RedHawks Notes: Miami (OH) enters Tuesday night's tilt with UIC with a record of 1-2 on the year after collecting a 52-33 victory at home on Nov. 17 over Florida A&M in its opening game of the inaugural Chicago Invitational Challenge. The RedHawks dropped their first two contests of the year to Wright State (57-56) and Kentucky (57-46). On the floor, Miami (OH) is paced by All-MAC forward Nathan Peavy, who is averaging 15.3 points and 5.3 rebounds per game while shooting 52 percent from the field and 50 percent from three-point range. Wing Michael Bramos is the other RedHawk averaging in double-figures in scoring at 10.3 ppg. Miami (OH) has made back-to-back NIT appearances under the direction of Charlie Coles, who is in his 13th season with the RedHawks.

UIC AND MIAMI (OH), THE SERIES:

Tuesday night's tilt will mark the first-ever meeting between UIC and Miami (OH).

UIC AND MIAMI (OH) QUICK HITS:

- Miami (OH) is the first of three games this season on UIC's schedule versus MAC schools. The Flames will travel to meet Northern Illinois on Dec. 5 and will then welcome Akron to the Pavilion on Dec. 16.
- Miami (OH) is 0-1 this year against Horizon League teams, dropping a 57-56 home decision to Wright State on Nov. 11.
- UIC's last win over a MAC school came in a 55-54 triumph over Northern Illinois on Dec. 17, 2005.

FLAMES AND REDHAWKS, CONTRASTING STYLES:

Something will have to give on Tuesday when UIC and Miami (OH) tangle on the hardwood. The Flames enter the contest averaging 78.7 points per game and shooting 44 percent from the field as a team. The RedHawks, meanwhile, have yet to top the 60-point mark in a game this season, but are allowing a miniscule 49.0 points per outing, while opponents are shooting just 37 percent against them. No team has scored more than 60 points against Miami (OH) this season while UIC has yet to be held under 70.

THE CHALLENGE CONTINUES:

Tuesday's game is the second for both UIC and Miami (OH) in the inaugural Chicago Invitational Challenge. The four-game event saw the Flames fall at Bradley in their opening game while the RedHawks topped Florida A&M. The Flames, Braves and RedHawks will meet up with Illinois, Rutgers, Florida A&M, Jackson State and Savannah State at the new Sears Centre in Hoffman Estates, Ill., for the final two games Nov. 24-25.

LAST TIME OUT: Bradley 81, UIC 72 (11/19/06 – Peoria, Ill.)

For the second straight game the UIC men's basketball team ran into a hot shooting team on its home floor as host Bradley connected on 12 three-pointers and shot 50 percent from the field in an 81-72 win over the Flames in front of 8,860 at Carver Arena. Junior guard Jeremy Crouch and senior post Zach Andrews did most of the

damage for the Braves (3-0). Crouch connected on seven three-pointers en route to a career-best 29 points, while Andrews tabbed a double-double with career highs of 26 points and 15 rebounds. The loss spoiled another strong offensive output for UIC (1-2). Sophomore Josh Mayo led the way with a team-high 16 points. Junior T.J. Gray scored 14 points, while Kevin Bond (10 points, 6 rebounds) and Karl White (11 points, 3 steals) also reached double-figures in scoring. Junior Othys Jeffers pulled down a team-best 10 rebounds. Sophomore Scott VanderMeer, who got the starting nod at center, totaled a season-high eight boards.

YOU CAN'T HOLD THE MAYO:

Sophomore Josh Mayo is UIC's leading scorer through the first three games of the season, averaging 16.7 points per outing. The 5-foot-10 point guard is shooting 58 percent from the field and 47 percent from three-point range. Mayo is also the team leader in assists (3.3 apg) and has yet to miss a free throw. Mayo had the best offensive performance of his career at Davidson on Nov. 15, finishing with 26 points, going 9-for-15 from the field and a personal-best 6-of-9 from three-point range.

FILLING IN NICELY:

Sophomore Scott VanderMeer took the place of Danijel Zoric in the starting lineup for UIC at Bradley on Nov. 19. The 6-foot-11 post came through for the Flames, pulling down a personal-best eight rebounds against the Braves, while adding three points.

CASHING IN WITH BOND:

Junior Kevin Bond has stepped into UIC's starting rotation this season and is quickly paying dividends for the Flames. Through his first three career starts, Bond is averaging 9.3 points and 3.3 rebounds per game and is shooting 50 percent from the field. Bond has been especially strong in his last two outings, posting back-to-back double-digit scoring efforts for the first time in his career. Last time out versus Bradley, Bond recorded 10 points and pulled down a career-best six rebounds, while pilfering a pair of steals.

WHITE IS IN AFTER LABOR DAY:

Junior Karl White enjoyed his best game of the 2006-07 campaign on Nov. 19 at Bradley, scoring 11 points, collecting three steals and pulling down a pair of rebounds against the Braves in just 19 minutes on the floor. The double-figure scoring output was White's first since scoring 11 points at Detroit on Jan. 21, 2006. White is now averaging 5.7 points and 1.7 rebounds per game this season.

GRAY IS MORE THAN O.K.:

Junior T.J. Gray has provided quite a spark for UIC off the bench in his last two outings. The Western Illinois transfer netted 16 points and dished out four assists at Davidson on Nov. 15 and then backed that up with a 14-point effort at Bradley on November 19. In both games, Gray netted four three-pointers. He is now third on the team in scoring (10.7 ppg) and is shooting 40 percent from behind the three-point line.

HITTING THEM WITH EVERYTHING WE'VE GOT:

UIC sampled a majority of its lineup on Nov. 19 at Bradley with 12 different players seeing action in the first half versus the Braves. Nine of those players scored in the opening stanza, including a free throw by D.J. Smedley, which marked the reserve guard's first point Nov. 23, 2005.

PLENTY OF OFFENSE AT DAVIDSON:

UIC showed plenty of offense in its 100-89 loss to Davidson on Nov. 15. Five different players scored in double-figures, paced by sophomore Josh Mayo's 26. The Flames shot 52 percent from the field as a team and connected on 11-of-21 three-point attempts. The last time UIC scored more than 89 points in a non-overtime contest was back on Dec. 20, 2003, in a 90-71 win over Northwestern.

JEFFERS PULLS DOWN ANOTHER 10:

Junior Othys Jeffers collected his first double-digit rebounding performance of the season on Nov. 19 at Bradley with 10 rebounds versus the Braves. It was Jeffers' 12th career double-digit rebounding game and his first since Feb. 18, 2006 at Murray State. The 6-foot-5 guard/forward is second on the team in rebounding at 7.0 rpg.

ON LEAVE:

Senior Danijel Zoric is currently taking an indefinite leave of absence from the UIC men's basketball team. Sophomore Scott VanderMeer will fill his role in the starting rotation for the Flames.

STEFANOV STEPPING IT UP:

Fifth-year senior Jovan Stefanov is off to a strong start in his final season with the Flames. The 6-foot-9 forward leads the team in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and field goal percentage (.600), while rating fourth in scoring (9.7 ppg).

NOT A BAD OPENER FOR JEFFERS:

Junior Othys Jeffers had quite a performance in the Flames' season-opener versus St. Edward's on Nov. 11. The 6-foot-5 guard totaled a career-best 24 points, going 7-for-12 from the field and a perfect 10-for-10 from the free throw line. Jeffers also added a personal-best five steals to go with eight rebounds and a pair of assists in the win. Jeffers' previous career-high scoring output was 19 points set last season versus Detroit on Feb. 4.

HIGH FIVE:

UIC has posted five consecutive winning seasons under head coach Jimmy Collins. The Flames have won 20 or more games in three of the five years, including a school-record 24 victories during the 2003-04 campaign. UIC has made two NCAA Tournament appearances (2002, 2004) and one trip to the NIT (2003) during the stretch.

COACH COLLINS IS NO. 1:

Headmaster Jimmy Collins continues to add to his record as UIC's all-time winningest men's basketball coach in his 11th season with the Flames with 163 career victories. Collins, who has guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances during his tenure, became the program's all-time leader in wins during the 2004-05 campaign with career victory No. 134 in a road triumph at UNC Wilmington on Dec. 12th.

COLLINS IS QUITE THE FAMILIAR FACE:

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is entering his 11th season at the helm of the UIC basketball program. That makes him the longest tenured Division I college basketball coach in the state of Illinois.

NON-CONFERENCE KNOWHOW:

The Flames posted some significant non-conference victories in 2005-06. UIC finished the regular season as the only team in the country with non-league wins over teams from the ACC (Georgia Tech), SEC (Ole Miss) and Big Ten (Northwestern). The Flames' wins over Georgia Tech and Ole Miss also marked the team's first-ever victories over programs from those respective conferences. UIC also notched two other impressive non-conference wins last season, knocking off future NCAA Tournament teams in San Diego State and Davidson.

UIC GETTING TALLER:

UIC enters the 2006-07 season with a roster that features 11 players over 6-foot-4 and six players over 6-foot-7. Sophomore Scott VanderMeer is the tallest Flame at 6-foot-11, while the Serbian trio of seniors Jovan Stefanov and Danijel Zoric and redshirt freshman Jovan Ignjatovic check in at 6-foot-9.

BRINGING DIVISION I EXPERIENCE TO THE TABLE:

Sophomore Scott VanderMeer and junior T.J. Gray both may be newcomers in the UIC lineup, but both bring Division I experience. VanderMeer, a 6-foot-11 post, played one season at Bowling Green State, where he ranked fifth in the Mid-American Conference in blocked shots. Gray, a 5-foot-9 guard, was a two-year performer at Western Illinois where he averaged over 10 points per game and shot better than 40% from three-point range.

EARLY SIGNEES:

Robert Kreps (Guard, 6-0, Maroa-Forsyth HS)

Illinois Class A All-State First Team guard Robert Kreps signed a National Letter of Intent with UIC on Nov. 9. The 6-foot sharp-shooter averaged over 19 points and four rebounds per game for Maroa-Forsyth last year, leading the Trojans to a 31-3 record and third-place finish in the state tournament. The future Flame is also a standout football player, topping the 1,000-yard plateau as a wide receiver for the Trojans, who will play in the IHSA Class 2A title game on Friday.

Tori Boyd (Guard/Forward, 6-5, Rockford Boylan HS)

Tori Boyd, a highly-touted senior at Rockford Boylan HS, signed a National Letter of Intent with UIC on Nov. 14. The 6-foot-5 wing was an All-NIC9 honoree last season, leading the Titans to a conference title, averaging 13.5 points and 6.4 rebounds per game.

A TRANSFER WAITING IN THE WINGS:

UIC fans will have to wait until the 2007-08 campaign to see 6-foot-7 forward Jeremy Buttell take to the hardwood as he sits out this season per NCAA transfer rules after joining the Flames following one year at Texas

Tech. Buttell was a prep standout in the Dallas/Fort Worth area at Colleyville Heritage High School, where he was a two-time All-State honoree and was named the 2005 Texas 5A Offensive Player of the Year. While he will not be able to see game action or travel with the squad this year, Buttell will be able to practice with the team.

SCHEDULE NOTES:

* UIC plays seven games this season against 2006 NCAA Tournament teams with Davidson, Bradley, Murray State, Illinois, Penn and UW-Milwaukee (2) all on the slate. The Flames are 0-2 this season in games against NCAA teams from last season after falling at Davidson and Bradley.

* The Flames have an Illinois intensive schedule in 2006-07 with six games versus in-state opponents. UIC has enjoyed great success against its intra-state rivals under head coach Jimmy Collins, boasting a 42-24 (.636) record since the 1996-97 campaign. The Flames are 0-1 against in-state rivals this season after falling at Bradley on Nov. 19.

* UIC wastes little time making its longest road trip of the season with a five-game swing over 10 days taking place Nov. 15-25. The Flames will play at Davidson, Bradley and Miami (OH) to start the trip before finishing with a pair of games at the Chicago Challenge Invitational at the new Sears Centre in Hoffman Estates, Ill.

* The Flames' busiest week will come Dec. 16-23, with four games slated in the seven-day stretch. UIC will start the run with a home game versus one of the preseason favorites in the Mid-American Conference, Akron, at home on Saturday, Dec. 16. The Flames will then travel to Mississippi (12/19) and Penn (12/21) all before returning home to take on Illinois State at the Pavilion on Dec. 23.

* UIC will meet Illinois at the United Center on Dec. 9 with the Flames looking for their first win over the Fighting Illini since Nov. 29, 1990. UIC bested Illinois 71-60 that evening at Assembly Hall. Ironically UIC head coach Jimmy Collins and associate head coach Mark Coomes were assistant coaches with the Illini at the time.

UIC HEAD COACH

Jimmy Collins

(163-140, 11th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 11th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 163 career wins, but is also the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last five years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.

- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
