#### SETTING THE TABLE:

UIC plays its second doubleheader in three days when it hosts Cleveland State in a pair of Horizon League games at Les Miller Field on Sunday...This will be UIC's first meeting with the Vikings since last season...The two teams last met on May 24, 2007 in the Horizon League Tournament, where the Flames defeated the Vikings 8-5 at Les Miller Field...UIC swept last season's four-game regular season series over Cleveland State...With Wright State concluding its Horizon League campaign at 16-6 on Saturday and holding the tiebreaker over the Flames by way of a 3-2 advantage in the season series, UIC must win all five of its remaining Horizon League games to clinch its seventh straight regular season title and the No. 1 seed in the 2008 Horizon League Tournament...By winning all five and moving to 17-6, the Flames would have a league winning percentage of .739, slightly better than Wright State's .727...UIC's leading hitter continues to be rookie center fielder **Steve McGuiggan (Burnsville, Minn./Apple Valley H.S.)**, who is batting .373 (66-for-177)...In UIC's last five games McGuiggan is hitting a team-best .500 (12-for-24) to go with an on-base percentage of .571.

#### SCHAEFER BREAKING OUT IN A BIG WAY:

Junior 1B/DH **Brett Schaefer (Orland Park, Ill./Brother Rice)** has made a big improvement at the plate during his third season. Schaefer combined to hit .241 (26-for-108) with one home run and seven RBI in 44 games in his first two years. This season Schaefer is batting .338 (54-for-160) with six home runs and a team-high 40 RBI in 44 games. He is also UIC's leading hitter in conference play, batting at a clip of .343 (23-for-67) against Horizon League pitching.

#### ADAM UNTOUCHABLE OF LATE:

Junior RHP **Adam Worthington (Gurnee, Ill./Warren H.S.)** has been stout out of the bullpen in his last seven appearances. In 11.1 innings during that span, Worthington has not been charged with a single run while fanning 10 hitters. Opposing hitters are batting just .135 (5-for-37) against him in that stretch. His earned run average has dropped from 4.07 to 2.78 since April 15. Worthington leads the Horizon League in games finished at 22.

#### CARR STARTING TO DRIVE:

Junior OF **Jake Carr (Frankfort, Ill./Marian Catholic)** has picked it up offensively in UIC's last 17 games. He is hitting .361 (26-for-72) in that span, gathering 20 of his 25 RBI in his last 17 starts. Carr has nine extra-base hits in that stretch, including a pair of doubles on Friday at Milwaukee, for a slugging percentage of .514. He comes into Sunday's doubleheader on a season-high eight-game hitting streak.

### MCGUIGGAN MCHITTIN WITH TWO OUTS:

True freshman center fielder **Steve McGuiggan** is the man to have at the plate when the Flames need a hit with two outs in an inning. McGuiggan is hitting a team-high .373 (22-for-59) with two outs. **Jake Carr** is the next-best at getting on board with a base knock when two outs appear on the scoreboard; he has a batting average of .370 (17-for-46) in that situation.

### DOWN TO THE WIRE:

The Flames have played in plenty of close games during their first 44 outings. 21 of UIC's games have been decided by two runs or less, including 15 games determined by a single run. The Flames are 11-10 in games with a final margin of no more than two scores, while the Flames are 8-7 in one-run affairs.

### A STEAL DEAL:

UIC has already stolen 78 bases through 44 games this season. The Flames accumulated 54 stolen bases in 56 games last year and 57 bags during a 55-contest campaign in 2006. This year's total already represents the most stolen bases by the team since the Flames took 96 bases in 60 games in 2005; that season the Flames averaged 1.6 steals per game, while UIC is averaging 1.8 this year.

### DEVIN KNOCKING ON THE DOOR:

True freshman outfielder **Devin Melecio (Chicago, Ill./Clemente H.S.)** made his recent insertion into the lineup look like a very smart decision. In the last five games, all in which Melecio has started, he has hit .412 (7-for-17) with a pair of home runs, nine runs scored, an on-base percentage of .565 and a slugging percentage of .824.

### TONY TAKING A TON OF BASES:

Junior utility man **Tony Altavilla (Lakeville, Minn./Lakeville H.S./College of Southern Idaho)** has been the catalyst behind UIC's running game. Altavilla leads the team with 18 stolen bases in 26 attempts. He's been a threat on the basepaths all year, posting an on-base percentage of .399.

### KEVIN CATCHING FIRE:

Junior catcher **Kevin Coddington (West Linn, Ore./West Linn H.S./Chemeketa College)** is swinging a hot stick these days. Coddington is batting .364 (12-for-33) in the Flames' last nine games, with half of those 12 hits of the extra-base variety. He has hit three doubles, a triple and two homers since April 20, slugging at a clip of .697.

### LAST TIME OUT:

**May 9, 2008 - Milwaukee 6, UIC 3; UIC 7, Milwaukee 3 (Henry Aaron Field - Milwaukee, Wis.)**

UIC split a doubleheader with Milwaukee at Henry Aaron Field on Friday, falling 6-3 in the opener before winning a 7-3 decision in the finale. The Flames scored twice in the first inning and padded that early lead with a three-run third during a 7-3 victory over the Panthers in Friday's nightcap. **Jake Carr** and **Kevin Coddington** drove in two runs apiece during the second game. Left-hander **Don Phillis (Streator, Ill./Marquette H.S.)** earned his fifth win of the year with three innings of relief, coming on with two outs and the bases loaded in the fifth and inducing a rally-killing groundout. In the first game Milwaukee scored five times with two outs in the seventh to break open a one-run game and defeat UIC, 6-3. The game was a pitchers' duel between UIC's **Derrick Miramontes (Durham, Calif./Durham H.S./Butte College)** and Milwaukee's Andy Hetebrueg until the fateful seventh frame in which five straight Panther hitter reached base with two away, a stretch capped by three consecutive RBI hits.

### ON DECK:

The Flames cap the regular season this week with four games. UIC plays its final regular season road game on Wednesday against Big Ten foe Purdue in West Lafayette, Ind. at 3 p.m. The Flames then return home to cap the slate prior to the Horizon League Tournament with three crucial games against Valparaiso at Les Miller Field beginning on Friday night and wrapping with a Saturday doubleheader.
