UIC and Loyola meet for just the second time in the postseason on Friday night when these two city rivals lock horns in the second round of the Horizon League Tournament...The last postseason meeting came in the 2002 tournament title game in Cleveland, Ohio, which the Flames won 62-61 in overtime on then-freshman Cedrick Banks' game-winning jumper with four seconds left...Banks is averaging 20.7 points, 5.1 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game during his career versus Loyola...These two teams split their regular-season contests with each team winning on the other's home floor...The Flames are 22-9 all-time versus the Ramblers and have won seven of the last eight meetings...UIC's offense has picked up of late, averaging over 80 points while the Flames are shooting 48% from the field as a team in their last five games...UIC is looking to become the first-ever No. 5 seed to win the Horizon League Tournament.

RAMBLER NOTES:

Fourth-seeded Loyola heads into the second round of the Horizon League Tournament as one of the hottest teams in the league with five straight wins under its belt, including a 78-75 triumph over Youngstown State in the tournament's opening round on Tuesday night. The Ramblers have shown the ability to win the close game during its recent surge with its last four victories coming by six points or less. On the floor, Loyola is paced by the one-two punch of All-Horizon First Team member, sophomore Blake Schilb, and senior guard DaJaun Gouard. Schilb leads the team in scoring (17.3 ppg), rebounding (5.5 rpg) and assists (4.2 apg). Schilb, meanwhile, has bounced back strong from a mid-season knee injury and is averaging 15.3 points per outing. Head Coach Jim Whitesell is in his first season at Loyola after a successful stint as head coach at Lewis University.

UIC vs. LOYOLA - SERIES NOTES:

- * UIC is 22-9 all-time versus Loyola.
- * The Flames have won seven of the last eight meetings with the Ramblers and 10 of the last 12 confrontations.
- * UIC Head Coach Jimmy Collins is 15-4 versus the Ramblers.
- * These two teams have met once in the postseason with the Flames downing the Ramblers, 76-75, in overtime in the 2002 Horizon League Tournament title game in Cleveland, Ohio.

BANKS VERSUS THE RAMBLERS:

UIC senior Cedrick Banks has enjoyed great success during his career versus Loyola, posting a 7-2 record in nine all-time meetings. He is averaging 20.7 points, 5.1 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game versus the Ramblers while shooting 49% from the field and three-point range. Banks' most memorable moment at UIC came versus the Ramblers, when he sank the game-winning shot with four seconds remaining to win the 2002 Horizon League Tournament Championship and send the Flames to the NCAA Tournament.

SEASON SERIES RECAPS:

UIC 64, Loyola 58

January 6, 2005 * Gentile Center

UIC erased a nine-point, second half deficit to earn its second straight victory, edging host Loyola 64-58 at the Gentile Center. The Flames trailed 50-41 with 7:10 remaining, but went on a 14-2 run over the next four minutes to take a 55-52 lead they would never relinquish. Junior Rocky Collum's insertion into the lineup seemed to ignite UIC's second half resurgence. The 5-foot-10 guard tallied all of his career-high six points and three assists down the stretch. Five straight points by Collum during the Flames' key surge helped trim the Rambler's lead to 52-50. After a Loyola turnover, he then found sophomore Jovan Stefanov

in the corner for a three-pointer that put UIC up for good. Senior Armond Williams led the Flames with 14 points, 12 of which came in the second stanza as he went 6-for-8 from the field. Stefanov finished with 13 points while Cedrick Banks added 10 for UIC, which shot 55% from the field in the final 20 minutes. The Ramblers jumped out to their nine-point advantage in the second half behind a 21-5 run of their own keyed by Blake Schilb, who tallied 11 of his game-high 19 points during the rally.

Loyola 91, UIC 85

February 17, 2005 * UIC Pavilion

UIC's run of success versus city rival Loyola came to an end as the visiting Ramblers ventured into the Pavilion and posted a 91-85 victory over the host Flames. Loyola snapped a seven-game losing streak to UIC with the win and notched their first victory at the Pavilion over the Flames since Jan. 6th, 1988, a stretch of 13 games. Senior guard DaJuan Gouard, who did not play the first time these two teams locked horns, led the way for the Ramblers with a game-high 31 points while adding seven rebounds. He was 11-for-21 from the field and sparked a solid shooting night for Loyola, which converted 53% of its attempts in the game. Senior Cedrick Banks finished with a game-high 25 points for UIC, tying his career best with six three-pointers made. Loyola also received strong efforts from Blake Schilb and Majak Kou, with both netting 16 points. After trailing most of the game, UIC took a 62-61 lead with 9:15 left on a pair of free throws by Jovan Stefanov. A 15-5 Loyola run over the next five minutes, highlighted by triples from Kou and Tom Levin, would give the Ramblers a nine-point lead they would never relinquish.

PLANTING SEEDS:

This is the fourth time the Flames have entered the league tournament as the No. 5 seed. On the other three occasions, UIC is 1-3 with the lone victory coming in the quarterfinals of the 1986 tournament.

LOOKING TO BECOME THE FIRST:

UIC is looking to become the first No. 5 seed to win the Horizon League Tournament. Over the last 25 years, only two fifth-seeded teams have advanced to the title game. Loyola was the last team to do so, reaching the championship contest in 2002, where the Ramblers fell to the sixth-seeded Flames in Cleveland, Ohio.

BANKS AND WILLIAMS ARE TOURNAMENT TESTED:

Seniors Cedrick Banks and Armond Williams are two of the most tournament-tested performers in the Horizon League. The duo has combined now to go 7-1 in Horizon League Tournament action, taking the 2002 and 2004 titles while falling in the semifinal round in 2003. Banks was the 2002 tournament MVP and is averaging 17.1 points and 5.0 rebounds per game in postseason play. Williams, meanwhile was the 2004 tournament MVP after averaging a double-double at last year's event.

JIMMY COLLINS IN THE CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT:

UIC Head Coach Jimmy Collins heads into the second round of the 2005 Horizon League Tournament with a 10-6 all-time record in conference postseason action. The Flames have advanced to the semifinals on four occasions under Collins and the championship game three times while taking home the title in 2002 and 2004.

OPENING ROUND RECAP:

#5 UIC 84, #8 Cleveland State 65 - UIC Pavilion

A 16-0 UIC run at the end of the first half proved to be the cushion the Flames would need on Tuesday night as they cruised to an 84-65 victory over Cleveland State in the opening round of the Horizon League Tournament. Senior Cedrick Banks led the way for UIC with a career tournament-best 23 points, going 11-for-12 from the foul line. The Flames, who shot 52% from the field, also received strong efforts from freshmen Karl White (12 points, 4 steals) and Kevin Bond (career-high 10 points) while forwards Armond Williams and Elliott Poole combined for 20 of the Flames' 40 points in the paint versus the Vikings.

PICKING UP THE OFFENSE:

UIC has seen its scoring output jump over the last seven games with the Flames averaging 80.4 points while shooting 48% from the floor as a team during the span. UIC has topped the 80-point plateau in each of the last five games, including a season-best 92 points on Feb. 19th versus Georgia Southern. For the season, the Flames are now totaling 69.8 points per game, which is second best in the Horizon League.

THIS KID KARL CAN PLAY:

UIC freshman Karl White made his Horizon League Tournament debut an impressive one on Tuesday night, recording 12 points, four assists and four steals in the Flames' win over Cleveland State. The Omaha, Neb., native has shown flashes of what the future will be like for UIC the last three games, averaging 12.0 points, 5.7 assists and 3.7 rebounds. For the season, White is averaging 5.5 points and 1.6 assists per game.

BANKS CATCHING FIRE DOWN THE STRETCH:

Senior Cedrick Banks has taken his game to another level the last seven games. The 6-foot-2 guard is averaging 26.0 points, 4.9 rebounds and 2.0 assists per outing during the stretch while shooting 47% from the field and 90% from the foul line. He has seven straight 20-plus scoring games, including a career-high 39 points versus Wright State on Feb. 23rd. Banks was named the Horizon League's Co-Player of the Week on Monday, after averaging 33.5 points while shooting 54% from the field in UIC's two games.

KEEPING THEM UNDER 70 IS THE KEY:

Keeping its opponent under 70 has proven to be the key to victory for UIC this season as the Flames are 1-10 when teams top the 70-point plateau. UIC is 14-3 when opponents score less than 70 points.

THE SCOREBOARD WITH 5:00 LEFT IN THE GAME TELLS THE STORY:

UIC is 14-0 this season when they are in the lead at the five-minute mark of the second half and 1-13 when trailing at that time. The only time UIC rallied from a deficit in the final five minutes was its win versus Loyola at the Gentile Center on Jan. 6th.

ALL-LEAGUE PERFORMERS:

UIC senior Cedrick Banks was named to the All-Horizon League First Team and was joined by teammate senior Armond Williams on the All-Horizon League Defensive Team as men's basketball postseason honors were handed out on Monday afternoon. This is the fourth time Banks has earned all-league recognition and the first time he has been awarded a spot on the all-defensive team. Williams, meanwhile, is now a two-time all-defensive team honoree.

SCORING CHAMP:

With his three-pointer from the right wing at the 17:42 mark of the first half versus Butler, senior Cedrick Banks became UIC's all-time leading scorer with career point No. 2,027. The 6-foot-2 guard, who finished the contest with the Bulldogs with a game-high 28 points, passed former standout Kenny Williams and now owns 2,075 career points.

ARMOND MAKES HISTORY:

Senior forward Armond Williams etched out his own spot in the UIC record books on Jan. 22nd at UW-Green Bay. With his two steals versus the Phoenix, Williams is now the only player in school history to have reached or surpassed 1,000 points, 600 rebounds and 150 steals in a career. In 117 games, Williams now owns 1,225 points, 696 rebounds and 167 steals. He ranks in the top 10 all-time in rebounds (7th) and steals (4th) while he ranks 12th on the school's all-time scoring list.

BANKS IN THE HORIZON LEAGUE RECORD BOOK:

Senior Cedrick Banks heads into the Horizon League Tournament in fifth place on the Horizon League all-time scoring list with his 2,075 career points. Banks has passed five players on the list in the last two weeks, including former Loyola star David Bailey and Xavier standout Tyrone Hill. Rashad Phillips is in fourth on the league's all-time scoring list with 2,319 points.

BANKS AND WILLIAMS, UIC'S WINNINGEST PLAYERS EVER:

Senior Cedrick Banks and Armond Williams are the two winningest players in school history, helping the Flames to 80 victories since they first stepped on the hardwood in 2001-02, an average of 20 victories per season. The duo has brought to UIC a pair of Horizon League Tournament titles, two NCAA Tournament bids and one berth in the NIT.

BANKS CAN PLAY ALL DAY, AND HE HAS:

UIC has counted on senior Cedrick Banks to log heavy minutes this season, and the senior has, logging a Horizon League-best 37.5 minutes per game. Banks has gone the entire way 11 times this year and has played in all but 68 of 1120 possible minutes of action.

FINDING A LINEUP THAT WORKS:

UIC used its eighth different starting lineup this season on Feb. 23rd versus Wright State with its three seniors, Cedrick Banks (g), Armond Williams (f) and Josip Petrusic, joining Rocky Collum (g) and Karl White (g) in the first five. Of the eight players who have been starters this season, only Banks has now started in all 26 games for the Flames.

HIS HALFS MAKE A WHOLE:

Many players never reach 20 points in a game during a season. But with his 23-point first-half outburst versus Wright State on Wednesday night, UIC senior guard Cedrick Banks has now scored 20 or more points in a single half on 13 occasions during his career and four times this season. Banks finished the contest versus the Raiders with a career-high 39 points.

BANKS MAKING HISTORY OF HIS OWN:

UIC senior Cedrick Banks is the first player in school history to lead the team in scoring in each of his four seasons with the team. Former Flames Mark Miller and John Ellis were the only past three-time scoring leaders before Banks.

COLLINS UIC'S CAREER COACHING LEADER:

UIC HEAD COACH

Jimmy Collins

(146-121, 9th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his ninth season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor has compiled a current record of 146-121 making him the program's all-time winningest coach. Collins collected career win No. 134, which pushed him past former headmaster Bob Hallberg (1987-96) for the top spot, on Dec. 12th at UNC Wilmington.

He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three straight 20-win seasons, including a school record 24 victories last year.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.

- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.

Chicago, Ill. - University of Illinois at Chicago senior guard Cedrick Banks wanted to put on a show for the Flames' faithful in his final regular-season game against Wright State at the UIC Pavilion on Wednesday night.

A show, indeed.

Not only did Banks score a career-high 39 points, including a career-high, and UIC Pavilion record-tying, eight three-pointers, the Chicago, Ill., native became the third player in school-history to tally over 2,000 career-points, as the Flames picked up the 81-68 Horizon League victory over the Raiders, keeping their hopes alive for a third-place finish in the conference race.

UW-Parkside's Gareth Malkowski previously set the Pavilion record of eight three-pointers on Dec. 21, 2004. Banks' 15 field goals also was the second-most for a single game, tying both Andrew White (Niles College, Dec. 3, 1977), Andrew Cooper (Missouri-St. Louis, Jan. 11, 1980) and Eric Longino (Valparaiso, Jan. 9, 1986).

With his 15th point of the game at the 9:25 mark of the first half, Banks hit the 2,000 point mark for his career, joining both Sherell Ford and Kenny Williams amongst the Flames' elite. Banks needs two more points to pass Williams for the most career points scored in school history with 2,026 tallies.

UIC freshman guard Karl White posted 14 points and a career-high, 10 assists for his first career, double-double. Senior forward Armond Williams led a fierce charge on the glass with a season-high, 12 boards, as the Flames out-rebounded the Raiders, 42-30, including 16 offensive.

DaShaun Wood garnered a team-high, 19 points for the visiting Raiders, while teammates Drew Burleson (18 points) and Everett Spencer (10 points) each turned in solid efforts.
