2002-03 SEASON IN REVIEW

It was just the second week in January and the University of Houston's basketball team faced its most important decision in the 2002-03 campaign. At this juncture, many of the goals they had set before starting the year seemed well beyond their reach. They had to make a decision either to ride out the rest of a very disappointing season or fight back and try to regain some respect.

The 2002-03 season was supposed to be filled with expectation. After all, Houston was supposed to have three prominent starters returning from a team that won 18 games. The Cougars advanced to the semifinals of the Conference USA Postseason Tournament for the first time in school history and played in their first national postseason tournament in nearly a decade. Those accomplishments could have been building blocks for something far greater.

But, that was before a three-year starter, George Williams, opted to leave as an early entrant in the 2002 NBA Draft, and before Conference USA All-Tournament performer, Marcus Oliver, a two-year starter, suffered a season-ending injury in a summer pickup game. What seemed so promising had taken a 180-degree turn.

Now, instead of having three experienced starters returning from a successful season, head coach Ray McCallum was faced with the task of building his team around one returning starter, two part-time players and a host of newcomers.

The lone returning starter, Louis Truscott, performed with Herculean effort and was a consistent leader for the team. He finished the season as Houston's scoring leader with 15.3 points per game, ranked sixth among national rebounding leaders with an 11.3 average and registered 16 double-doubles. Those efforts earned him First-Team, All-Conference USA honors when the season ended.

The part-time players also played key roles. Senior center Jereme McGuires teamed with junior-college transfer Anwar Ferguson to form one of the top shot blocking duos in C-USA. Ferguson finished the season averaging 1.75 blocked shots per game and McGuires had 1.61 per contest.

Sophomore guard Bryan Shelton also took over the point-guard duties by the end of the season.

One of the newcomers, sophomore transfer Andre Owens, made giant strides picking up some of the slack. He averaged 13.9 points per game and led the Cougars

with 3.2 assists and nearly one steal per game. Owens also scored 25 points in two games and had nine 20-point games throughout the season.

However, the Cougars couldn't take advantage of these strong performances because they were missing a key ingredient that could only be found on the court and in competition.

"We just didn't have enough experience to get the job done, and it showed early in the season," McCallum said.

The Cougars opened the season with a 78-75 setback against Prairie View A&M, with former UH assistant coach Jerome Francis making his head-coaching debut. Then, after a loss against intracity rival Rice, Houston suffered a 62-60 loss against Baylor in the Space City Hoops Classic when Terrance Thomas scored his only three points of the game with a desperation heave from near half-court as the final buzzer sounded.

Houston rebounded from those losses to beat intrastate foes, UTEP and Texas-Arlington in their next two games. The Cougars upended the Miners, 56-47, and beat the Mavericks, 60-59.

However, the Cougars dropped their next four games and ended their non-conference schedule with a 2-9 record before opening their Conference USA slate with a 63-50

loss against UAB.

"After the start we had, our mission turned to regaining some respect by participating in the Conference USA Tournament," McCallum said.

The C-USA Tournament includes 12 of its 14 teams playing four rounds to determine which school would receive the league's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament. Houston's focus was to be one of those 12 teams.

The Cougars began their fight for credibility with a 72-59 victory over Saint Louis, as Owens scored a career-high 28 points and Truscott added 20.

Houston also won a 76-75 victory against Southern Miss in Biloxi's Mississippi Gulf Coast Coliseum when Truscott scored 19 points, freshman Cedrick Hensley tallied a career-high 16 points and Owens added 15 points and a team-high three assists.

After suffering a 77-66 loss at Memphis, the Cougars returned home to beat South Florida, 59-57, as Owens scored 23 points and Truscott added 12 points and 11 rebounds. Truscott registered 21 points and 21 rebounds to lead Houston to a 61-56 victory at TCU.

The resurgence was slowed by four consecutive losses before the Cougars won a defensive struggle, 46-42, against Southern Miss.

Houston achieved its goal on March 1, and clinched a berth into the C-USA Tournament with a 75-57 victory over TCU as four Cougars finished the game in double figures. Owens led Houston with 22 points, while Truscott added 19 points and 10 rebounds; Hensley netted 16 points and Jereme McGuires tallied 11 points and a game-high 13 rebounds.

"After the start we had, even though we didn't have a lot of wins down the stretch, the fact that we controlled our own destiny was a major accomplishment," McCallum said. "Playing our way into the Conference USA Tournament is something that we can build upon and carry over into our preseason workouts and this season."
