Opening statement:

“Obviously, it’s tough to be done and it feels like with our program it’s a little bit earlier than we would’ve liked to be finished with our season. But overall, for a fairly young club, we came out and competed. I like that we came out and played that entire game against Washington. Torrey Schroeder came in and did a fantastic job for us. We got a big hit obviously by Brittany Chalk. We just kept competing just unfortunately we came up a little bit short.”

On adjusting to Washington’s pitching:

“Well, I think against Delaware State we were warmed up. They’re not going to throw anything by you. They’re going to mix speeds a lot and you have to have the mindset to let the ball get deep and try to drive the ball up the middle. I think we made some adjustments as the game went on but sometimes it takes some time to do that. In the second game I thought we had some good at bats. We anticipated what we were going to see, we knew what her go-to pitch was, but she’s good and I think you have to tip your hat to her as well.”
