*Quick Notes: The UIC men's basketball team plays its final regular-season game away from home and wraps up a three-game road trip at Cleveland State on Wednesday night...The Flames are looking for a split of the season series with the Vikings after Cleveland State bested UIC, 87-83, back on Jan. 19th at the Pavilion...The Flames have won their last three league road games with victories at Wright State, Youngstown State and UW-Milwaukee...UIC freshman Josh Mayo has been pacing the team's attack of late, averaging 16.6 points while shooting 60% from the field and 61% from three-point range in his last five games...Sophomore Othys Jeffers has recorded a double-double in three of his last four games and has totaled 10 or more rebounds in each of his last four outings...Senior Justin Bowen ranks in the top 10 in the Horizon League in scoring (15.0 ppg/10th), rebounding (7.1 rpg/6th), field goal percentage (53%/5th) and steals (1.3/9th)...UIC is 10-3 this season when its opponent scores less than 70 points...The Flames will wrap up the regular season on Saturday when they host Wright State at 3:00 p.m.

VIKING NOTES:

Cleveland State enters Wednesday night's game with a record of 10-15 and 6-9 ledger in the Horizon League. The Vikings have won their last two games, posting a road victory at Wright State and a non-conference home triumph over Delaware on Saturday. Cleveland State is still striving to secure a home game in the first round of the Horizon League Tournament and finishes the year with two home games versus the Flames and UW-Green Bay, two teams they beat on the road earlier this year. On the floor, junior Ije Nwankwo has been pacing the Vikings, averaging 11.8 points and 5.1 rebounds per game. Freshman J'Nathan Bullock is coming off a double-double effort versus Delaware on Saturday in which he totaled 17 points and 10 rebounds. Cleveland State features five players averaging eight or more points per outing.

UIC vs. CLEVELAND STATE - SERIES NOTES:

- * This is the 57th all-time meeting between Cleveland State and UIC with the Flames holding a slim 29-27 advantage in the series.
- * The Flames had a seven-game winning streak versus the Vikings snapped when Cleveland State bested the Flames, 87-83 back on Jan. 19th at the Pavilion.
- * UIC Head Coach Jimmy Collins owns a 14-9 all-time record versus Cleveland State.

LAST TIME WE MET:

Cleveland State 87, UIC 83

January 19, 2006 * UIC Pavilion

Despite career-best performances from senior Justin Bowen and freshman Josh Mayo, UIC dropped a heartbreaker to visiting Cleveland State at the Pavilion. Bowen tabbed his sixth double-double of the season in the loss, finishing with a career-high 26 points and 13 rebounds. Mayo tabbed a personal-best 22 points and five assists. Raheem Moss led five Vikings in double figures with 16 points. Cleveland State crashed the boards hard in the contest, out-rebounding UIC, 46-40, including 24 offensive rebounds which led to 27 second-chance points. UIC trailed the Vikings by two in the waning seconds and had an attempt to tie the game, but sophomore Karl White's driving lay-in rimmed out with :04 left.

LAST TIME OUT:

Murray State 72, UIC 68

February 18, 2006 * Murray, Ky.

Despite a career night from freshman Josh Mayo, UIC was unable to hold on to a lead late in the game as host Murray State rallied for a 72-68 victory on Saturday night. Mayo finished with a career-high 23 points, going 7-for-8 from the field and 5-for-5 from three-point range. Sophomore Othys Jeffers added a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds for the Flames. UIC owned a four-point advantage late in the game, but back-to-back triples by the Racers in the final two minutes proved to be the difference. The Flames out-rebounded Murray State, 37-31, and shot 50% from behind the arc in the game.

WHAT'S UP NEXT:

UIC heads home for the regular-season finale versus Wright State on Saturday, Feb. 25th, at 3:00 p.m. The Flames will honor their three seniors - Justin Bowen, Rocky Collum and Etienne Nelson - before the game. UIC bested the Raiders in Dayton earlier this season and will be looking for the series sweep in what could be an important tie-breaker with the victory.

MAYO IS ON A ROLL:

Freshman Josh Mayo is enjoying the best stretch of his collegiate career as the 5-foot-10 point guard is averaging 16.6 points, 3.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists in his last five games while shooting 60% from the field and 61% from three-point range. Mayo has scored in double digits in each of his last five outings, including back-to-back 20-plus point efforts in his last two games.

JEFFERS IS RACKING UP THE DOUBLE-DOUBLES:

Sophomore Othys Jeffers totaled his third double-double in the last four games on Saturday with a 13-point, 10-rebound effort at Murray State. Jeffers is now tied for the team lead with seven double-doubles this season. His other two double-dips during his most recent string came in wins over Detroit and UW-Milwaukee.

CAREER NIGHT FOR MAYO:

Freshman Josh Mayo enjoyed the best shooting night of his collegiate career on Saturday at Murray State. The 5-foot-10 point guard finished with a career-best 23 points, netting 7-of-8 field goal attempts and going a perfect 5-for-5 from three-point range. Mayo has now converted eight of his last nine shots from behind the arc.

ZORIC LIKES IT ON THE ROAD BETTER:

Junior Danijel Zoric must like life on the road as the 6-foot-9 post has fared much better this season away from the UIC Pavilion. In the Flames' 12 road games this year, Zoric is averaging 8.8 points and 4.2 rebounds while shooting 54% from the field. In the team's 12 home contests, Zoric is averaging just 4.1 points and 2.5 rebounds while shooting 37% from the floor. Six of Zoric's top-seven scoring efforts this season have come on the road and he has only scored in double figures at the Pavilion one time, a 12-point effort versus UW-Green Bay on Jan. 28th. Zoric is averaging 14.0 points and 3.5 rebounds in the first two games of UIC's three-game road trip.

CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARDS:

Sophomore Othys Jeffers has been dominating the glass, averaging 10.3 rebounds per contest in his last four games. Jeffers, who leads the Flames with 7.8 rpg, has tallied 10 or more rebounds in each of the four outings and is the first UIC player to record four straight double-digit rebounding games since Maurice Brown during the 2000-01 campaign. Jeffers has also been scoring of late as well, averaging 13.8 points in the last four outings.

JUSTIN TIME:

Senior Justin Bowen is enjoying a standout final campaign for the Flames this season, leading the team in scoring (15.0 ppg) and field goal percentage (53%), and rating second in rebounding (7.1 rpg), while ranking in the top 10 in the Horizon League in each category. Bowen, who entered the year with career averages of 5.9 ppg and 4.1 rpg, has scored in double-figures in 21 of his 27 games played and has seven double-doubles this season, including a 26-point, 10-rebound effort on Jan. 28th versus UW-Green Bay.

A SUPER SIXTH MAN:

Sophomore Kevin Bond has given UIC an offensive boost off the bench of late, earning him the nod as top sixth-man for the Flames. The 6-foot-5 wing, who dropped in 10 points in the team's win over UW-Milwaukee on Feb. 15th, is averaging 8.4 points and shooting 50% from the field in his last seven games. Bond, who has tabbed three double-figure outings during the stretch, is now totaling 5.1 points per game this season while shooting 48% from the field and 39% from three-point range.

JOVAN HAS GOT IT GOING ON:

Junior Jovan Stefanov has raised his game in UIC's last five outings, averaging 11.2 points, 7.6 rebounds and 3.6 assists during the stretch while shooting 47% from the field. Stefanov has now moved up to fourth on the team in scoring (7.3 ppg) and third in rebounding (5.4 rpg) and assists (2.2 apg).

PLENTY OF CLOSE GAMES:

UIC has had more than its fair share of nail-biters this season. UIC has already played five overtime games, had four contests decided by a single point and 10 decisions by five points or less after a 72-68 setback at Murray State on Saturday. The Flames are 3-2 in overtime games and 4-6 in games decided by five points or less.

JEFFERS MAKING A BID FOR TOP NEWCOMER HONORS:

Sophomore Othys Jeffers has had an impressive start to his UIC career as he currently leads the team in rebounding (7.8 rpg), assists (2.9 apg) and blocks (0.7 bpg) while ranking second in scoring (11.7 ppg) and field goal percentage (49%). The 6-foot-5 forward, who owns seven double-doubles this season, recorded 13 points and 10 rebounds at Murray State in his last outing.

FOREIGN FLAVOR:

Serbia & Montenegro natives Danijel Zoric and Jovan Stefanov, both 6-foot-9 junior forwards, have provided a strong one-two punch for the Flames in their last eight games, combining for 21.9 points, 10.4 rebounds and 4.3 assists per outing.

FAB FROSH:

UIC freshman Josh Mayo has played beyond his years to start his collegiate career. The Merrillville, Ind., native took over the starting spot at point guard 23 games ago and hasn't looked back. Mayo, who has scored in double figures 15 times this year, currently rates third on the team in scoring at 10.3 points per game and is second on the team in assists (2.7 apg). Mayo also ranks first on the team in free throw shooting at 84% while he tops the squad in three-pointers made with 44.

NOT YOUR EVERY DAY ASSIST MAN:

Sophomore forward Othys Jeffers is not only the Flames' leading rebounder at 7.8 rpg, but also leads the team in assists at 2.9 per outing. The 6-foot-5 forward has tabbed a career-high seven assists on two occasions this season and has had five or more assists in five outings. The last player to lead UIC in both rebounding and assists in the same year was Shawn Harlan during the 1995-96 campaign.

DAN IS THE MAN:

Junior Danijel Zoric, who collected 12 points at Murray State on Saturday night, has been coming on the second half of the season for the Flames, averaging 11.3 points and 4.1 rebounds in his last eight games while shooting 50% from the field. Zoric has seen his minutes go way up accordingly, playing almost 32 minutes per contest during his recent hot stretch.

PASSING THEIR BOARDS:

UIC has hit the boards hard thus far in 2005-06, pulling down 36.8 rebounds per game while owning a +4.5 rebounding margin. The Flames have out-rebounded their opponent in 22 of their 27 games this year and have snagged at least 15 offensive caroms in 12 outings. Sophomore Othys Jeffers leads the team in rebounding at 7.8 rpg while senior Justin Bowen is right behind him at 7.1 rpg.

COMEBACK KIDS:

UIC's comeback from 15 points down in the second half in its victory over Wright State on Jan. 25th was the largest deficit overcome by the Flames in a win this season. UIC's prior top comeback was against Ole Miss, when the Flames erased a 12-point deficit in the second half en route to an 87-75 overtime triumph over the Rebels.

DID YOU KNOW:

UIC has 13 wins this season, but has only been in the lead with 5:00 left in the game on five occasions. The Flames have been tied at the five-minute mark five times, winning all five, and have erased a deficit in the final five minutes on four occasions as well. UIC is 4-2 when leading with five minutes remaining.

FINDING THE RIGHT ROTATION:

Through its 27 games this season, UIC has used eight different starting lineups. UIC has used its most recent starting lineup (Mayo, Jeffers, Bowen, Stefanov, Zoric) in nine games with the group going 5-4. Sophomore Othys Jeffers is the only Flame to start in all 27 games this season.

SUCCESS IN THE NON-CONFERENCE SLATE THIS SEASON:

UIC recorded a pair of firsts during its non-conference schedule earlier this season with the program's first-ever wins over an Atlantic Coast Conference and Southeastern Conference opponent. The Flames disposed of Georgia Tech in Atlanta, 73-51, back on Nov. 25th and then rallied past Mississippi in overtime, 87-75, on Dec. 10th. UIC added another impressive win to its resume on Dec. 14th with a 71-62 triumph at Northwestern. The

Flames are the only team in the country that can boast non-conference wins over teams from the ACC, SEC and Big Ten this season. The Flames also bested preseason favorites from the Big Sky (Montana State), Mountain West (San Diego State) and Southern Conference (Davidson) during non-league play.

NEW YEAR'S EVE DISHES:

UIC was in the giving mood on New Year's Eve versus Youngstown State as the Flames dished out a season-high 26 assists in their overtime triumph over the Penguins. The 26 helpers were the most dished out by any team in the Horizon League in a single game this season. Freshman Josh Mayo and sophomore Karl White each dished out seven assists to lead the team while eight different UIC players tabbed at least one assist.

FLAMES SIGN A PAIR FOR 2006-07:

UIC inked a pair of players this fall for the 2006-07 season as Edwardsville, Ill., guard Spencer Stewart and Houston-area forward Jonathan Blake signed National Letters of Intent with the Flames. Stewart, 6-foot-4, garnered All-State honors last season at Edwardsville High School, averaging 9.4 points, 9.1 assists, 7.8 rebounds and 3.8 steals per game for the Tigers. Blake, 6-foot-5, was an All-District performer at Cypress Springs High School, totaling 13.6 points and 6.0 rebounds per contest.

JEFFERS COMES WITH A UIC PEDIGREE:

Newcomer Othys Jeffers, who sat out last season while attending UIC after playing one year of junior college basketball, has a family legacy with the Flames basketball program, as he is the cousin of former standout Mark Miller. With his permission, Jeffers will don Miller's No. 12 jersey, which was retired by UIC in 2000. Jeffers is a product of Hubbard HS and averaged 22.3 points and 10.8 rebounds per contest back in 2003-04 at Los Angeles Southwest CC.

THE 70-POINT MARK IS KEY:

The 70-point mark has proven to be the make-or-break point for the Flames this season. UIC is 10-3 when limiting the opposition to less than 70 points and 3-11 when its opponent breaks the 70-point barrier.

POOLE CLOSED FOR THE SEASON

UIC senior Elliott Poole was declared academically ineligible for the remainder of the 2005-06 season on Jan 6th. The 6-foot-7 forward was averaging 7.3 points and 4.4 rebounds for the Flames. Poole has exhausted all of eligibility thus ending his playing career at UIC.

UIC HEAD COACH Jimmy Collins (159-137, 10th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 10th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 159 career wins, but is also now the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last four years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 159 career victories.

- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
