Under Protest:

The Horizon League ruled that UIC's protest of April 6th's 3-2 loss against Youngstown State has been upheld. The game only will be finished from the play in question, if the outcome of the contest will not directly affect the seeding of either team, heading into the Horizon League tournament. The Horizon League's ruling will take the loss away from UIC.

Ain't He Grand:

Junior **Curtis Granderson (Lynwood, Ill./T.F. South)** is second in the nation in hitting with an batting average of .515 announced by the NCAA as of April 23rd. Granderson enters today's contest with an average of .521.

Pitching Prowess:

UIC has been very successful from the mound this season as the Flames are allowing a meager 3.18 earned runs per contest.

Dr.K:

Senior **Wes Gilliam (South Holland, Ill./Thornwood)** has been quite impressive this season, as he has struck out 45 batters in his six starts along with an ERA of 2.82 for a record of 5-0. Gilliam is currently tied for third in school history with 182 strikeouts during his career with **RC Lichtenstein (1987-91)**. The South Holland, Ill., native needs 12 more strikeouts to pass **Ed Chibe (1980-83)** for second in UIC history.

Hit Machine:

Junior outfielder **Curtis Granderson** has picked up 73 basehits this season. The Lynwood, Ill., native is 11 hits away from breaking the single-season record of 83, held by **Jim Noble (1982)**. Granderson has 193 career hits and is tied for fifth in UIC history with **Eric Duke (1997-2000)**. Granderson needs four more hits to pass **Kelly Kropp (1988-91)** for fourth in school history.

Big Time:

Sophomore **Mike Hughes (Hoffman Estates, Ill./Fremd)** was instrumental in the Flames' 3-2 upset of #23 Ohio State on March 23rd as he notched a two-out, two-run single in the bottom of the fifth inning.

Milestone:

UIC head coach **Mike Dee** earned his 100th career victory on March 30th as the Flames cruised past Viterbo, 8-0, in the second game of their doubleheader.

Going Yard:

Junior outfielder **Curtis Granderson** connected for his league-leading eighth home run of the season against Wright State on April 20th. Granderson has accumulated 24 home runs over his short career, which is second in UIC history.

Running Man:

Junior **Curtis Granderson** needs one more run to break **Frank Provenzano's** record of 57 in a single-season set in 1985. Granderson is tied for second in UIC history with 159 career runs scored.

Take It To The Banks:

Senior **Larry Banks (Cicero, Ill./Nazareth)** leads the Horizon League with an earned run average of 1.86. Banks is currently 7-3 on the season.

Preseason Predictions:

UIC, who finished second in the regular season in 2001, has been picked to finish second again in the Horizon League in a preseason poll of head coaches. UW-Milwaukee, which won the league title a year ago, was picked as the preseason favorite with four first-place votes.

Home Sweet Home:

UIC has found life at Les Miller Field more than enjoyable over the last three years as the Flames have compiled a record of 50-12 at home.

Tough Losses:

UIC will be without the services of junior left fielder **J.P. Moran (Burlington, Wis./Westosha Central)** for the entire 2002 season due to a tear in his throwing shoulder. Moran, a second-team All-Conference selection last season, batted .337 with three home runs and 33 RBI in 2001. Junior **Weber Bowen (Minneapolis, Minn./Blake School)** was also lost for the season as he tore his right anterior cruciate ligament in a collision at first base against Ohio State on March 23rd. Senior center fielder **John Rosner (Ottawa, Ill./Marquette)** will be on the shelf for a minimum of four weeks after breaking his right hand against Northern Illinois on April 17th.

Draft Dodgers:

Freshmen **Andy Sigerich (Downers Grove, Ill./Downers Grove North)** and **Ryan Gehring (Burlington, Wis./Central Catholic)** were both selected in the 2001 Major League Baseball Draft. Sigerich was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 31st round (928th overall), while Gehring was nabbed in the 33rd round by the Minnesota Twins (977th overall).

Broken Record:

Junior **Weber Bowen** had a monster day at the plate in UIC's 27-1 victory against Tennessee-Martin on March 8th as he went 6-for-7, with a pair of three-run blasts for a school-record eight RBI. The previous record of seven RBI was held by **Larry Rubin (1990), Jim Nesci (1992)** and **Jon Piazza (1996)**.
