\*Quick Notes: The UIC men's basketball team looks to snap a four-game losing streak on Thursday as the Flames return home to take on Cleveland State...Losing streaks are quite uncommon for UIC as the recent four-game slide is the longest since the 2000-01 season...UIC has won the last seven meetings with Cleveland State and owns a 29-26 advantage in the all-time series...The Flames and Vikings last locked horns in the opening round of the 2005 Horizon League Tournament with UIC besting Cleveland State 84-65 at the Pavilion...The Flames' average margin of victory over the Vikings in the last seven meetings is 12.3 points...UIC junior Danijel Zoric is averaging 11.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in his last two games...Senior Justin Bowen ranks in the top 10 in the Horizon League in both scoring (15.4 ppg) and rebounding (7.3 rpg)...Freshman Josh Mayo is the Horizon League's top free throw shooter (89%)...The Flames are 5-0 this season when committing fewer turnovers than their opponent...UIC will be back on the road this weekend with a Saturday afternoon contest at Detroit.

#### VIKING NOTES:

Cleveland State heads to the Windy City after having its two-game winning streak snapped on Monday night with a non-conference home loss to Akron. The Vikings are 2-3 in the Horizon League this season with wins in their last two outings versus Detroit at home and on the road at Youngstown State. Freshman J'Nathan Bullock leads the team in scoring, averaging 10.9 points per game. Junior Raheem Moss, a preseason All-Horizon League honoree, is close behind at 10.4 ppg. Moss is the team's top three-point marksman, netting 42% of his triple attempts. Cleveland State has been searching for a solid first five as it has used seven different starting lineups through 14 games this year. Head Coach Mike Garland is in his third season at Cleveland State and is 0-5 all-time versus UIC.

#### UIC vs. CLEVELAND STATE - SERIES NOTES:

- \* This is the 56th all-time meeting between Cleveland State and UIC with the Flames holding a slim 29-26 advantage in the series.
- \* The Flames have won the last seven confrontations with the Vikings, including an 84-65 triumph in last year's opening round of the Horizon League Tournament.
- \* UIC Head Coach Jimmy Collins owns a 14-8 all-time record versus Cleveland State.

#### LAST TIME WE MET:

##### UIC 84, Cleveland State 65

##### March 1, 2005 \* UIC Pavilion \* Horizon League Tournament Opening Round

A 16-0 UIC run at the end of the first half proved to be the cushion the Flames would need as they cruised to an 84-65 victory over Cleveland State in the opening round of the Horizon League Tournament. Senior Cedrick Banks led the way for UIC with a career tournament-best 23 points, going 11-for-12 from the foul line. The Flames, who shot 52% from the field, also received strong efforts from freshmen Karl White (12 points, 4 steals) and Kevin Bond (career-high 10 points) while forwards Armond Williams and Elliott Poole combined for 20 of the Flames' 40 points in the paint versus the Vikings.

#### LAST TIME OUT:

##### Loyola 75, UIC 61

##### January 15, 2006 \* Chicago, Ill.

UIC had four players score in double figures on Sunday afternoon, but it was not enough to propel the Flames past Loyola, as the host Ramblers earned a 75-61 victory at the Gentile Center. Sophomore Karl White led UIC with a season-high 12 points off the bench. Sophomore Othyus Jeffers totaled 11 points and eight rebounds while junior Jovan Stefanov (11 points, 7 rebounds) and freshman Josh Mayo (10 points) also reached double figures in the loss. The Flames were unable to stop the one-two scoring punch of Blake Schilb and Majak Kou. The Rambler tandem combined for 48 points, shooting 20-for-33 from the field. Schilb finished with a game-high 27 points and six assists. Kou totaled 21 points, 16 of which came in the first half. Loyola owned a nine-point lead at intermission and then scored the first five points of the second half to own a 41-27 advantage. UIC would get no closer than 11 the rest of the way as the Ramblers shot 52% from the field in the contest.

#### WHAT'S UP NEXT:

UIC heads back out on the road with a trip to the Motor City on Saturday as the Flames will take on Detroit at Calihan Hall at 3:00 p.m. The Titans hold a 17-7 edge in the all-time series with UIC and the Flames will look for their first win at Calihan since a 77-74 triumph during the 2002-03 season.

**ZORIC STEPPING IT UP FOR THE FLAMES:**

Junior Danijel Zoric has stepped up his game of late, averaging 11.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in his last two outings while shooting 60% from the field. Zoric delivered his best performance of the season on Wednesday, Jan. 11th, at UW-Green Bay, coming off the bench for a career-high 17 points (6-of-10 FG) and nine rebounds in the Flames’ overtime loss to the Phoenix. The 6-foot-10 junior college transfer then tallied six points and six rebounds at Loyola on Sunday, Jan. 15th. For the season, Zoric is now averaging 4.4 points and 3.1 rebounds per game.

**PROVIDING A SPARK OFF THE BENCH:**

Sophomore Karl White came off the bench to tally a season-high 12 points at Loyola on Jan. 15th. The Flames have now had a player come off the bench to score in double figures in each of their last five games. White has accounted for two of the five, also tallying 10 points in a win over Youngstown State on Dec. 31st. For the season, UIC is getting an average of 19.2 ppg off its bench, led by White’s 4.6 ppg.

**VON TURNING IT ON:**

Junior Jovan Stefanov struggled early on this season as he battled through a badly sprained finger on his shooting hand. The 6-foot-9 forward has turned things around of late, though, averaging 7.3 points and 7.3 rebounds in his last three outings, including a season-high 11-point, seven-rebound effort at Loyola on Jan. 15th. For the season, Stefanov is averaging 6.1 points and 5.4 rebounds per game.

**EVEN OFFENSE:**

UIC’s offense has been pretty evenly distributed of late. In their last three games, the Flames have six players averaging seven or more points per game with Othys Jeffers and Justin Bowen leading the way at 11.3 ppg. UIC has had at least four players score in double figures in each of the last two games.

**JUSTIN TIME:**

Senior Justin Bowen is enjoying a standout final campaign for the Flames this season, leading the team in scoring (15.4 ppg) and ranking second in rebounding (7.3 rpg) while rating in the top 10 in the Horizon League in each category. Bowen, who entered the year with career averages of 5.9 ppg and 4.1 rpg, has scored in double-figures in 15 of his 17 games played and has a team- and Horizon League-best five double-doubles this season, including a 21-point, 11-rebound effort at Syracuse on Dec. 21st.

**JEFFERS MAKING A BID FOR TOP NEWCOMER HONORS:**

Sophomore Othys Jeffers has enjoyed an impressive start to his UIC career as he currently leads the team in rebounding (7.4 rpg), is tied for top honors in assists (2.7 apg) and field goal percentage (53%) while rating second on the squad in scoring (12.5 ppg). The 6-foot-5 forward, who owns four double-doubles this season, recorded 11 points and eight rebounds in his last outing at Loyola on Jan. 15th.

**NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP FOR BUSH:**

Sophomore Robert Bush has elevated his game as a sophomore. The 6-foot-4 guard is averaging 6.8 points and 2.0 rebounds per game while shooting 42% from the field and 35% from three-point range for the Flames this season. Bush, who averaged just one point and less than a rebound per game in limited duty as a freshman, has started in 12 games this year. On Jan. 11th at UW-Green Bay, Bush tied his career-high with 16 points, including a personal-best four three-pointers.

**FAB FROSH:**

UIC freshman Josh Mayo has played beyond his years to start his collegiate career. The Merrillville, Ind., native took over the starting spot at point guard 13 games ago and hasn’t looked back, averaging 10 points and three assists per outing as a starter. Mayo currently rates third on the team in scoring at 8.8 points per game and is tied for the team lead in assists (2.7 apg). Mayo also ranks first in the Horizon League in free throw shooting at 89% while he tops the squad in three-pointers made with 22. Two of Mayo’s best performances have come in two of UIC’s biggest wins this season as he recorded 21 points and four assists in the team’s win at Georgia Tech and then netted 11 of his 16 points in the final minute of regulation and overtime in UIC’s triumph over Ole Miss.

### PLENTY OF CLOSE GAMES:

UIC has had more than its fair share of nail-biters this season. UIC has already played four overtime games, had four contests decided by a single point and six decisions by five points or less. The Flames, who are 3-3 in games decided by five points or less and 2-2 in overtime games after their Jan. 11th extra session loss at UW-Green Bay.

### PASSING THEIR BOARDS:

UIC has hit the boards hard thus far in 2005-06, pulling down 38.1 rebounds per game while owning a +5.2 rebounding margin. The Flames have out-rebounded their opponent in 14 of their 17 games this year and have snagged at least 15 offensive caroms in eight outings. Sophomore Othylus Jeffers leads the team in rebounding at 7.4 rpg, which ranks fifth in the Horizon League. He is followed closely by senior Justin Bowen's 7.3 rpg, which rates sixth in the league.

### FINDING THE RIGHT ROTATION:

Through its first 17 games this season, UIC has used eight different starting lineups. Sophomore Othylus Jeffers is the only Flame to start in all 17 games this season.

### COACH COLLINS IS NO. 1:

Headmaster Jimmy Collins continues to add to his record as UIC's all-time winningest men's basketball coach in his 10th season with the Flames as he now boasts 154 career victories after the team's triumph over Youngstown State on Dec. 31st. Collins, who has guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances during his tenure, became the program's all-time leader in wins last season with career victory No. 134 in a road triumph at UNC Wilmington on Dec. 12th. He garnered career win No. 150 on Dec. 10, 2005 versus Mississippi.

### A SUCCESSFUL NON-CONFERENCE RUN:

UIC endured a rigorous non-league slate this season with contests against teams from the BIG EAST, Big Ten, ACC and SEC. The Flames opened the year with five games in 10 days, starting in Fairbanks, Alaska for the BP Top of the World Classic and finishing with a trip through Georgia to take on Georgia Tech and Georgia Southern. UIC is fresh off its first-ever victory over an SEC school with its win over Mississippi on Dec. 10th, and a Big Ten road triumph at Northwestern. The Flames also bested preseason favorites from the Big Sky (Montana State), Mountain West (San Diego State) and Southern Conference (Davidson) during non-league play.

### ACC...CHECK...SEC...CHECK...BIG TEN...CHECK:

UIC recorded a pair of firsts already this season with the program's first-ever wins over an Atlantic Coast Conference and Southeastern Conference opponent. The Flames disposed of Georgia Tech in Atlanta, 73-51, back on Nov. 25th and then rallied past Mississippi in overtime, 87-75, on Dec. 10th. UIC added another impressive win to its resume on Dec. 14th with a 71-62 triumph at Northwestern. The Flames are the only team in the country that can boast non-conference wins over teams from the ACC, SEC and Big Ten this season.

### PAINT PRODUCTION:

UIC has been effective scoring down low this season with 46% of its total points being scored in the paint. The Flames, who average 67.8 points per game, are scoring 31.5 per outing in the paint. UIC has scored at least 32 points in the paint in 10 of its last 11 games.

### FLAMES SIGN A PAIR FOR 2006-07:

UIC inked a pair of players this fall for the 2006-07 season as Edwardsville, Ill., guard Spencer Stewart and Houston-area forward Jonathan Blake signed National Letters of Intent with the Flames. Stewart, 6-foot-4, garnered All-State honors last season at Edwardsville High School, averaging 9.4 points, 9.1 assists, 7.8 rebounds and 3.8 steals per game for the Tigers. Blake, 6-foot-5, was an All-District performer at Cypress Springs High School, totaling 13.6 points and 6.0 rebounds per contest.

### NO TROUBLE TABBING DOUBLE-DOUBLES:

UIC forwards Justin Bowen and Othyus Jeffers have combined for nine double-doubles through the first 17 games of the 2005-06 season. Bowen leads the Horizon League with five this season while Jeffers has tabbed four double-dips. The Flames totaled 12 double-doubles all of last season with Armond Williams leading the squad with four.

## UIC HEAD COACH Jimmy Collins (154-132, 10th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 10th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 154 career wins, but is also now the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last four years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

### JIMMY COLLINS FAST FACTS

- \* Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- \* In the midst of his 10th season with UIC, Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball head coach in the state of Illinois.
- \* Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- \* Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his eight years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- \* Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 154 career victories.
- \* Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- \* Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- \* Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- \* As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- \* Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- \* Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- \* Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- \* Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
