SETTING THE TABLE:

UIC wraps up the 2008 regular season campaign with four games this week...The Flames head to West Lafayette, Ind. to take on Purdue this Wednesday afternoon at 4 p.m. Eastern/3 p.m. Central...The week concludes with a crucial three-game series against Valparaiso at Les Miller Field this Friday and Saturday...UIC must win all three games against the Crusaders to clinch its seventh straight Horizon League regular season title and the No. 1 seed in next week's 2008 Horizon League Baseball Championship presented by U.S. Army in Niles, Ohio...The Flames have won five of their last seven games...Pacing UIC offensively is true freshman center fielder **Steve McGuiggan (Burnsville, Minn./Apple Valley H.S.)**, who is hitting .371 (69-for-186)...McGuiggan is hitting .455 (15-for-33) in UIC's last seven games...McGuiggan has become UIC's first true freshman starting center fielder since current Detroit Tiger **Curtis Granderson** patrolled center for the Flames as a rookie in 2000.

ADAM UNTOUCHABLE OF LATE:

Junior RHP **Adam Worthington (Gurnee, Ill./Warren H.S.)** has been stout out of the bullpen of late. He has a consecutive scoreless innings streak at 14.1 and counting, a span in which he has allowed just eight hits in 49 at-bats (.163 opponent batting average).

SCHAEFER BREAKING OUT IN A BIG WAY:

Junior 1B/DH **Brett Schaefer (Orland Park, Ill./Brother Rice)** has made a big improvement at the plate during his third season. Schaefer combined to hit .241 (26-for-108) with one home run and seven RBI in 44 games in his first two years. This season Schaefer is batting .337 (56-for-166) with six home runs and a team-high 44 RBI in 46 games. He is also UIC's second-leading hitter in conference play, batting at a clip of .342 (25-for-73) against Horizon League pitching, and in UIC's last 13 games he has hit .396 (19-for-48) with 15 RBI.

CARR STARTING TO DRIVE:

Junior OF **Jake Carr (Frankfort, Ill./Marian Catholic)** has picked it up offensively in UIC's last 20 games. He is hitting .365 (27-for-74) in that span, gathering 20 of his 28 RBI in that timeframe. Carr is currently on a 10-game hitting streak in which he is batting .405 (17-for-42) with eight doubles.

FLAMES AGAINST THIS WEEK'S FOES:

UIC is 3-5 all-time against the Boilermakers, with the last meeting taking place on March 9, 1995 in Winter Park, Fla. The Flames earned a 13-5 victory over Purdue. UIC is 42-33 all-time against Valparaiso, with two of those victories coming during a doubleheader sweep of the Crusaders back on April 18 in Valparaiso.

MCGUIGGAN MCHITTIN WITH TWO OUTS:

True freshman center fielder **Steve McGuiggan** is the man to have at the plate when the Flames need a hit with two outs in an inning. McGuiggan is hitting a team-high .365 (23-for-63) with two outs. **Jake Carr** is the next-best at getting on board with a base knock when two outs appear on the scoreboard; he has a batting average of .670 (18-for-50) in that situation.

DOWN TO THE WIRE:

The Flames have played in plenty of close games during their first 46 outings. 21 of UIC's games have been decided by two runs or less, including 15 games determined by a single run. The Flames are 11-10 in games with a final margin of no more than two scores, while the Flames are 8-7 in one-run affairs.

A STEAL DEAL:

UIC have stolen 81 bases through 46 games this season. The Flames accumulated 54 stolen bases in 56 games last year and 57 bags during a 55-contest campaign in 2006. This year's total already represents the most stolen bases by the team since the Flames took 96 bases in 60 games in 2005; that season the Flames averaged 1.6 steals per game, while UIC is averaging 1.8 this year.

DEVIN KNOCKING ON THE DOOR:

True freshman outfielder **Devin Melecio (Chicago, Ill./Clemente H.S.)** made his recent insertion into the lineup look like a very smart decision. In the last seven games, all in which Melecio has started, he has hit .304 (7-for-23) with a pair of home runs, nine runs scored, an on-base percentage of .367 and a slugging percentage of .609.

TONY TAKING A TON OF BASES:

Junior utility man **Tony Altavilla (Lakeville, Minn./Lakeville H.S./College of Southern Idaho)** has been the catalyst behind UIC's running game. Altavilla leads the team with 18 stolen bases in 26 attempts. He's been a threat on the basepaths all year, posting an on-base percentage of .399.

KEVIN CATCHING FIRE:

Junior catcher **Kevin Coddington (West Linn, Ore./West Linn H.S./Chemeketa College)** is swinging a hot stick these days. Coddington is batting .353 (12-for-34) in the Flames' last nine games, with half of those 12 hits of the extra-base variety. He has hit three doubles, a triple and two homers during that stretch, slugging at a clip of .676.

KEEPING HIS KOOL WHEN IT COMES TO BALLS AND STRIKES:

Junior pitcher **Mike Kool (Davenport, Iowa/Central H.S./Black Hawk College)** has mastered the art of control in his last 24.1 innings of work. During that span he has allowed just two walks, compared to six walks in the 15.1 innings he pitched prior to that stretch.

RAFI SWINGING IN THE SECOND HALF:

Rookie shortstop **Rafael Garcia (Chicago, Ill./Clemente H.S.)** has made a big turnaround at the plate in UIC's last 23 games. During the Flames' first 23 contests the true freshman hit .234 (15-for-64) with five RBI; in the last 23 he is hitting nearly 100 points higher at .324 (24-for-74) with 16 RBI. His on-base percentage in the first half of games was .319, while in the last half he has an OBP of .454.

LAST TIME OUT:

May 11, 2008 - UIC 6, Cleveland State 2; UIC 4, Cleveland State 1 (Les Miller Field)

UIC swept a Mother's Day doubleheader over Cleveland State on Sunday night. **Mike Kool** tossed a complete game gem, and a four-run fifth inning provided plenty of offensive cushion in UIC's 6-2 victory over Cleveland State in the opener. Kool scattered seven hits and allowed just one earned run for his second complete game of the season. In the nightcap **Chris Kovacevich (Frankfort, Ill./Lincoln-Way East/Coastal Carolina)** turned in a strong six-plus inning start, and closer **Adam Worthington** sealed the deal as UIC defeated Cleveland State, 4-1. Kovacevich, who allowed just two hits in six and a third, tossed four hitless innings to begin the game. Worthington came on to finish the final two and two-thirds to get the save.

FLAMES AGAINST THE BIG TEN:

Since head coach **Mike Dee** took the helm of the UIC program back in 1998, the Flames are 24-11 against Big Ten opponents entering Wednesday's game at Purdue. UIC is 3-1 thus far against the Big Ten in 2008.
