ABOUT THE GAME

Louisiana Tech battles another foe from Conference USA Saturday as the Bulldogs (1-1) host Houston (2-0) at 6 p.m. at Joe Aillet Stadium. The game, broadcast on ESPN3, comes off the heels of Tech's first OT win since 2001 with Heisman Trophy candidate Case Keenum bringing the Cougars to Ruston.

ABOUT THE SERIES

Louisiana Tech and Houston will meet for only the sixth time Saturday with UH leading the all-time series, 3-2. The Cougars won the first three meetings in the series but Louisiana Tech took the last two meetings in 1994 and 1995. In Ruston the series is tied, 1-1, with UH winning 60-0 in 1988, Tech's last season in Division I-AA. The Bulldogs recorded the school's first win over Houston in 1994 with a 32-7 win in Ruston.

THE COACHES

Louisiana Tech: Sonny Dykes is in his second season at Louisiana Tech and as a head coach in his career. He is 6-8 all-time after recording a 5-7 mark in his inaugural year, keeping the Bulldogs on the verge of bowl eligibility until the last game of the season. Overall, he is 0-2 vs. Conference USA teams.

Houston: Kevin Sumlin, a finalist for the 2009 Paul "Bear" Bryant National Coach of the Year Award, is in his fourth season guiding the Cougars. Sumlin has led UH to a pair of bowl appearances while winning the 2009 Conference USA West Division title and a top-15 national ranking. He enters Saturday's game with a 25-16 overall record but the contest vs. LA Tech will mark his first against a Western Athletic Conference opponent.

LAST TIME OUT

Louisiana Tech 48, Central Arkansas 42 (OT); Joe Aillet Stadium, Ruston, La.; Sept. 10, 2011
Lennon Creer ran for 177 yards on 32 carries, including the winning touchdown in overtime, as Louisiana Tech outlasted Central Arkansas 48-42 Saturday night. After a 42-42 tie in regulation, Central Arkansas got the ball first, but its drive stalled and Adrien Cole blocked Eddie Camara's 39-yard field goal attempt. When the Bulldogs (1-1) took over, Creer burst 23 yards on the first play to the Bears' 2-yard line, and he scored from the 1 two plays later. Louisiana Tech took a 35-20 third-quarter lead on a 12-yard run by Creer, but Central Arkansas (1-1) tied it on Nathan Dick's touchdown passes of 43 yards to Dominique Croom and 56 yards to Jesse Grandy. Central Arkansas' Jerre McKnight ran a fumble back 73 yards for a 42-35 lead with 2:08 left, but the Bulldogs drove 72 yards to tie it on Ray Holley's 7-yard run with 58 seconds left.

HIGH OCTANE OFFENSE SHOWING SIGNS OF IMPROVEMENT

As Louisiana Tech enters the last week of regular season play for the 2010 season, Sonny Dykes' high octane offense is showing signs of improvement over last year's offense. Tech's total offense is ranked 47th in the nation compared with being ranked 66th last season. Of the four main offensive categories in the NCAA statistical charts (rushing offense, passing offense, total offense and scoring offense), Louisiana Tech's average national rank is No. 50 this season while last year's average national rank was 65th. As Dykes and his staff continue to recruit and the team continues to improve, look for the Bulldogs high-flying offense to continue to gather steam.

HOUSTON - Junior running back Lee Ragsdale ran for 89 yards in his first game as a Bulldog as Tech topped Houston, 19-7, in Houston. It was the Bulldog defense that once again dominated the day, surrendering just 120 yards of total offense to Houston in the second half while holding them scoreless. While Tech quarterback Jason Martin had an off day, completing 13-of-30 passes, he did hit several key passes late and finished with 148 yards. But once again, the Bulldog running game flourished with a trio of Ragsdale, Jason Armstrong and Billy Thomas combining for 245 of Tech's 266 ground yards.

THE OFFENSIVE POTENTIAL FOR YEAR TWO

As Louisiana Tech enters year two of Sonny Dykes' and Tony Franklin's high octane offense, Tech has the potential to showcase offensive fireworks this season. By comparison, below is a list of select offensive categories from 2006 and 2007 at Troy, where Franklin was once the offensive coordinator. The chart also lists offensive categories from 2007 and 2008 at Arizona, where Dykes was the offensive coordinator, along with the pair's first year at Louisiana Tech. The increase in offensive output in Franklin's offense with the Trojans and Dykes' offense with the Wildcats shows some of the potential that Louisiana Tech brings to the gridiron this fall.

TECH ENDS DROUGHT IN CLOSE GAMES

With Louisiana Tech's seven-point, one possession win over San Jose State on Nov. 27, 2010, Louisiana Tech ended a stretch of six consecutive losses in one possession games. Prior to that win, Tech had lost six consecutive one possession games. In a reversal of fortunes, Tech has now won two of its last three games decided by one possession with the loss being a 19-17 decision in the middle of Tropical Storm Lee at Southern Miss in Hattiesburg, Miss.

ATTENDANCE RECORD SET UNDER DYKES' WATCH

Louisiana Tech set a single season attendance record in 2010 as 116,908 fans went through the turnstiles at Joe Aillet Stadium. That is over 8,700 more fans than the previous season high attendance mark of 108,121 set in 2008.

JOE AILLET IS A TOUGH PLACE TO PLAY...

It always nice to be home and Louisiana Tech has experienced recent success in the friendly confines of Joe Aillet Stadium. LA Tech has won 12 of its last 17 games at home. That record ranks fifth in the league with six of the WAC's nine teams having a winning record at home in that time frame.

JOE AILLET STADIUM FUN FACT

NFL Hall of Famer and four-time Super Bowl Champion Terry Bradshaw threw the first touchdown pass in the history of Joe Aillet Stadium connecting with Buster Herren from 5-yards out against East Carolina on Sept. 28, 1968. Tech went on to win the game 35-7.



FRESH START

Entering the 2011 campaign, Louisiana Tech is among one of 30 FBS programs in the nation that will start a quarterback in its first game with three or fewer career starts under his belt. Nick Isham, a true freshman, played in his first collegiate game on Sept. 3 in Hattiesburg.

NOT THE ONLY ONE

While Louisiana Tech is one of 22 schools that had a quarterback make his first career start during the first weekend of play, Tech was one of only four schools that started a true freshman. Tech, Marshall, Utah State and Wyoming are the only four schools in the 120-member FBS to start a true freshman at quarterback in the first game of the 2011 season.

YOUNGEST IN THE NATION?

When Louisiana Tech's Nick Isham took the field in his first career start Saturday, he was be the youngest player in FBS to start and possibly even play. Isham is only 17 and will turn 18 on Oct. 7.

SECOND YOUNGEST IN HISTORY?

Nick Isham started at quarterback for Louisiana Tech in the team's first game of his true freshman season, taking his first snaps in college at the young age of 17 years, 10 months and 27 days. He is believed to be the second-youngest quarterback in college football history to start the first game of his true freshman year. Texas A&M's David "Moon" Walker (coincidentally a native of Louisiana) started for the Aggies against Wichita State on Sept. 15, 1973 as a true freshman at just 17 years, nine months and 26 days old. A&M went on to win, 48-0.

HOME DOMINATION VS. ROAD WOES

Louisiana Tech hopes to take advantage of a Houston team that has historically not played well on the road lately. Since the disbandment of the Southwest Conference and Houston joining Conference USA, the Cougars have a .390 winning percentage in road games (35-55) and since 2000, UH is only 25-42 on the road (.370). Head coach Kevin Sumlin is trying to change that trend and his Houston teams have gone 9-12 (.430) on the road during his tenure.

Conversely, Joe Aillet Stadium has been an unfriendly place for visiting teams. In the same time periods as before, Louisiana Tech is 12-6 (.667) since 2008, has won 60 percent of its games since 2000 (32-21) and has posted a 46-23 (.670) mark at home since 1996.

FAMILIAR FACES

When Louisiana Tech hosts Houston on Sept. 17, the coaches of both teams will be in a familiar setting when looking across the field at one another. LA Tech's Sonny Dykes was an assistant coach at Texas Tech from 2000-06 while Kevin Sumlin was an assistant coach first at Texas A&M (2001-02) and then at Oklahoma (2003-07). The two had a common bond after Dykes left Texas Tech as he became the offensive coordinator at Arizona under Mike Stoops, brother of Oklahoma head coach Bob Stoops where Sumlin coached until 2007 before taking the head coaching job at Houston.

Additionally, Houston QB coach Kliff Kingsbury was a quarterback at Texas Tech from 1998-2002 while Dykes served as the team's receivers coach.

While Houston does not have any Louisiana players on its roster, Louisiana Tech has 21 players in its ranks that come from the state of Texas, including noted running back Lennon Creer.

(SOMEWHAT) RECENT HISTORY NOT KIND TO TECH ON SEPT. 17

With Tech's game against Houston to be decided on Sept. 17, the Bulldogs are looking to break a losing streak on that date. All-time, the Bulldogs are 4-6 when playing on Sept. 17 but Tech has lost its last five games played on that day. Louisiana Tech has not won on Sept. 17 since a 20-0 defeat over Lamar in 1960.

STEADY AS SHE GOES

Entering Saturday's game against Houston, Lennon Creer and Taulib Ikharo bring a steady hand to the game. Both have caught a pass in 14 consecutive games for Louisiana Tech, ranking them fifth among WAC receivers in that streak.

GENERAL PATTON LEADING THE CHARGE

Receiver Quinton Patton had a breakout day on Sept. 10 against Central Arkansas, recording 211 receiving yards and two touchdowns in Tech's 48-42 overtime win. His performance ranks tied for 10th in school history matching Rod Foppe's 211 receiving yards against North Texas in 1977 and Tommy Spinks 211 receiving yards against UL-Lafayette in 1968.

Patton's 211 receiving yards also marked the most for a Tech receiver since Delwyn Daire recorded 235 receiving yards against UAB in 1999. It marked only the 18th time a Tech receiver has recorded 200 or more receiving yards in a game.

CREER, PATTON RANK SECOND IN THE NATION DURING WEEK TWO

During week two of play this season, Louisiana Tech's Lennon Creer and Quinton Patton both posted high-number days on Sept. 10 in Tech's overtime win over Central Arkansas. That weekend, Creer's 177 rushing yards ranked second in the nation only to Utah State's 180 rushing yards against Weber State. The Western Athletic Conference, normally known for passing offenses, showed its prowess on the ground that week as Robbie Rouse was fourth in the nation with 169 rushing yards as the WAC posted three of the nation's top four performances of the week.

In addition, Quinton Patton's 211 receiving yards ranked second in the nation that week. Only Colorado's Paul Richardson (284 receiving yards vs. Cal) eclipsed Patton's mark during week two of play.

RETURN GAME SUCCESS

Louisiana Tech continues to stake its claim as one of the best return teams in the country and that claim continues into the 2011 season. On Sept. 3 at Southern Miss, Lyle Fitté returned a kickoff 86 yards for a touchdown, the 10th-longest return in school history. That marked the sixth consecutive year that a Louisiana Tech player has returned a kickoff or a punt for a touchdown, the longest streak in the nation.

Prior to the current streak, Louisiana Tech had one of the longest return droughts in the nation, having not returned a kickoff for a touchdown since 1989 and not returned a punt for a touchdown since 1999.

Entering this week's game against Houston, Tech is ranked first in the nation in punt returns and 23rd in the nation in kickoff returns.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

This accomplishment of academic excellence is par for the course in Ruston as Tech has consistently proven itself as an academic institution of the highest regard, especially when it comes to student-athletes.

Among Tech's many laudable academic honors:

- ▶ Last year, Tech recorded its highest four-year graduation rate ever, ranking No. 1 in the state of Louisiana among FBS public institutions and second among WAC schools.
- ▶ Tech boasts one of the best retention rates (84.5) in the state of Louisiana, which tops the averages of both the LSU System (79.3) and the UL System (77.7).
- ▶ Tech has had more than 800 student-athletes earn Academic All-WAC honors since joining the league in 2001, including more than 80 this past year.
- ▶ Tech recently recorded its highest Graduation Success Rate (GSR) and ranks among the best in the nation.
- ▶ Tech has the highest graduation rate (53.2%) in the UL System.
- ▶ Tech also saw eight of its 16 NCAA sanctioned programs record their highest multi-year APR rates ever while four of the programs registered their highest single year APR score ever. Three of the programs also earned a perfect 1,000 score on the single year rate. **All 16 of Louisiana Tech's NCAA sanctioned programs will be penalty free in 2011-12.**

BLOCKED KICKS SPARK SPECIAL TEAMS SUCCESS

In the last few years, Louisiana Tech's emphasis on special teams has begun to show in games. Two games into the 2011 season, Adrien Cole has two blocked field goals including one against Central Arkansas in overtime.

Since 2008, Louisiana Tech is ninth in the nation in blocked kicks with 10.

In Tech's game at Southern Miss, the full range of the teams special teams was on display. In that one game, Tech blocked a USM field goal attempt, returned a kickoff for a touch-down and recovered a fumble.

TOP-RANKING PUNTING TEAM VS. TOP-RANKED PUNT RETURN TEAM

In this week's match-up against Houston, fans at Joe Aillet Stadium will see a battle on special teams. Already known as a talented return team, Louisiana Tech enters Week 3 of the 2011 season as the nation's No. 1 ranked punt return team after Andrew Guillot returned a punt 52 yards against Central Arkansas last weekend.

In addition, with a net punt average of 53.80 per punt Houston is ranked No. 1 in the nation in punt returns.

BROHA APPROACHING SECOND ALL-TIME IN SACKS

With a solo sack at Southern Miss on Sept. 3, redshirt senior Matt Broha now has 15.5 career sacks which ranks him third all-time in Louisiana Tech's career sack charts. One assisted sack would tie Broha for second while a solo sack would give him sole possession of second. Walter Johnson (1983-86) owns the school record with 38 career sacks while Johnny Robinson (1977-80) is second with 16 career sacks.

A LOOK AT THE "DAVE CLARK FIVE"

Entering this season, Louisiana Tech's defense will put a stronger emphasis on its Nickel defensive package against the various pass-heavy offenses it will face. This package could also be called the "Dave Clark Five" as it is led, in part, by redshirt junior Dave Clark.

This unit is "Glad All Over" this season "Because" the secondary has looked much improved to date, "Reelin' and Rockin'" through fall camp. While the offense challenges opponents to "Catch Us If You Can," the defense is always "At the Scene" dressed in their "Red and Blue." The pass defense has worked hard "Over and Over" to be much improved in 2011 after a disappointing 2010 season by improving "Bits and Pieces" at a time.

The man himself, Dave Clark, says "I Knew It All The Time" that the pass defense would be improved this season.

TECH TOUGH IN HOME OPENERS

Since Joe Aillet Stadium opened in 1968, Louisiana Tech has been a tough team to play at home, especially in home openers. In Tech's first game at home of the season, the Bulldogs are 35-9 (.800) all-time at Joe Aillet Stadium. That includes LA Tech's thrilling 48-42 overtime win over Central Arkansas in 2011.

ROAD WOES FINALLY COME TO AN END

Louisiana Tech gladly ended one streak at New Mexico State on Nov. 13 when the Bulldogs recorded their first road win in 11 tries, ending a drought that lasted two years. The Bulldogs added another road victory on Nov. 27 when LA Tech won at San Jose State, 45-38.

MISSISSIPPI TECH?

Louisiana Tech faces a unique non-conference schedule this fall with three non-WAC games in the state of Mississippi: Sept. 3 at Southern Miss, Sept. 24 at Mississippi State and Nov. 12 at Ole Miss. Research into this scheduling aberration has not turned up any other FBS program that has played three non-conference games in a single state (not its own). That research also indicates LA Tech is the first FBS program since San Jose State in 1999 to play three road games in a single state that is not its own, but those were conference games. That year, the Spartans played games at TCU (L, 42-0), at Rice (L, 49-7) and at UTEP (L, 42-26).

LENNON CREER RUNS OVER BOISE STATE IN 2010, MORE ON TAP FOR 2011

Last season, Lennon Creer surprised the nation with six games of over 100 rushing yards and a total of 1,181 rushing yards on the season. His most remarkable performance was on Oct. 26 at No. 2 Boise State. Facing the nation's second-best defense and top-ranked rushing defense, Lennon Creer ran for 149 yards on the "Smurf Turf." His performance ended the year better than 10 of Boise State's 12 other opponents with only Nevada and Utah State recording more rushing yards as a team.

As he enters the 2011 campaign and his final year of collegiate eligibility, look for Creer to continue to pave a path down the field.

TWENTY-ONE THE MAGIC NUMBER

Dating back to the 1998 season, history has shown that when the Louisiana Tech offense struggles the team tends to struggle. Since 1998 the Bulldogs have compiled a 4-55 record when scoring less than 21 points. Before the Bulldogs won the 2008 Independence Bowl vs. Northern Illinois 17-10, the last victory for Tech when scoring less than 21 points was in 2003 against Michigan State when the Bulldogs upset the then ranked Spartans, 20-19. Tech added a win to that tally on Sept. 4, 2010 when the Bulldogs defeated Grambling State, 20-6.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

Sonny Dykes made his debut as a head coach on Sept. 4 and did so at the same stadium his father made his coaching debut in. Spike Dykes first guided Texas Tech on Dec. 20, 1986 in the Independence Bowl. However, while Spike's Red Raider squad lost to Ole Miss, 20-17, Sonny's Bulldog team toughed out a 20-6 win over Grambling.

BULLDOG OPENER HISTORY

After Louisiana Tech fell at Southern Miss to open the 2011 campaign, Tech moved to 50-49-5 all-time in season openers. That mark includes a record of 9-1 at Joe Aillet Stadium. Tech's only loss in Joe Aillet Stadium on opening day was 12-7 to Tennessee-Chattanooga in 1978.

BENCHMARK SET AT 300?

Louisiana Tech allowed over 300 yards rushing on Sept. 5, 2009 at Auburn and that standard can be a fairly accurate predictor for the outcome of games. Since 2000, LA Tech is 1-12 when allowing teams to rush for 300-plus yards with the lone win coming over Nevada in 2001. LA Tech has not allowed opponents to post back-to-back 300-yard rushing games since 2000 when Auburn ran for 301 yards on Oct. 21, 2000 and Miami (Fla.) ran for 331 on Oct. 28, 2000.

When Louisiana Tech faces Fresno State on Nov. 5 at Bulldog Stadium it will mark 142 years that the first college football game was played. On Nov. 6, 1869, nearly 100 spectators gathered to witness the first-ever college football game between Rutgers and Princeton. That game was reportedly "replete with surprise, strategy, prodigies of determination and physical prowess." Rutgers defeated Princeton, 6-4.

WAC FINISHES

Louisiana Tech finished the 2008 season tied for second place in the Western Athletic Conference standings, the program's second best finish in eight years as a member. The 2001 Louisiana Tech team won the WAC title by virtue of a 7-1 mark in league play.

The 2008 Independence Bowl marked the fifth bowl appearance for Louisiana Tech in its history and only the third since the program joined the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) in 1989. SONNY DAYS ARE HERE AGAIN

Last season marked the first year of the Sonny Dykes' tenure at Louisiana Tech and the first-year head coach guided the Bulldogs to the verge of bowl eligibility entering the last game of the season. He was one of very few of the 22 first-year head coaches last season to improve upon his team's conference record in his first year at the helm.

The son of legendary Texas Tech coach Spike Dykes, he is no stranger to success on the field having won at stops in the Pac-10, SEC and Big 12 en route to being named LA Tech's head coach. Since 1940, only three other LA Tech coaches have posted winning records in their first season at the helm of the Bulldogs including Joe Aillet (6-4, 1940), Gary Crowton (6-5, 1996) and Jack Bicknell (8-3, 1999).

FAMILY TRADITION

Thomas Graham is back for his fifth year with the Bulldog football team, but he is no longer the team's deep snapper. Graham has joined the strength and conditioning staff. As the team's deep snapper for four years, he continued a family tradition as his brother, Matt, was the deep snapper for LA Tech four straight years before him. The Graham brothers come from a football family as their grandfather Bill Graham, who is the Director of Special Events at Tech, played football for Florida State (and was roommates with Burt Reynolds) at running back and their father, Randy Graham, played rover back football at Missouri. The youngest of the Graham brothers, Gantt, is also with the program as a student worker on the equipment staff.

FAMILY TRADITION - PART II

Redshirt freshman walk-on Hayden Slack is the third generation of his family to play football at Louisiana Tech. His father, Terry, played at LA Tech from 1974-77 and his uncle, Jay, played at Tech from 1984-87. Going back one more generation in the Slack family, J.W. Slack (Hayden's grandfather) played at Tech from 1957-59.

AUNT WAS NATIONAL CHAMP

Redshirt junior linebacker Dusty Rust is not the first in his family to play ball for Louisiana Tech. Except his relative did not play football. Rust's aunt Rita Rust played basketball for the Lady Techsters from 1979-82, playing on two national championship teams.





SONNY DYKES

Head Coach

Sonny Dykes was introduced as the 32nd head coach in Louisiana Tech history on Jan. 20, 2010 in front of an overflowing Jarrell Room filled with Bulldog fans at the Charles Wylie Athletic Center.

In his first season Dykes put his high octane offense into effect, resulting in him being one of only four of the nation's 22 new head coaches to improve a team's conference record from the year before. Dykes' exciting brand of offense improved in several areas of the NCAA statistical ranks including passing offense (91st in 2009 to 62nd in 2010) and total offense (66th to 52nd) while the team's average offensive national rank improved from 65th in 2009 to 54th in 2010.

Dykes, son of Texas Tech coaching legend Spike Dykes, has coached in the PAC-10, South-eastern Conference and Big 12 during his 16 years in the college football profession while also serving under some very successful head coaches including Mike Leach and Mike Stoops.

He won the 2006 Mike Campbell Top Assistant Award, presented by the All-American Football Foundation, and was a nominee for the 2009 Broyles Award, which goes to the nation's top assistant coach.

Dykes came to Louisiana Tech after completing his third season as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Arizona, leading the Wildcats to an 8-5 record and an appearance in the Holiday Bowl. That Holiday Bowl appearance marked Dykes' 10th bowl appearance as a coach with all 10 appearances coming within an 11 year span.

A spread-offense specialist, Dykes' offensive attack set at least five single-season records at Arizona while also racking up a pile of single-game marks in the UA record book. Former Wildcat quarterback Willie Tuitama, a disciple of Dykes, notched career numbers that are among Arizona's best.

"Coach Dykes has demonstrated throughout his coaching career all the leadership qualifications we are looking for in the next leader for our football program," said acting athletics director Bruce Van De Velde. "His coaching success has been achieved at the highest level of competition, from the SEC to the Big 12 to the Pac-10."

Rivals.com cited Dykes as one of the countries brightest offensive minds and top ten college recruiters in the country.

"I have worked my entire life to get to this point, and I have had lots of great mentors that have worked with me and taught me and brought me along," said Dykes. "I am very fortunate to be here."

Dykes' Arizona team went 6-3 in the Pac-10 Conference during the 2009 campaign, finished tied for second in the league with Oregon State and Stanford.

Fond of the passing attack, Dykes Arizona offense in 2008 ranked 16th in scoring and 33rd in total offense while developing and outstanding run-pass balance.

Dykes orchestrated an Arizona offense that was ranked 10th nationally in passing yards per game in 2007 as he coached then-junior Tuitama to honorable mention All-Pac-10 honors that year. That same season, he helped develop the offensive scheme that pushed receiver Mike Thomas to first-team all-league status as a junior and senior ('08).

Prior to his tenure at Arizona, Dykes was co-offensive coordinator working with then-head coach Mike Leach and inside receivers coach Dana Holgorsen running Texas Tech's wide-open passing attack in 2005-06 after having been Texas Tech's wide receivers coach since 2000. The Red Raiders were among the national top six in total offense and passing during the span.

Texas Tech was No. 3 in passing and No. 6 in total offense in 2006 under his co-direction, throwing for 370 yards and accumulating nearly 450 overall. He directed an offense that scored 32 points per game in 2006 with two receivers ranked top three in the nation and a third in the top 20 in receptions per game.

While in Lubbock, Dykes helped develop Joel Filani into a two-time first team All-Big 12 honoree and a sixth-round NFL draft selection by the Tennessee Titans in 2007. Receiver Jarrett Hicks also signed a free-agent deal with the San Diego Chargers that year.

Dykes also worked with quarterback Graham Harrell who completed 412 passes for 4,555 yards and 38 touchdowns in 2006, ranking Texas Tech third nationally in total offense that season.

Prior to his five seasons at Texas Tech, Dykes spent two non-consecutive seasons at Kentucky, first coaching tight ends as a graduate assistant in 1997 and then coaching special teams and wide receivers in 1999 under the "Air Raid" attack of former UK coach Hal Mumme. Dykes coached Kentucky's James Whalen to AP All-America honors after his Division I-A record for receptions by a tight end.

Sandwiched in between his two stints in Lexington, Dykes was the wide receivers coach at Northeast Louisiana where he helped receiver Marty Booker set school seas and career records and earn Blue-Gray and Shrine Game spots before getting drafted in the third round by the Chicago Bears in 1999.

A 1993 graduate of Texas Tech, Dykes lettered for three years as a baseball player for the Red Raiders. At age 40, Dykes is one of the nation's youngest coaches in the Football Bowl Subdivision.

Dykes is married to the former Kate Golding and they have two daughters, Alta Carolina (Ally) who is three and Charlotte Reese (Charlie) who was born in late spring 2011.
