new facility.

OVER TIME

• In 28 contests this year, Mike O'Donnell has logged 957 minutes, which ranks eighth on UCF's single-season register. He is averaging 34.2 minutes per game, good for seventh in Conference USA.

• Jermaine Taylor (926) and Dave Noel (916) are both approaching the top 10 on UCF's single-season minutes played list. Gary Johnson played a school record 1,086 minutes in 2004-05 as the Knights advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second-straight season.

• O'Donnell has played at least 35 minutes on 16 occasions. In UCF's triple-overtime victory over Tulsa on Jan. 12, Noel spent 51 minutes on the floor. Taylor played 49 minutes in the victory and O'Donnell logged 44 minutes.

CLOSE CALLS

• UCF's 12 losses this year have come by an average of 6.7 points. Five of the losses were by three points or less and three defeats came in overtime.

• The Knights fell to No. 18 Kansas State and traditional power Connecticut by a combined five points. Sixteen of UCF's total games this season have been decided by 10 points or less.

TRIPLE TROUBLE

• UCF has connected on 208 3-pointers in 2007-08. That mark is fifth on the school's single-season 3-point field goals made list. The 2004-05 squad hit a record 283 treys.

THE INJURY REPORT

• The health of the Knights was a big reason why UCF went 22-9 in 2006-07. In UCF's 12-man rotation a year ago, only one player missed any games due to injury (Stanley Billings-three).

• The 2007-08 campaign has been different. After averaging 7.5 points in UCF's first two contests of the year, backup guard Mike Battle missed 11 games with a leg injury. Billings, the team's starting center, missed seven games in Conference USA play because of an injury to his elbow. Freshman Chris Baez, who was expected to be one of the team's top perimeter players off the bench, is out for the season with a knee injury.

KNOWING IS HALF THE BATTLE

• In his first 12 games of the season, Mike Battle totaled just 33 points. Battle was a major contributor for the Knights in the team's last four contests, scoring a combined 42 points in games against East Carolina, Marshall, Tulane and Rice.

• He averaged 10.5 points during the span and shot 68.4 percent from the floor and 66.7 percent from deep, making 10-of-15 3-point field goal attempts.

• On the year, 18 of his 24 made field goals have been from 3-point range.

STAN'S BLOCK PARTY

• When Stanley Billings missed seven games in Conference USA play due to an injury, UCF registered 13 blocked shots without its starting center. In their last three contests with Billings back in the lineup, the Knights totaled 11 swats.

• Billings has recorded five blocks after returning to action and matched a career best with four swats against Rice on Saturday.

PERIMETER POWER

• UCF is starting three guards in 2007-08 and the trio of perimeter players - Mike O'Donnell, Dave Noel and Jermaine Taylor - have accounted for 61.4 percent of the Knights' points. Taylor (21.2) paces the Knights in scoring, followed by Noel (13.0) and O'Donnell (11.6).

• The three players have combined to make 174 of UCF's 208 3-pointers this season.

STEPPING BACK

• In his first two campaigns with the Knights, Dave Noel rarely shot the ball from 3-point range. He attempted 79 triples, making 26 (32.9 percent).

• Now in his third year at UCF, the senior has not been shy about shooting from deep this season and the results have paid off for the Knights. Noel has made 35-of-75 attempts from behind-the-arc in 2007-08. He paces Conference USA in 3-point field goal percentage (46.7).

SO MUCH BETTER

• In each season at UCF, Dave Noel has exhibited great improvement offensively. This year, he is second on the team in scoring at 13.0 points per game. A year ago, Noel averaged 9.1 points. In his first campaign with the Knights after transferring from UNC-Wilmington, Noel totaled 2.8 points per game as the team's backup point guard in 2005-06. In 2007-08, Noel is shooting 51.3 percent overall.

DEEP COVER

• In the win over East Carolina on Feb. 20, Mike O'Donnell moved to second on UCF's career 3-pointers list. He has connected on 190 treys in three years with the Knights. Jason Thornton (1998-02) is the school's all-time leader in the category with 220 3-pointers. O'Donnell's former teammate Josh Peppers (2003-07) is third with 180 triples.

SHOT CALLER

• Mike O'Donnell struggled with his shooting touch in non-conference play, making just 32.1 percent of his shots from the field. O'Donnell is now shooting the ball with great confidence. In Conference USA games, the senior is shooting 44.5 percent overall.

• In non-league action, he made just 33.3 percent of his tries from 3-point range, but has turned around his shooting from deep as well. In C-USA games, he is eighth in the league, shooting at a 39.6 percent clip from long distance.

MOVING UP THE CHARTS

• In just his third season with the Knights after transferring from NC State, Mike O'Donnell is making his mark in the UCF record book. He is currently listed in five career statistical categories: 3-point field goals (190-2nd), 3-point field goal attempts (490-3rd), 3-point field goal percentage (.388-9th), assists (317-5th) and steals (138-8th).

GIVING IT AND TAKING IT AWAY

• Mike O'Donnell is one of just four players in UCF history who have dished out at least 300 assists and also recorded 130 or more steals. O'Donnell registered his 300th career assist while with the Knights at No. 1 Memphis on Feb. 9. Sinua Phillips (531 assists/179 steals), Cory Perry (512 assists/205 steals) and Bo Clark (302 assists/133 steals) are the only Knights who have achieved the feat.

FROM DOWNTOWN

• This year, Mike O'Donnell has connected on 70 3-pointers, which ranks eighth on the school's single-season register. Dexter Lyons hit 72 in 2003-04, which is good for seventh on the list.
 • O'Donnell's 192 3-point field goal attempts this season rank fifth at UCF. In 2007-08, 70 of O'Donnell's 101 (69.3 percent) made field goals have come from 3-point range.

TOP OF THE LINE

• In his third campaign with the Knights, Dave Noel ranks fourth in program history in free-throw percentage, shooting at an 81.9 percent clip. Cleveland Jackson (1977-79) is the school's leader in the category at 83.8 percent. This year, Noel is ninth in Conference USA, shooting 80.2 percent from the line.
 • During his three years at UCF, Noel has made 231 free throws, good for ninth on the school's all-time list. Darryl Davis (1991-95) is eighth with 245 foul shots.

SHOW AND IMPROVE

• Kenrick Zondervan has shown continued improvement since arriving at UCF from Holland before the 2005-06 campaign. This year, he is averaging 5.0 points and 4.3 rebounds in 22.8 minutes per game.
 • A year ago, he made 31 starts at center and averaged 3.9 points and 2.1 rebounds. In Zondervan's rookie year (2005-06), he averaged just 0.3 points and 0.3 boards in limited action in 18 games.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

• When UCF met No. 1 Memphis on Feb. 9, it marked the Knights third game against a nationally-ranked opponent this season. At the Old Spice Classic in November, UCF faced No. 18 Kansas State and No. 19 Villanova. Four other squads that UCF played - Nevada, Ole Miss, Sam Houston State and Houston - were all garnering votes in national polls when meeting the Knights.
 • UCF's non-conference slate, which was the toughest in program history, featured five opponents that participated in the postseason a year ago. The Knights faced Nevada twice (NCAA), Villanova (NCAA), Kansas State (NIT) and Ole Miss (NIT).
 • In non-league play, UCF faced three BIG EAST programs (Villanova, USF, Connecticut) and teams from the Big Ten (Penn State), Big 12 (Kansas State) and SEC (Ole Miss).

PRESEASON PICKS

• UCF was picked to finish sixth in Conference USA in the league's preseason coaches' poll, which was released in October. Memphis was tabbed to win the league and Houston and UAB tied for second. Southern Miss (4) and Tulsa (5) were selected ahead of the Knights.
 • The Knights have already recorded wins over Southern Miss and Tulsa.
 • Prior the 2006-07 campaign, UCF was picked to finish seventh by the league's coaches. The Knights proved the coaches wrong, going 11-5 in conference play to finish second in the league.

A BIG ADDITION

• In November, UCF head coach Kirk Speraw announced that his team will have a huge presence in the post next season when he confirmed that Jakub Kusmieruk has signed a National Letter of Intent with the Knights. Listed at 7-foot-4, Kusmieruk attends the John Carroll School in Bel Air, Md.
 • Two other prep players, P.J. Gaynor of Jacksonville and A.J. Rompza from Chicago, also inked NLIs with the Knights in November.

NEW UCF ARENA COMPLEX

- The new UCF Arena is the centerpiece of an area that includes apartment-style dormitories with 2,000 total beds and 100,000-square feet of retail space.
- The neighboring retail area has room for 24 shops. Some of the current retail outlets include Barnes & Noble, Red Brick Oven Pizza, Papa John's Pizza and Subway.
- The new arena is twice the size of the Knights' previous home and also hosts UCF commencement ceremonies and concerts.
- No tuition or tax money was used to construct the building.
- The arena sits on the northern side of campus and is situated around UCF's other athletics facilities, including Bright House Networks Stadium, Jay Bergman Field, Nicholson Fieldhouse and the Wayne Densch Sports Center.
- The 45,000-seat football stadium opened in September 2007.
- The old UCF Arena is currently being renovated. Once completed, the old facility will have two basketball practice courts as well as a dedicated volleyball court. The men's and women's basketball programs at UCF will each have their own practice courts.
- The old arena will also have a locker room, player lounge, weight room and coaches offices for the men's basketball program. An equipment room is also being built inside the facility.
- The new UCF Arena will connect with the old building on its north side, near the student section.
