



# The 2003-04 Lady Cougar Basketball

*The Best Season in School History*

## Season Highlights

- The 27 wins are a school record, and is tied with the 1966-67 Cougar men's basketball team for the fourth-highest win total in Houston basketball history.
- In earning a berth to the 2004 NCAA Tournament, the 2003-04 campaign marks only the third time Houston has gone to the Big Dance, and the first in 12 years (1988, 1992).
- The No. 3 seed in the East Region of the NCAA Tournament bracket is the highest-ever for Houston in school history, as well as the highest ever for a C-USA member school in league history.
- Houston has won 21 of their last 22 games, including a school best 12-game win streak as well as a nine-game C-USA win streak.
- Houston has reached its highest ever rankings by both the Associated Press and the ESPN/USA Today/WBCA coaches' (No. 10) poll this season.
- At 27-3, Houston's .900 winning percentage is the best in school history.
- 2003-04 marks the first time in school history Houston won the C-USA regular season title, earned a No. 1 seed at the annual C-USA Tournament and claimed the league tournament title.
- Houston posted 20 victories overall for the second time since the 1991-92 campaign when they closed out the year 22-8 and earned a bid to the NCAA Tournament. The 2001-02 squad finished out the year at 26-8.
- Houston became just the second team in C-USA history to win the regular season championship with just one loss. DePaul did it in the 1995-96 season when it went 13-1.
- Houston's 14-1 mark in road games this season is the best in school history and is the second-best road winning percentage in the country. They have won 12 straight games on the road dating back to Dec. 3, 2003.
- Houston's three losses are the fewest in school history and just the fifth time in the program's 29-year history that they have had less than 10 losses in a season. The last time the Lady Cougars posted less than 10 losses was the 2001-02 season in which they reached the WNIT finals and finished 26-8.
- Houston has had just one losing streak this season - a two-game spell (12/3/03-12/7/03).
- Houston has won four games against nationally-ranked opponents this season, beating TCU all three times and DePaul once, while two of their losses came against nationally-ranked Purdue and Georgia.
- Houston was led by senior Chandi Jones, who led C-USA in scoring and steals with 22.5 ppg and 3.2 steals per game.
- The Lady Cougars won two non-conference tournaments: a Big 10 tournament (KCRG TV-9 Hawkeye Challenge) and the Houston Classic Tournament.

### On the Court: Houston Earns First Trip to NCAA Tourney since 1992

This year marks the third time in program history the Lady Cougars have earned a trip to the NCAA Tournament, and the first time since 1992 (see box at left).

Houston has yet to advance to the Second Round, having fallen at Ole Miss, by a final of 74-68 in 1988, and at UC-Santa Barbara, 80-69, in 1992. In addition, as the No. 3 seed in the East Region, this also marks the highest-ever seed for Houston and a Conference USA member school in the Big Dance. ### A Closer Look: Houston vs UW-Green Bay, Colorado and UC-Santa Barbara

Houston comes into the First and Second Rounds having never faced its First Round opponent, UW-Green Bay, and having a 1-2 lifetime record vs Colorado (1-1) and UC-Santa Barbara (0-1). The Lady Cougars' lone contest and loss at UC-Santa Barbara came in the First

Round of the 1992 NCAA Tournament (see box score, page 12) on March 18, 1992. Houston defeated the Buffaloes in the two school's first-ever meeting by a one-point margin, 79-78, on Dec. 4, 1987, and Colorado returned the favor with a 88-58 win over the Lady Cougars in the championship game of the Colorado Tournament on Nov. 24, 2001.

#### Houston Against the 2004 NCAA Tournament Bracket

The Lady Cougars have faced seven of the schools in this year's NCAA Tournament. Houston posted a 7-2 record in those games: Iowa (1-0), Middle Tennessee State (1-0), Marquette (1-0), DePaul (1-0), TCU (3-0), Georgia (0-1) and Purdue (0-1).

#### Leading the Pack Among the Ranked

As of March 15, The Lady Cougars are currently ranked No. 10 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll, and No. 9 by the Associated Press Top 25 poll, the highest-ever ranking in school history and for a C-USA school in any poll (DePaul was ranked 11th by the ESPN/USA Today coaches poll the week of Feb. 16, 2004). Houston jumped six places to No. 11 on March 9 after beating then-No. 13 TCU for its ninth-straight win and the C-USA crown.

#### Houston Claims First Conference Regular Season Championship in School History

Upon defeating innerstate rival TCU, 77-71, in the final regular season game on Feb. 27 at Hofheinz Pavilion, Houston clinched its first-ever Conference USA regular season championship, earning a No. 1 seed at the annual C-USA Tournament, and went on to win its first C-USA Tournament title. The Lady Cougars' 13-1 record vs league foes is the best league season record in school history, surpassing the previous high in victories against league opponents being 11 (the 1984-85 team went 11-5 in the Southwest Conference, and the 2001-02 team went 11-3 in C-USA. In addition, Houston is the first school since the 1995-96 season to clinch the league crown with only one loss, joining DePaul, who won the title with a 13-1 league mark and 21-10 overall record that year. Houston also becomes the ninth different school to earn at least a share of the regular season crown in C-USA's first nine seasons.

#### The Road Warriors

With a 14-1 record on the road this season (15-1 including neutral games), Houston has the best road record in C-USA as well as one of the best road record in the country and in school history (see boxes at right). This season marks the first time the Lady Cougars have posted double-digit wins on the road, and only the third time since the 1997-98 campaign that the Lady Cougars have closed out a regular season with an above-.500 road mark. Additionally, the Lady Cougars have won 12 straight road games dating back to Dec. 19, when they beat North Texas in Denton, also a school record. Houston's sole road loss this season came at the hands of the nationally-ranked Georgia Lady Bulldogs, 65-52, in Athens, Ga., on Dec. 3.

#### Houston Enjoying Best Season in School History

With each game played throughout the post-season, the Lady Cougars will be making history. With a 27-3 overall record - and .900 winning percentage - the 2003-04 Lady Cougar campaign is by far the

### Last Time Out: Lady Cougars Beat TCU for C-USA Tournament Title

Senior Chandi Jones scored 24 of her 36 points in the second half, and No. 11 Houston beat No. 16 TCU, 86-75, on March 7 in Ft. Worth to win the C-USA tournament title and earn its first trip to the NCAA tournament in 12 years. Jones, the tournament MVP, scored 81 points in three games. TCU's Sandora Irvin scored 20 points and grabbed 16 rebounds for her 13th straight double-double. Joann Overstreet scored 14 points for Houston, and Sancho Lyttle added 13 points and six rebounds before fouling out with 4:48 left.

The Lady Cougars led, 52-36, early in the second half before the Lady Frogs sliced the lead to 57-55 with just less than 10 minutes remaining. But Jones started a 12-2 run with a short jumper, and also finished the spurt with a three-point play to give Houston a 69-57 advantage with 7:14 left. Irvin's layup brought TCU to 76-71 with 2:05 left, but Houston hit eight of 10 free throws down the stretch. The Lady Frogs, who were playing on their home floor, lost to the Lady Cougars for the third time this season. Jones scored 13 points in a 3:25 stretch as the Lady Cougars turned a one-point lead into a 16-point cushion two minutes into the second half. Houston went on an 8-0 surge over the final 1:25 of the first half to take a 43-34 half-time lead. Jones then hit three straight 3-pointers in the first two minutes of the second half.

### Curl, Jones Claim League's Highest Honors

Head coach Joe Curl and senior forward Chandi Jones of regular-season championship Houston headlined the list of Conference USA award winners as announced by the league office on March 4. Curl was named Coach of the Year, while Jones became the first player in C-USA history to be recognized as Player of the Year in three consecutive seasons. Sancho Lyttle was named to the Second Team All-Conference Team. In addition, Jones was named MVP of the 2004 C-USA Tournament, and was joined by Lyttle on the First Team All-C-USA Tournament squad.

### Curl Named ESPN.com Coach of the Year

Houston head coach Joe Curl, the 2004 Conference USA Coach of the Year, who led the Lady Cougars to their first-ever conference regular season championship and a trip to the NCAA post-season for the first time while boasting a school record 27 wins in 2003-04, was named national Coach of the Year by ESPN.com on March 12. Curl becomes the first coach in Lady Cougar history to win such an honor.

### Coaching Milestone for Curl

Entering the NCAA Tournament this weekend, Lady Cougar head coach Joe Curl is one win shy of winning his 100th game at Houston. Through March 15, Curl's career record at Houston is 99-80 (.553) in six seasons. Should the Lady Cougars win their first game in the NCAA Tournament, Curl will join Dot Woodfin (175-104, 1976-85) and Jessie Kenlaw (104-123, 1990-98) as the third head coach in school history to crack the 100-win plateau.

candidate for the State Farm Wade Watch Award and Kodak All America. The winner of the State Farm Wade Trophy from the 10-member Kodak All-America Team will be announced during the WBCA National Convention, April 3-6, in New Orleans, La. The winners of the Naismith Awards will be honored in Atlanta on April 9.

### The Dynamic Scoring Duo

This season, Chandi Jones and Sancho Lyttle have teamed to score 57.3 percent of Houston's points this season. In fact, together they have accounted for 1,180 of Houston's 2,058 total points scored on the year, and have both reached double figures in scoring in 26 of 30 games (*see box above*). The most they've combined for came on March 5 vs Cincinnati in the C-USA Tournament, when Jones (25) and Lyttle (34) combined to score 59 of the team's 84 points in the Lady Cougars' 84-67 win over the Bearcats.

### Jones Makes History - Again

Chandi Jones became Conference USA's all-time leading scorer when she bucketed 21 points in Houston's win at ECU on Feb. 15. The 21-point performance lifted Jones past former record holder Tamika Whitmore, who tallied 2,488 points in 120 games for the Memphis Tigers from 1996-99. She first splashed the C-USA history books in 2001-02 when she became the fastest

Heading into the NCAA tourney, Houston has not put up eye-popping offensive numbers; however, it has continually won games with defense, allowing the opposition just 59.7 points per game while averaging 13.2 steals per contest, physical ability and athleticism. The Lady Cougars are led by All American Chandi Jones, who has teamed with junior Sancho Lyttle to create Houston's one-two scoring and rebounding machine. While Jones continues to be Houston's scoring machine on the perimeter and master of the steal, Lyttle is a force inside, averaging nearly a double-double in points and rebounds with 16.8 ppg and 9.5, respectively. She is third on the team in steals with 72, while boasting the team's best shooting percentage (.537) on the team. Joann Overstreet has been a solid performer at the point guard position, averaging 8.8 points per game and leads the Lady Cougar squad with 134 assists (4.5 per game) and is fourth with 67 steals. Senior Nicole Oliver, Houston's defensive force, is averaging 5.8 points per game and is second on the squad with 79 steals. Other players who have made an impact for the Lady Cougars are KiKi Harris (4.0 ppg/4.6 rpg) Daphne Andre (5.9 ppg/2.7 rpg) and Amanda Barksdale (2.9 ppg/3.6 rpg).

### Jones on National Award Watch Lists

Chandi Jones has been named to the watch list of three prestigious national awards in college basketball. She is a Top 16 finalist for the John R. Wooden Award, the Naismith College Basketball Player of the Year Award, and the Bayer Advantage Senior CLASS Award as one of their top 30 players. In addition, Jones is also a candidate

player in league history to reach 1,000 points when she earned her 1,000th point in only her 46th game, bypassing UAB's Deanna Jackson (1998-00), who recorded her 1,000th point in 57 games. In addition, Jones is the first player in C-USA history to reach the 2,500-point plateau.

#### Jones Etches Name in Record Books and Becomes Third-Fastest Player in NCAA History to Score 2,000

All-American Chandi Jones became the third-fastest player in NCAA history to reach the 2,000-point plateau when she sank a free throw with 16:07 to play in the second half against the Iowa Hawkeyes in the Lady Cougars' second game of the 2003-04 season, Jones' 84th collegiate game (*look to chart on page 5*). Lynette Woodard of Kansas was the fastest to 2,000, she did it in 70 games, while Jackie Styles of Southwest Missouri State reached 2,000 in 83 games.

#### NCAA Record-Breaker

Jones has scored in double figures in all 112 of her college basketball games, an NCAA record. The previous record for consecutive double-digit scoring games was 92, set by former NCAA Player of the Year Jackie Stiles of Southwest Missouri State.

#### Lady Cougars Among the National Ranking

Through games of March 8, senior Chandi Jones is ranked third in the nation averaging 22.5 ppg and is 29th averaging 3.2 steals per game.

#### Lyttle Making Big Impact

Sancho Lyttle has registered double-doubles in three of her last five games and has a team-leading 13 on the year. She currently ranks fifth on Houston's all-time top ten lists for most rebounds in a single season with 285, and her 9.5 rebounds-per-game average is tied for fifth all-time in school history.

#### Queens of the Streak

Having won their last 12 games, the Lady Cougars are riding the best winning streak in school history and has the nation's best streak entering the NCAA Tournament. The previous school record for consecutive wins was 10 games, matched earlier this season and by the 1987-88 squad which won 10 in a row from Dec. 1-Jan. 4. Houston's 10 straight wins earlier this season began Dec. 19 with its 74-62 win over North Texas and ended with the 77-75 overtime loss to Louisville on Jan. 25.

### Joining the NCAA Record Books

Senior Chandi Jones enters the NCAA Tournament currently resting in 16th place all-time among the NCAA Division I All-Time Top Twenty for most career points (*see box on page 8*). She is just one point shy of tying Janet Harris of Georgia (2,641), and depending upon how far Houston goes in the Tournament, could crack the top twelve all-time.

### The Art of the Steal

This year's Lady Cougar squad has been third in the nation much of the season in steals, and as of March 9, are third averaging 13.2 per game. For the fourth straight year senior Chandi Jones led Houston in steals (96), and four Lady Cougars registered 60-or-more steals on the year, including Jones (96), Nicole Oliver (79), Sancho Lyttle (72) and Joann Overstreet (67). In addition, Amanda Barksdale and KiKi Harris added 22 and 29, respectively.

### Houston Among the Nation's Finest: Inside the Lady Cougars' Record

Against ranked opponents this season, Houston is 4-2, with three wins coming against TCU and one over DePaul, and losses to Georgia and Purdue. Houston was undefeated at 8-0 during the month of February, and since returning to the court following the holidays, have posted a 17-1 record.

### Lyttle Rocks the Rim

Junior Sancho Lyttle shocked the Gonzaga Bulldogs in the first game of the season at the Hawkeye Challenge in Iowa City, Iowa when she dunked in the first half. Lyttle grabbed a steal and raced down court, with what appeared to be an uncontested layup. She decided it was time to show her skills and dunked. In addition, Lyttle came close to dunking against Cincinnati in the Conference USA Tournament.

Under third-year head coach Greg Williams, the 1987-88 Lady Cougars began the season on a 10-game winning streak before falling to Florida International on Jan. 4. The team went on to post a 22-7 overall record - the second consecutive year of 20-plus victories - including 12-4 in Southwest Conference play - to place second in the league standings. Houston faced Texas Tech in the Southwest Conference Tournament and lost, 60-59, but earned their first bid to the NCAA Tournament in school history and traveled to Tad Smith Arena in Biloxi, Miss, to face Ole Miss in their first ever post-season game.

The Lady Cougars were up, 68-65, with just over three minutes to play when the Lady Rebels started a 9-0 run - five points which came off free throws - to take the lead and held on for the victory.

Kelly McCabe was the leading scorer for Houston, shooting 7-of-12 for 14 points, while Carla Fountain and Barbara Anderson, seventh in the SWC during the season in averaging 14.9 points per game, followed with 13 and 12 points, respectively. Fountain led the team with five assists in the game.

Second-year head coach Jessie Kenlaw led the Lady Cougars to a 22-8 regular season record, 10-4 in the Southwest Conference, for a third-place league finish and a NCAA-bid for the second time in program history. Houston advanced to the SWC Tournament, defeating Rice in the first round, 63-57, before falling to Texas , 70-60, in the semifinals at Moody Coliseum in Dallas, Texas.

Houston went on to the post-season and faced UC-Santa Barbara in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament, falling by a final of 80-69. Down 41-30 at the halfway point, Houston came back to bucket nearly 30 points in the second half and pulled to within four points at 66-70 with 1:54 left, but UCSB went on a 10-3 run and shut down the Houston offense to hold on for the victory.

Four Lady Cougars' registered double figures in points in the game, including LaShawn Johnson as the leading scorer with 18 points, as well as Cynthia Jackson (14 pts.), Margo Graham (12 pts.) and Darla Simpson (10 pts.). Johnson also added a game-high seven assists and Jackson registered five steals.
