* **Quick Notes:** UIC and Butler conclude their respective regular seasons on Saturday afternoon at Hinkle Fieldhouse...The Flames are still striving for the third seed in the upcoming Horizon League Tournament, but need a win versus the Bulldogs and a Detroit loss to Youngstown State to earn the tournament's final opening-round bye...UIC has won its last four meetings with Butler, including a 65-56 victory in its last trip to Hinkle Fieldhouse for last season's league tournament semifinals...UIC is averaging 79.4 points per game in its last five contests, but runs into the league's top-rated defense on Saturday in Butler, which allows just 60.2 points per game...Senior Cedrick Banks netted a career-high 39 points in his last outing versus Wright State and now needs one point to tie and two points to pass former Flame Kenny Williams (2,025) for the UIC career scoring record...Banks, who leads the Horizon League in scoring (18.0 ppg), is averaging 26.2 points and 5.2 rebounds in his last five games...The Flames are 2-0 since moving to their three-guard lineup of Banks, Karl White and Rocky Collum...UIC is 13-0 this season when owning the lead with 5:00 minutes left in the game.

BUTLER NOTES:

Butler plays its final regular-season home game of the 2004-05 season on Saturday afternoon, entering with a 12-14 record and 6-9 mark in Horizon League play. The Bulldogs are 9-4 this year at Hinkle Fieldhouse. Butler has won its last two games with a non-conference victory over Valparaiso last Saturday, before a road win at Youngstown State on Thursday night. On the floor, the Bulldogs have been led this season by junior Brandon Polk, who is one of four players averaging in double figures. The 6-foot-6 junior is averaging 12.7 points and 4.4 rebounds per game, which are both team highs. Butler is always a threat from behind the arc, having converted 207 triples as a team this season. Guard Bruce Horan leads the Bulldogs with 77 three-pointers made while converting 41% of his attempts from downtown. Butler ranks first in the Horizon League in team defense, allowing just 60.2 points per game.

UIC vs. BUTLER - SERIES NOTES:

- * Saturday's contest is the 29th all-time meeting between UIC and Butler with the Bulldogs owning an 18-10 lead in the series.
- * UIC has won the last four confrontations with Butler, after the Bulldogs had claimed the 10 prior meetings before last season.
- * The Flames knocked the Bulldogs out of the 2004 Horizon League Tournament with a 65-56 victory at Hinkle Fieldhouse in the semifinal round, one of two UIC triumphs in the historic venue last season.
- * UIC is 3-10 all-time at Hinkle Fieldhouse.

LAST TIME WE MET:

UIC 73, Butler 49

January 29, 2005 * UIC Pavilion

UIC enjoyed its best shooting night of the season and hounded visiting Butler on the defensive end en route to a 73-49 triumph over the Bulldogs at the Pavilion. The Flames were red-hot from the field, netting a season-high 67% of its overall attempts and 50% of its three-point shots. UIC was just as strong on the defensive end, forcing Butler into a season-high 17 turnovers, which turned into 22 points for the Flames. UIC also limited the Bulldogs to just 18 points in the second half on 25% shooting. Junior guard Rocky Collum sparked UIC's strong performance with a career-high 20 points, seven assists and three steals. The Racine, Wis., native did not commit a turnover and was 7-for-9 from the field, including five three-pointers. Senior Armond Williams (15 points) and sophomore Jovan Stefanov (12 points) were also in double figures for the Flames. Junior Bruce Horan paced the Bulldogs with 18 points.

BANKS AT BUTLER:

UIC senior Cedrick Banks has found the shooting background to his liking in Hinkle Fieldhouse as he is averaging 18.5 points while shooting 44% from the field and 46% from three-point range in his four prior games in the venue. Last season, Banks tallied 22 points in both of his contests at Hinkle Fieldhouse and was 10-for-18 (56%) from behind the arc in those games.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE FLAMES:

UIC 81, Wright State 68

February 23, 2005 * UIC Pavilion

UIC senior guard Cedrick Banks wanted to put on a show for the Flames' faithful in his final regular-season game against Wright State at the UIC Pavilion on Wednesday night. Not only did Banks score a career-high 39 points, including a career-high, and UIC Pavilion

record-tying, eight three-pointers, the Chicago, Ill., native became the third player in school history to tally over 2,000 career points, as the Flames picked up the 81-68 Horizon League victory over Wright State. UIC freshman guard Karl White posted 14 points and a career-high, 10 assists for his first career double-double. Senior forward Armond Williams led a fierce charge on the glass with a season-high, 12 boards, as the Flames out-rebounded the Raiders, 42-30, including 16 offensive. DaShaun Wood garnered a team-high, 19 points for the visiting Raiders, while teammates Drew Burleson (18 points) and Everett Spencer (10 points) each turned in solid efforts.

NOW THAT’S WHAT I CALL A SENIOR NIGHT:

Senior Cedrick Banks saved the best offensive night of his collegiate career for his last regular-season home game as he tallied a personal-best 39 points on Wednesday versus Wright State. Banks set career bests for field goals made in a game with 15 and for three-pointers made in a game with eight. His 39 points was also the second-highest, single-game total in school history, falling just four points shy of Chuck Lambert’s 43 points versus Trinity Christian on Jan. 27, 1974.

SCORING CHAMP:

After his career-high 39-point effort on Wednesday night versus Wright State, senior guard Cedrick Banks is now knocking on the door of becoming UIC’s career scoring leader. Banks, who became just the third player to surpass 2,000 career points versus the Raiders, is now just one point from tying all-time scoring leader Kenny Williams (2,025) and one field goal away from reaching the top spot.

SPEAKING OF SENIORS DOING WHAT THEY DO BEST:

While Cedrick Banks has led UIC in scoring each of the last three seasons, the man on the glass for the Flames during that span has been senior Armond Williams. It was no wonder then that on Wednesday night in his last regular-season home game, the 6-foot-5 forward would pull down a season-high 12 rebounds in UIC’s 13-point triumph over Wright State.

THIS KID CAN PLAY:

UIC freshman Karl White showed flashes of what the future will be like for the Flames on ‘Senior Night’ at the Pavilion on Wednesday as the 6-foot-2 guard collected his first career double-double with 14 points and a career-high 10 assists. White, who did not commit a turnover in the game, fearlessly took the ball to the basket versus the Raiders, helping him do most of his damage from the free throw line, where he went 8-for-12. For the season, White is now averaging 5.1 points and 1.5 assists per outing.

PICKING UP THE OFFENSE:

UIC has seen its scoring output jump over the last five games with the Flames averaging 79.4 point per outing during the span. UIC has topped the 80-point plateau in each of the last three games, including a season-best 92 points on Feb. 19th versus Georgia Southern. For the season, the Flames are now totaling 68.8 points per game, which is second-best in the Horizon League.

THE FLAMES WERE IN THE GIVING MOOD VERSUS WRIGHT STATE:

UIC set a season-high as a team on Wednesday versus Wright State with 26 assists on 29 made baskets in an 81-68 triumph over the Raiders. Freshman Karl White led the way for the Flames with a career-high 10 helpers without committing a turnover. All in all, UIC turned the ball over just eight times.

BANKS AND WILLIAMS, UIC’S WINNINGEST PLAYERS EVER:

UIC will watch two of the most successful players in the history of the program play their final regular-season game on Saturday afternoon versus Butler. Senior Cedrick Banks and Armond Williams are the two winningest players in school history, helping the Flames to 79 victories since they first stepped on the hardwood in 2001-02. The duo has brought to UIC a pair of Horizon League Tournament titles, two NCAA Tournament bids and one berth in the NIT.

QUEST FOR THE FINAL BYE:

With the top two seeds in the upcoming Horizon League Tournament already secured by UW-Milwaukee and UW-Green Bay, UIC heads into the final game still with a chance at claiming third place and a first-round tournament bye. The Flames also could still finish in the fourth or fifth position depending on the outcome of the final weekend of play. In order for UIC to finish third and avoid a first round game on Tuesday, the Flames must win at Butler on Saturday and then have Youngstown defeat Detroit in the Motor City.

THE THREE-GUARD COMBO SEEMS TO BE WORKING:

UIC is undefeated in its last two games when it starts its three-guard rotation with Cedrick Banks, Rocky Collum and Karl White getting the nod with the first five. The Flames' offense has picked up with the team averaging 86.5 points per game in those outings with all three of the guards averaging in double figures.

JUSTIN TIME:

Junior Justin Bowen has played effectively both as a starter and a reserve for the Flames of late, averaging 11.4 points and 7.2 rebounds while shooting 58% from the field in his last four games. The 6-foot-7 forward proved to be UIC's spark off the bench in Saturday's win over Georgia Southern on Feb. 19th, tallying a career-high tying 18 points and pulling down nine rebounds in just 22 minutes of action. For the season, Bowen is now averaging 8.0 points per outing while he is second on the team in rebounding with 5.8 caroms per game.

BANKS CATCHING FIRE DOWN THE STRETCH:

Senior Cedrick Banks has taken his game to another level the last five games. The 6-foot-2 guard is averaging 26.2 points, 6.0 rebounds and 5.2 rebounds per outing during the stretch. He has five straight 20-plus scoring games, including a career-high 39 points versus Wright State on Wednesday night.

FINDING A LINEUP THAT WORKS:

UIC used its eighth different starting lineup this season on Wednesday night with its three seniors, Cedrick Banks (g), Armond Williams (f) and Josip Petrusic, joining Rocky Collum (g) and Karl White (g) in the first five. Of the eight players who have been starters this season, only Banks has now started in all 26 games for the Flames.

KEEPING THEM UNDER 70 IS THE KEY:

Keeping its opponent under 70 has proven to be the key to victory for UIC this season as the Flames are 1-9 when teams top the 70-point plateau. UIC is 13-3 when opponents score less than 70 points.

BANKS CAN PLAY ALL DAY, AND HE HAS:

UIC has counted on senior Cedrick Banks to log heavy minutes this season, and the senior has, logging a Horizon League-best 37.8 minutes per game. Banks has gone the entire way 11 times this year and has played in all but 55 of 1040 possible minutes of action.

BANKS AND WILLIAMS RATE AMONG HORIZON LEAGUE'S CAREER ACTIVE BEST:

Seniors Cedrick Banks and Armond Williams both find themselves among the active career leaders in the Horizon League record book. Banks is the active career leader in scoring (2,024) and three-pointers made (247) while Williams rates first in rebounds (683) and steals (166) while he is second to only Banks in scoring (1,205).

THE SCOREBOARD WITH 5:00 LEFT IN THE GAME TELLS THE STORY:

UIC is 13-0 this season when they are in the lead at the five-minute mark of the second half and 1-11 when trailing at that time.

HIS HALFS MAKE A WHOLE:

Many players never reach 20 points in a game during a season. But with his 23-point first-half outburst versus Wright State on Wednesday night, UIC senior guard Cedrick Banks has now scored 20 or more points in a single half on 13 occasions during his career and four times this season. Banks finished the contest versus the Raiders with a career-high 39 points.

ARMOND MAKES HISTORY:

Senior forward Armond Williams etched out his own spot in the UIC record books on Jan. 22nd at UW-Green Bay. With his two steals versus the Phoenix, Williams is now the only player in school history to have reached or surpassed 1,000 points, 600 rebounds and 150 steals in a career. In 117 games, Williams now owns 1,205 points, 683 rebounds and 166 steals. He ranks in the top 10 all-time in rebounds (7th) and steals (4th) while he ranks 12th on the school's all-time scoring list.

BANKS LOOKING TO MAKE HISTORY OF HIS OWN:

UIC senior Cedrick Banks is on pace to become the first player in school history to lead the team in scoring in each of his four seasons with the team. Former Flames Mark Miller and John Ellis were the only past three-time scoring leaders before Banks.

COLLINS UIC'S CAREER COACHING LEADER:

UIC headmaster Jimmy Collins became the program's all-time winningest coach on Sunday, Dec. 12th, with the Flames' 76-67 victory at UNC Wilmington. It was career win No. 134 for Collins, pushing him past Bob Hallberg (1987-96). In his ninth season as head coach, Collins now owns an overall record of 144-120.

**UIC HEAD COACH
Jimmy Collins
(145-120, 9th season)**

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his ninth season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor has compiled a current record of 145-120 making him the program's all-time winningest coach. Collins collected career win No. 134, which pushed him past former headmaster Bob Hallberg (1987-96) for the top spot, on Dec. 12th at UNC Wilmington.

He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three straight 20-win seasons, including a school record 24 victories last year.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his eight years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 145 career victories.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins has posted a record of 86-33 (.723) at home during his career at UIC.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.

Not only did Banks score a career-high 39 points, including a career-high, and UIC Pavilion record-tying, eight three-pointers, the Chicago, Ill., native became the third player in school-history to tally over 2,000 career-points, as the Flames picked up the 81-68 Horizon League victory over the Raiders, keeping their hopes alive for a third-place finish in the conference race.

UW-Parkside's Gareth Malkowski previously set the Pavilion record of eight three-pointers on Dec. 21, 2004. Banks' 15 field goals also was the second-most for a single game, tying both Andrew White (Niles College, Dec. 3, 1977), Andrew Cooper (Missouri-St. Louis, Jan. 11, 1980) and Eric Longino (Valparaiso, Jan. 9, 1986).

With his 15th point of the game at the 9:25 mark of the first half, Banks hit the 2,000 point mark for his career, joining both Sherell Ford and Kenny Williams amongst the Flames' elite. Banks needs two more points to pass Williams for the most career points scored in school history with 2,026 tallies.

UIC freshman guard Karl White posted 14 points and a career-high, 10 assists for his first career, double-double. Senior forward Armond Williams led a fierce charge on the glass with a season-high, 12 boards, as the Flames out-rebounded the Raiders, 42-30, including 16 offensive.

DaShaun Wood garnered a team-high, 19 points for the visiting Raiders, while teammates Drew Burleson (18 points) and Everett Spencer (10 points) each turned in solid efforts.
