* **Quick Notes:** The UIC men's basketball team concludes a two-game road trip on Sunday afternoon at Loyola...The Flames are 22-10 all-time against the Ramblers and have won seven of the last nine meetings, including the last three at the Gentile Center...UIC is looking to avenge last year's overtime loss to Loyola in the Horizon League Tournament...Head Coach Jimmy Collins is 15-5 all-time versus the Ramblers with the 15 victories the most versus any single opponent...UIC is looking to avoid its first four-game losing streak since the 2000-01 season...This is just the third three-game losing skid the Flames have endured since the start of the 2001-02 campaign...Senior Justin Bowen paces UIC's attack as the team leader in scoring (16.0 ppg) and rebounding (7.3 rpg)...Sophomore Othys Jeffers is coming off a strong all-around game at UW-Green Bay as he totaled 12 points, 10 rebounds and a career-high seven assists in the contest...The Flames have played four overtime games this season and had six games decided by five points or less..UIC is 5-0 this season when committing fewer turnovers than its opponent.

RAMBLER NOTES:

Loyola enters Sunday afternoon's showdown with the Flames looking to snap a four-game losing streak. The Ramblers last tasted victory on Dec. 29th at Cleveland State. Loyola, which has played six of its last seven games on the road, will now play six straight at home starting with the Flames. The Ramblers feature a potent offensive attack that includes five players averaging in double figures. Junior Blake Schilb, a 2005 All-Horizon League First Team honoree, leads the team averaging 17.6 points per game. Freshmen J.R. Blount (13.1 ppg) and Leon Young (11.3 ppg), junior Majak Kou (11.2 ppg) and senior Chris Logan (10.7 ppg) are the other Ramblers in double digits while Young paces the squad on the boards at 8.1 rpg. Loyola is under the direction of Jim Whitesell, who owns a 2-1 record against UIC in his second season.

UIC vs. LOYOLA - SERIES NOTES:

- * UIC is 22-10 all-time versus Loyola.
- * The Flames have won seven of the last nine meetings with the Ramblers, including the last three meetings at the Gentile Center.
- * UIC Head Coach Jimmy Collins is 15-5 all-time versus the Ramblers, which is the most wins he owns over any single opponent.
- * These two teams have met twice in the postseason with the Flames downing the Ramblers, 76-75, in overtime in the 2002 Horizon League Tournament title game in Cleveland, Ohio, and Loyola besting UIC, 87-81, in overtime in last season's league tournament quarterfinals in Milwaukee, Wis.

LAST TIME WE MET:

Loyola 87, UIC 81 (OT)

March 4, 2005 * Milwaukee, Wis. * Horizon League Tournament Quarterfinals

Blake Schilb's career-high 39 points proved to be too much for UIC as Loyola ended the Flames' season with an 87-81 overtime victory in the second round of the Horizon League Tournament in Milwaukee, Wis. Cedrick Banks led UIC with 22 points while Elliott Poole tabbed a double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds. Justin Bowen chipped in with 12 points in defeat for the Flames. The Ramblers shot 55% from the field in the game, which made up for UIC taking 30 more shots from the field and out-rebounding Loyola by 10.

LAST TIME OUT:

UW-Green Bay 90, UIC 84 (OT)

January 11, 2006 * Green Bay, Wis.

UIC battled back from a 16-point deficit in the second half at UW-Green Bay on Jan. 11th, only to eventually fall in overtime, 90-84, to the host Phoenix. Five Flames scored in double figures in the loss, led by senior Justin Bowen's 18 points. Sophomore Othys Jeffers tabbed a double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds while also dishing out a career-high seven assists. UIC erased UW-Green Bay's lead by scoring on 14 of its final 18 possessions of regulation. Phoenix junior Ryan Evanochko proved to be the difference in overtime as he netted seven of his career-high 30 points in the extra session.

WHAT'S UP NEXT:

UIC returns home on Thursday, January 19th, to take on Cleveland State at the Pavilion at 7:00 p.m. The Flames have won the last seven games in the series with the Vikings, including an 84-65 triumph at home in the opening round of last year's Horizon League Tournament.

THE FLAMES KNOW HOW TO BOUNCE BACK:

Since the start of the 2001-02 season, UIC has lost three straight games just twice and on both occasions quickly bounced back with a significant winning streak. In 2003-04, the Flames lost three in a row in late December only to go on to win 15 of their next 17 games en route to the Horizon League Tournament title and a trip to the NCAA Tournament. Last season, the Flames dropped three straight in late December and bounced back by winning five of their next six games.

A SENIOR SENSATION:

Senior Justin Bowen is enjoying a standout final campaign for the Flames this season, leading the team in scoring (16.0 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg) while rating in the top five in the Horizon League in each category. Bowen, who entered the year with career averages of 5.9 ppg and 4.1 rpg, has scored in double-figures in 15 of his 16 games played and has a team- and Horizon League-best five double-doubles this season, including a 21-point, 11-rebound effort at Syracuse on Dec. 21st.

JEFFERS MAKING A BID FOR TOP NEWCOMER HONORS:

Sophomore Othys Jeffers has enjoyed an impressive start to his UIC career as he currently rates second on the team in scoring (12.6 ppg), rebounding (7.3 rpg) while leading the team in assists (2.7 apg), blocks (0.8 bpg) and field goal percentage (55%). The 6-foot-5 forward, who owns four double-doubles this season, just missed a triple double in his last outing, tabbing 12 points, 10 rebounds and a career-best seven assists at UW-Green Bay on Jan. 11th.

PLENTY OF CLOSE GAMES:

UIC has had more than its fair share of nail-biters this season. UIC has already played four overtime games, had four contests decided by a single point and six decisions by five points or less. The Flames, who are 3-3 in games decided by five points or less and 2-2 in overtime games after their Jan. 11th extra session loss at UW-Green Bay.

PASSING THEIR BOARDS:

UIC has hit the boards hard thus far in 2005-06, pulling down 38.2 rebounds per game while owning a +5.4 rebounding margin. The Flames have out-rebounded their opponent in 13 of their 16 games this year and have snagged at least 15 offensive caroms in eight outings. Senior Justin Bowen leads the team in rebounding at 7.6 per game and ranks fifth in the Horizon League in the category. Sophomore Othys Jeffers, who is UIC's second-leading rebounder (7.3 rpg), is also right behind Bowen with his sixth-best league ranking.

OUR MAYO IS ON A ROLL:

UIC freshman Josh Mayo, who tabbed 16 points in his last outing at UW-Green Bay, has played beyond his years to start his collegiate career. The Flames' starting point guard currently rates third on the team in scoring at 8.7 points per game and is tied for the team lead in assists (2.7 apg). Mayo also ranks first in the Horizon League in free throw shooting at 88% while he tops the squad in three-pointers made with 22. Two of Mayo's best performances have come in two of UIC's biggest wins this season as he recorded 21 points and four assists in the team's win at Georgia Tech and then netted 11 of his 16 points in the final minute of regulation and overtime in UIC's triumph over Ole Miss.

FINDING THE RIGHT ROTATION:

Through its first 15 games this season, UIC has used eight different starting lineups. The group of Josh Mayo, Othys Jeffers, Elliott Poole, Justin Bowen and Jovan Stefanov had the best results, going a perfect 3-0 as the first five on the floor. Jeffers is the only Flame to start in all 16 games this season.

COACH COLLINS IS NO. 1:

Headmaster Jimmy Collins continues to add to his record as UIC's all-time winningest men's basketball coach in his 10th season with the Flames as he now boasts 154 career victories after the team's triumph over Youngstown State on Dec. 31st. Collins, who has guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances during his tenure, became the program's all-time leader in wins last season with career victory No. 134 in a road triumph at UNC Wilmington on Dec. 12th. He garnered career win No. 150 on Dec. 10, 2005 versus Mississippi.

POOLE CLOSED FOR THE SEASON

UIC senior Elliott Poole was declared academically ineligible for the remainder of the 2005-06 season on Friday, January 6th. The 6-foot-7 forward was averaging 7.3 points and 4.4 rebounds for the Flames this year, earning the starting nod on eight occasions. Poole, whose best moment came when he scored the game-winning bucket in UIC's Horizon League Tournament championship game triumph over UW-Milwaukee in 2004, has exhausted all of eligibility thus ending his playing career at UIC.

DAN PROVED HE CAN BE THE MAN:

Junior Danijel Zoric delivered his best performance of the season on Wednesday, Jan. 11th, at UW-Green Bay, coming off the bench for a career-high 17 points (6-of-10 FG) and nine rebounds in the Flames' overtime loss to the Phoenix. The 6-foot-10 junior college transfer, who has seen his role increased with the loss of Elliott Poole, has not scored more than six points in a game since a Nov. 19th win over San Diego State in which he dropped in 13 points. For the season, Zoric is now averaging 4.3 ppg and 2.3 rpg.

ANOTHER STRONG ALL-AROUND GAME FOR JEFFERS:

Sophomore Otyhus Jeffers had another night in which he filled up the stat sheet at UW-Green Bay on Jan. 11th, finishing the contest with 12 points, 10 rebounds and a career-high seven assists. It was his fourth double-double of the year.

NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP FOR BUSH:

Sophomore Robert Bush has elevated his game as a sophomore. The 6-foot-4 guard is averaging 6.9 points and 1.9 rebounds per game while shooting 43% from the field and 35% from three-point range for the Flames this season. Bush, who averaged just one point and less than a rebound per game in limited duty as a freshman, has started in 11 games this year. On Thursday at UW-Green Bay, Bush tied his career-high with 16 points, including a personal-best four three-pointers.

A SUCCESSFUL NON-CONFERENCE RUN:

UIC endured a rigorous non-league slate this season with contests against teams from the BIG EAST, Big Ten, ACC and SEC. The Flames opened the year with five games in 10 days, starting in Fairbanks, Alaska for the BP Top of the World Classic and finishing with a trip through Georgia to take on Georgia Tech and Georgia Southern. UIC is fresh off its first-ever victory over an SEC school with its win over Mississippi on Dec. 10th, and a Big Ten road triumph at Northwestern. The Flames also bested preseason favorites from the Big Sky (Montana State), Mountain West (San Diego State) and Southern Conference (Davidson) during non-league play.

ACC...CHECK...SEC...CHECK...BIG TEN...CHECK:

UIC recorded a pair of firsts already this season with the program's first-ever wins over an Atlantic Coast Conference and Southeastern Conference opponent. The Flames disposed of Georgia Tech in Atlanta, 73-51, back on Nov. 25th and then rallied past Mississippi in overtime, 87-75, on Dec. 10th. UIC added another impressive win to its resume on Dec. 14th with a 71-62 triumph at Northwestern. The Flames are the only team in the country that can boast non-conference wins over teams from the ACC, SEC and Big Ten this season.

PAINT PRODUCTION:

UIC has been effective scoring down low this season with 46% of its total points being scored in the paint. The Flames, who average 67.2 points per game, are scoring 31.1 per outing in the paint. UIC has scored at least 32 points in the paint in nine of its last 10 games and tabbed a season-best 50 points in the paint versus Chicago State on Dec. 4th.

FLAMES SIGN A PAIR FOR 2006-07:

UIC inked a pair of players this fall for the 2006-07 season as Edwardsville, Ill., guard Spencer Stewart and Houston-area forward Jonathan Blake signed National Letters of

Intent with the Flames. Stewart, 6-foot-4, garnered All-State honors last season at Edwardsville High School, averaging 9.4 points, 9.1 assists, 7.8 rebounds and 3.8 steals per game for the Tigers. Blake, 6-foot-5, was an All-District performer at Cypress Springs High School, totaling 13.6 points and 6.0 rebounds per contest.

NOTROUBLE TABBING DOUBLE-DOUBLES:

UIC forwards Justin Bowen and Othys Jeffers have combined for nine double-doubles through the first 16 games of the 2005-06 season. Bowen leads the Horizon League with five this season while Jeffers has tabbed four double-dips. The Flames totaled 12 double-doubles all of last season with Armond Williams leading the squad with four.

JEFFERS COMES WITH A UIC PEDIGREE:

Newcomer Othys Jeffers, who sat out last season while attending UIC after playing one year of junior college basketball, has a family legacy with the Flames basketball program, as he is the cousin of former standout Mark Miller. With his permission, Jeffers will don Miller's No. 12 jersey, which was retired by UIC in 2000. Jeffers is a product of Hubbard High School and averaged 22.3 points and 10.8 rebounds per contest back in 2003-04 at Los Angeles Southwest Community College.

UIC HEAD COACH Jimmy Collins (154-131, 10th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 10th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 154 career wins, but is also now the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last four years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * In the midst of his 10th season with UIC, Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball head coach in the state of Illinois.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his eight years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 154 career victories.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
