UIC welcomes Central Michigan to the Pavilion for a non-conference affair on Saturday as part of the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters event... This is the fifth year of the BracketBusters series and UIC has been a part of the event each season, owning a 3-1 record in its prior games... The Flames are 2-1 against Mid-American Conference schools this season, topping Akron and Northern Illinois while dropping a road decision to Miami (OH)... UIC has never beaten Central Michigan, with the Chippewas owning a 3-0 record in the all-time series... These two teams last met in Mount Pleasant, Mich, back during the 2000-01 season... Junior Robert Bush has scored in double-figures in his last three games since being inserted into the starting rotation... The Flames are 10-4 this season when scoring 70 points or more in a game and 0-13 when they don't... UIC plays its regular-season home finale versus UWM on Feb. 21.

Chippewas Notes: Central Michigan enters Saturday's game having won its last two games, including a 71-66 home victory on Wednesday night over Western Michigan. In that contest, forward Sefton Barrett poured in a game-high 24 points on 8-of-11 shooting, while pulling down seven rebounds and blocking three shots. Giordan Watson added 22 points and six boards in the win. The Chippewas are 5-7 in the Mid-American Conference, which is good for third place in the West Division. Watson paces Central Michigan's offensive attack, averaging 18.4 points per game. He is the only player on his team scoring in double figures and has taken more than twice as many shots than anyone else on the squad. Barrett is the team's top rebounder (5.5) and second-leading scorer (9.5 ppg). The Chippewas are a strong free throw shooting squad, converting 73 percent of their attempts from the charity stripe. Ernie Zeigler is in his first season as head coach at Central Michigan after spending the last three seasons as an assistant coach at UCLA.

UIC AND CENTRAL MICHIGAN, THE SERIES:

UIC has never beaten Central Michigan as the Chippewas are 3-0 all-time against the Flames.

FLAMES vs. CHIPPEWAS SERIES NUGGETS:

- * The first meeting between the two schools came in the 1972-73 season lid-lifter at Central Michigan with the Chippewas downing UIC, 74-62.
- * The two teams played a home-and-home series in 1999-2000 and 2000-01 with Central Michigan winning at the Pavilion, 78-75, and then topping the Flames at home, 70-56, in their last confrontation.
- * Central Michigan marks the fourth Mid-American Conference team the Flames have played this season with UIC owning a 2-1 record in the prior contests with wins over Akron and Northern Illinois while dropping a road decision at Miami (OH).

UIC AND THE BRACKETBUSTERS SERIES:

UIC has played in all four prior BracketBusters events and enjoyed great success, owning a 3-1 record, including a perfect 3-0 mark in home games in the series. In the inaugural BracketBusters game, the Flames hosted Bowling Green in front of a nationally-televised audience and topped the Falcons, 83-72. UIC followed that with wins over UNC Wilmington (77-52) in 2003-04 and Georgia Southern 92-83 in 2004-05. Last season marked the Flames' first BracketBusters setback, as UIC was edged by Murray State, 72-68, in Kentucky.

LAST TIME WE MET:

Central Michigan 70, UIC 56 – November 25, 2000 (Mount Pleasant, Mich.)

UIC shot just 34 percent from the field and committed 21 turnovers as Central Michigan earned a 14-point home victory over the Flames on Nov. 25, 2000. Taurus Cook led UIC with 11 points while Joel Bullock added 10. The Chippewas were paced by David Webber, who tallied a game-high 24 points.

LAST TIME OUT:

UW-Green Bay 65, UIC 55 – February 14, 2007 (UIC Pavilion)

Sophomore Josh Mayo scored 15 points and senior Jovan Stefanov collected 10 rebounds, but it was not enough for UIC to overcome a poor shooting night from the field as the Flames suffered a 65-55 setback at home to UW-Green Bay on Wednesday (Feb. 14) night. The Flames shot under 30 percent from the field in the contest and were never able to overcome a 10-2 run by the Phoenix to close out the first half. UW-Green Bay took a four-point lead into intermission and then built its advantage to nine (38-29) by scoring the first five points of the second stanza. Senior Ryan Evanochko led the Phoenix with 21 points while Ryan Tillema came off the bench to hit five three-pointers for 15 points. Junior Robert Bush tallied 10 points for the Flames in defeat.

WHAT'S UP NEXT:

UIC concludes its three-game homestand on Wednesday, Feb. 21 by welcoming UW-Milwaukee to the Pavilion for 'Senior Night'. The Flames will be looking to even the season series with the Panthers after UWM bested UIC, 76-65, back on Jan. 17.

COLLINS TO RETURN FOR 2007-08 CAMPAIGN:

Head Coach Jimmy Collins announced on Tuesday (Feb. 13) that he will return to full-time coaching duties later this spring in preparation for the 2007-08 season after a complete recovery from an abdominal aortic aneurysm. Collins had a procedure to repair the aneurysm on Jan. 4 and has not been on the sidelines since the Dec. 21 game at Penn. Associate Head Coach Mark Coomes will remain at the helm of the program for the remainder of the season in Collins' absence.

OTHYUS FOR ALL-LEAGUE:

Junior Othys Jeffers is putting up quite a case for All-Horizon League consideration this season. Jeffers leads UIC in scoring (15.7 ppg), rebounding (8.9 rpg), field goal percentage (.489) and steals (1.7 spg), while ranking in the Top 10 in the Horizon League in each category. He has a team-best 10 double-doubles to his credit this year, including one in three of his last six outings.

BUSH FILLING THE STARTERS ROLE QUITE NICELY:

Junior Robert Bush has provided UIC with a lift since being entered into the starting unit the last three games, averaging 11.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per outing. Versus UW-Green Bay on Wednesday (Feb. 14), Bush notched his third straight double-figure scoring outing with 10 points on 4-of-9 shooting. For the season, Bush is averaging personal bests of 6.3 points and 2.5 rebounds per game.

SCORING 70:

Reaching the 70-point mark offensively has been a barometer for success for UIC this season as the Flames are 10-4 when scoring 70 or more. On the other end of the spectrum, UIC is 0-13 when not reaching the 70-point plateau.

JEFFERS ON A RECORD PACE AT GETTING TO THE LINE:

Junior Othys Jeffers has gotten to the free throw line early and often this season as his 178 free throw attempts ranks fourth in the UIC single-season record book and is the most since Bobby Locke's 191 charity tosses in 1986-87. The record for free throw attempts in a season is 219 set by Greg Olsen in 1970-71. Jeffers also rates ninth in the single-season record book for free throws made with 115, tying his cousin Mark Miller's mark set in 1995-96.

QUEST FOR A FIRST ROUND HOME GAME:

UIC has its eye on a home game in the first round of the Horizon League Tournament, which the Flames can earn by finishing fourth, fifth or sixth in the final standings. With two league games remaining, UIC is in a three-way tie for sixth with UW-Milwaukee, the Flames' opponent on Wednesday, Feb. 21, and Detroit. UIC sits just a game behind Youngstown State. Those four teams all have two games remaining next week.

VANDERMEER ON THE BOARDS:

Known as the league's preeminent shot blocker, 6-foot-11 center Scott VanderMeer has been a monster on the boards of late as well. In his last four outings, the sophomore is averaging 10.0 rebounds per game. VanderMeer tied for top honors on the team on Wednesday (Feb. 14) versus UW-Green Bay with eight rebounds. For the season, VanderMeer now rates third on the team in rebounding at 5.5 rpg.

YOU CAN'T HOLD THE MAYO:

Sophomore Josh Mayo has been hot from behind the three-point arc, connecting on 13 of his last 23 triple attempts (57%). Scoring 16, 13, 15 and 15 points, respectively, in each of his last four outings has raised his season average to a single-season best 11.5 points per game, second best on the squad.

THIS SENIOR IS STEPPING UP:

Senior Jovan Stefanov is coming on of late for UIC. The 6-foot-9 forward is averaging 12.8 points and 7.3 rebounds in his last five games. This recent surge has pushed his season scoring average to a personal-best 10.0 ppg while he rates second on the team in rebounding (5.7 rpg).

MR. DOWNTOWN:

Junior T.J. Gray has provided UIC with quite a spark in his first season with the team. The 5-foot-9 guard, who has started and been an explosive sixth-man off the bench, is third on the team in scoring at 11.0 points per game, while he leads the team in three-pointers made per game (2.9) and in three-point field goal percentage (.417). Gray's 75 three-pointers made this year ranks sixth in the UIC single-season records book and he is 15 triples shy of Cedrick Banks' record of 90 set in 2003-04.

KING OF THE BLOCK:

Sophomore center Scott VanderMeer needed just 21 games to become the UIC single-season record holder for blocked shots as his two swats at UW-Green Bay on Jan. 24 pushed him past the mark of 67 held by Dave Williams (1981-82) and Sherell Ford (1992-93). VanderMeer, who boasts more blocks than six teams in the Horizon League and ranks in the top five nationally in the category, has continued to raise the blocked shot record as he now owns 92 on the year.

DOUBLE-DIGIT THREES:

The Flames netted 11 three-pointers at Youngstown State on Feb. 3, marking the eighth time this season that UIC has converted at least 10 triples in a game. Prior to this season, the Flames had converted 10 or more three-pointers in a game just six times in the previous four years combined. The eight games with double-digit triples is the most since the 2001-02 team posted nine games with 10 three-pointers or more.

DOUBLE-DIPPING:

Junior Othys Jeffers racked up his single-season best 10th double-double of the season and the 17th of his career against Wright State on Feb. 7, finishing with 14 points and 11 rebounds. Jeffers has come up just shy of five other double-doubles this year against Bradley (9 points, 10 rebounds), Murray State (16 points, 9 rebounds), Akron (16 points, 9 rebounds), Butler (9 points, 12 rebounds) and UW-Green Bay (18 points, 9 rebounds).

OUR OWN ALL-NEWCOMER TEAM:

UIC features three players this season who deserve strong consideration for Horizon League All-Newcomer Team accolades. Junior T.J. Gray, a transfer from Western Illinois, is third on the team in scoring (11.0 ppg) and leads the team in three-pointers made (75) and three-point percentage (42%). Sophomore Scott VanderMeer, a transfer from Bowling Green, leads the Horizon League and ranks among the top 10 nationally in blocked shots per game (3.4) while he is third on the team in rebounding (5.5 rpg). Lastly, true freshman Spencer Stewart is UIC's leader in assists (3.2 apg) and is averaging 5.2 points and 2.6 rebounds per outing.

HITTING THREES NOTHING NEW TO T.J.:

While his three-point prowess might seem new to UIC fans, the ability to connect from downtown is old hat to T.J. Gray and Division I opponents. During Gray's first two seasons at Western Illinois, the 5-foot-9 guard connected on 111 three-pointers and shot 39 percent from behind the arc. Combining his two years with the Leathernecks and his first 27 games with the Flames, Gray is 186-for-465 (40%) from three-point range and owns 762 career Division I points.

2006-07 UIC FLAMES MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

SINGLE-GAME SWAT LEADER:

Sophomore Scott VanderMeer, a 6-foot-11 center, tied the UIC single-game record with nine blocked shots against Cleveland State on Jan. 27. The nine swats equaled the mark set by former Flames great Sherell Ford, who tabbed nine blocks against the Vikings on Feb. 28, 1994.

FINDING THE RIGHT COMBINATION:

UIC has used 11 different starting lineups through the first 26 games this season. Othys Jeffers and Jovan Stefanov are the only two players to start in every game this season. Of the Flames' nine active players, only Jovan Ignjatovic and Ebenezer Noonoo have not made at least one start this year.

COOMES COMES WITH EXPERIENCE:

Coach Mark Coomes, who will take the reins of the Flames during Collins' absence, is not without head coaching experience with two stints at Wabash Valley College and a year at Southern Indiana as the program's headmaster. Prior to his arrival at UIC, Coomes was the head coach at Wabash Valley College in Mt. Carmel, Ill., for two seasons. Coomes compiled an impressive record of 64-6 at WVC during that span. During the 1995-96 campaign, the team went 34-3 and finished fifth in the country.

EARLY SIGNEES:

Robert Kreps (Guard, 6-0, Maroa-Forsyth HS)

Illinois Class A All-State First Team guard Robert Kreps signed a National Letter of Intent with UIC on Nov. 9. The 6-foot sharp-shooter averaged over 19 points and four rebounds per game for Maroa-Forsyth last year, leading the Trojans to a 31-3 record and third-place finish in the state tournament. The future Flame was also a football star for the Trojans, topping the 1,500-yard plateau as a wide receiver to lead his team to a state title.

Tori Boyd (Guard/Forward, 6-5, Rockford Boylan HS)

Tori Boyd, a highly-touted senior at Rockford Boylan HS, signed a National Letter of Intent with UIC on Nov. 14. The 6-foot-5 wing was an All-NIC9 honoree last season, leading the Titans to a conference title, averaging 13.5 points and 6.4 rebounds per game.

UIC HEAD COACH

Jimmy Collins

(172-155, 11th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 11th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 172 career wins, but is also the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last five years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
