**WAC Highlights**

- New Mexico State won at Minnesota, 28-21, to pick up its first ever win against a Big Ten team. It also snapped a 12-game road losing streak for the Aggies. Andrew Manley threw for 288 yards and three touchdowns, two of which were caught by Taveon Rogers.
- Utah State's Robert Turbin rushed for 180 yards and two touchdowns on 18 carries in a 54-17 win over Weber State. Chuckie Keeton was 10-of-15 for 166 yards and two touchdowns with no interceptions. It was the Aggies' largest margin of victory under head coach Gary Andersen.
- Trailing 14-3 in the second quarter, Idaho scored the final 41 points of the game to beat North Dakota, 44-14. Brian Reader completed 27-of-39 passes for 299 yards and four touchdowns. Mike Scott caught eight passes for 99 yards and one touchdown while Armauni Johnson added eight more receptions for 97 yards and another score.
- Louisiana Tech scored a touchdown in the final minute to force overtime and then won the game, 48-42, on a Lennon Creer TD run in the extra period to beat Central Arkansas. Creer ran for 177 yards and three scores while Quinton Patton caught eight passes for 211 yards and two touchdowns for the Bulldogs.

**WHAT'S ON TAP IN THE WAC** – The first conference game of the season will be played on Saturday as San Jose State hosts Nevada at 1:00 p.m. PT. The game will be televised by the WAC Sports Network and shown in several markets throughout the West.

## VERIZON PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

**OFFENSIVE** – New Mexico State quarterback Andrew Manley, a sophomore from Wahiawa, O'ahu (Leilehua HS), was 20-of-31 for 288 yards and three touchdowns in New Mexico State's 28-21 win at Minnesota. He completed his first 12 pass attempts in giving the Aggies a 21-7 lead in the first half. The win was the first ever for New Mexico State against a Big Ten team and the first win over a team from an automatic qualifying BCS conference team since 1999.



**DEFENSIVE** – New Mexico State defensive back Jonte Green, a senior from St. Petersburg, Fla. (Lakewood HS), led the Aggies with 10 solo tackles in the win over Minnesota. He also forced a fumble and broke up a pass while recording his second double-digit tackle game of his career.



**SPECIAL TEAMS** – Fresno State punt returner Devin Wylie, a senior from Roseville, Calif. (Granite Bay HS), returned five punts for 110 yards including a 67-yard return for a touchdown to open the scoring in Fresno State's game at Nebraska. It was the first punt return for a touchdown against the Cornhuskers since 2001 and the first for the Bulldogs in almost two years. Wylie also caught four passes for 50 yards in the game.



### Others nominated on offense:

**Robbie Rouse, Jr., RB, Fresno State** - rushed for 169 yards on 36 carries in the game at Nebraska.

**Jeremiah Ostrowski, Jr., WR, Hawai'i** - had a team-high 11 catches for 87 yards and one touchdown in the game at Oregon.

**Brian Reader, Sr., QB, Idaho** - completed 27-of-39 passes for 299 yards and four touchdowns in the win over North Dakota.

**Quinton Patton, Jr., WR, Louisiana Tech** - caught eight passes for 211 yards and two touchdowns in the win over Central Arkansas.

**Mike Ball, Jr., RB, Nevada** - had 14 carries for 99 yards and caught a five-yard touchdown pass in the game at Oregon.

**Robert Turbin, Sr., RB, Utah State** - rushed for 180 yards and two touchdowns on 18 carries in the win over Weber State. It was the most rushing yards by any player in the nation over the weekend.

### Also nominated on defense:

**Derron Smith, So., S, Fresno State** - had six tackles, forced a fumble and intercepted a pass in the game at Nebraska.

**Richard Torres, Sr., S, Hawai'i** - made five tackles and returned an interception 99 yards for a touchdown against Oregon.

**Korey Toomer, Sr., LB, Idaho** - recorded two tackles and returned an interception 19 yards against North Dakota.

**Bobby Wagner, Sr., LB, Utah State** - tallied a team-high 10 tackles in the win over Weber State.

### Additional special teams nominations:

**Trey Williams, So., S, Idaho** - had four tackles on kickoff coverage and forced two fair catches versus North Dakota.

**Adrien Cole, Sr., LB, Louisiana Tech** - blocked Central Arkansas' field goal attempt in overtime to help the Bulldogs to the victory.

**Jake Hurst, Sr., P, Nevada** - punted five times for a 40.2-yard average against Oregon. He also had two inside the 20 and recorded a career-long 62-yarder in the game.

**Tyler Bennett, Jr., P, Utah State** - punted three times for a 54.3-yard average against Weber State. All three punts were downed inside the 20-yard line, and he had a long of 62 yards.

**WAC SPORTS NETWORK** – In its second year, the WAC Sports Network allows for WAC football and basketball games to be produced and distributed to media outlets in the respective schools' markets. A total of 19 affiliates in 18 markets plus regional network Altitude and national outlet ESPN GamePlan will televise nine games during the 2011 WAC football season.

**TURBIN REACHES 2000** – Junior running back Robert Turbin rushed for 180 yards and two touchdowns on 18 carries in Utah State's win over Weber State. With the performance, he became the eighth running back in school history to reach 2,000 rushing yards for his career (2,048). He ranks 17th among all active players in the nation and is seventh in touchdowns scored with 32.

**2011 BOWL LINEUP** – The WAC is affiliated with three bowl games this season. WAC teams will play in the Sheraton Hawai'i Bowl in Honolulu against a Conference USA opponent, the Famous Idaho Potato Bowl in Boise, Idaho versus a MAC team and the Poinsettia Bowl in San Diego versus a team from the Mountain West.

**BOWL CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES** – Since 1997, the WAC has been an official part of the Bowl Championship Series. The WAC's champion will receive an automatic berth in one of the five BCS bowl games if ranked in the top 12 of the BCS Standings (and is the highest ranked team from a conference without an automatic bid) or if ranked in the top 16 of the BCS Standings and its ranking is higher than that of a champion of a conference that has an annual automatic berth in one of the BCS bowls. The BCS Standings are determined by a formula involving polls and computer rankings. Next year's National Championship Game will be played in New Orleans on Jan. 9, 2012.

**COACHES MOVING UP RECORD LISTS** – A couple of WAC coaches are working their way up career coaching record lists. Nevada head coach **Chris Ault** is in his 27th season as a head coach and is 219-98-1, the fourth winningest active coach in FBS (Joe Paterno, Penn State-402; Frank Beamer, Virginia Tech-242; Mack Brown, Texas-221). Fresno State head coach **Pat Hill** has 75 WAC victories, the second most in league history (LaVell Edwards, BYU-166).

**PRESEASON FAVORITES** – Hawai'i was picked as the favorite by both the media and coaches for the 2011 season. Fresno State was second in both polls and Nevada was third. As selected by the media, Hawai'i quarterback Bryant Moniz was voted the preseason Offensive Player of the Year while Utah State linebacker Bobby Wagner was picked as the Defensive Player of the Year. Moniz, a senior, was the nation's leader in passing and total offense last season. Last year, he became just the 11th player in FBS history to surpass 5,000 passing yards in a season. He averaged 360.0 passing yards per game and also led the nation in passing touchdowns (39) and ranked eighth in passing efficiency (159.11). Wagner, a senior, is a two-time first-team all-WAC honoree. Last season, he led the WAC and tied for seventh in the FBS with 11.1 tackles per game. He logged a total of seven double-digit tackle games, and had at least six stops in all 12 games.

**50 YEARS** – The 50th year of WAC football is underway. The conference has undergone many changes over the last half century and will see some more next year. This season, the conference is an eight-team league following the withdrawal of Boise State after 10 years in the WAC. In 2012 (following the departures of Fresno State, Hawai'i and Nevada), the WAC welcomes Denver, Seattle, UT Arlington, Texas State and UTSA with the latter two competing in football.

**INCOMING SCHOOL WEEK 2 RECAP** – Texas State played at Wyoming in the first ever meeting between the two schools and lost, 45-10. The Bobcats opened the scoring on a 35-yard field goal by Will Johnson and trailed 17-10 at halftime. Texas State was shutout in the second half for the second straight week and has now been outscored 69-0 after halftime this season. After winning its inaugural game the previous week, UTSA picked up its first loss, 24-21, to McMurry. Eric Soze completed 15-of-28 passes for 255 yards and two touchdowns with one interception and also led UTSA in rushing with 51 yards on 12 carries. The Roadrunners drew another good crowd to the Alamodome as 31,634 attended the game.
