* **Quick Notes:** The UIC men's basketball looks for its fifth win in its last six games on Saturday night when the Flames welcome Loyola to the Pavilion...The Flames are 22-11 all-time versus the Ramblers, but Loyola has won the last three meetings in the series, including a 75-61 triumph back on Jan. 15th in Rogers Park...Loyola reaching the 70-point mark will be a key to Saturday's contest as the Ramblers are 11-2 when scoring 70 or more points while UIC is 10-3 when its opponent scores less than 70...The Flames are limiting the opposition to just 62.5 points in their last five games...Loyola's one-two punch of Blake Schilb and Majak Kou have averaged a combined 39.0 points in the last four meetings with UIC...Flames sophomore Othys Jeffers is coming off one of his best outings of the season, tallying a career-high 19 points while adding 11 rebounds in a win over Detroit on Feb. 4th...Junior Jovan Stefanov is averaging 14.5 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists in his last two games...UIC is 3-0 this season in games broadcast by Comcast SportsNet Chicago and is 6-1 in games played on Saturday.

RAMBLER NOTES:

Loyola enters Saturday night's game with a record of 13-9, 5-7 in Horizon League play, and fresh off a 69-59 loss at UW-Green Bay on Wednesday. The Ramblers, who are 3-6 on the road this season, boast the league's top scoring offense, producing 72.2 points per game, and rank second in field goal percentage (.455). On the other end of the spectrum, Loyola rates last in the league in scoring defense (70.5 ppg) and is seventh in field goal percentage defense (.457). All-Horizon League guard Blake Schilb paces the Ramblers' attack, averaging 18.8 points per game while leading the team with 81 assists. Junior Majak Kou is another lethal scorer for Loyola, tallying 13.1 ppg. The duo of Schilb and Kou have been especially dangerous versus the Flames as they have combined for an average of 39.0 points in each of the last four meetings with UIC.

UIC vs. LOYOLA - SERIES NOTES:

* UIC is 22-11 all-time versus Loyola.

* The Flames have won seven of the last 10 meetings with the Ramblers, but Loyola has claimed victory in the last three games this series.

* UIC Head Coach Jimmy Collins is 15-6 all-time versus the Ramblers, which is the most wins he owns over any single opponent.

* These two teams have met twice in the postseason with the Flames downing the Ramblers, 76-75, in overtime in the 2002 Horizon League Tournament title game in Cleveland, Ohio, and Loyola besting UIC, 87-81, in overtime in last season's league tournament quarterfinals in Milwaukee, Wis.

LAST TIME WE MET:

Loyola 75, UIC 61

January 15, 2006 * Chicago, Ill.

UIC had four players score in double figures, but it was not enough to propel the Flames past Loyola, as the host Ramblers earned a 75-61 victory at the Gentile Center. Sophomore Karl White led UIC with a season-high 12 points off the bench. Sophomore Othys Jeffers totaled 11 points and eight rebounds while junior Jovan Stefanov (11 points, 7 rebounds) and freshman Josh Mayo (10 points) also reached double figures in the loss. The Flames were unable to stop the one-two scoring punch of Blake Schilb and Majak Kou. The Rambler tandem combined for 48 points, shooting 20-for-33 from the field. Schilb finished with a game-high 27 points and six assists. Kou totaled 21 points, 16 of which came in the first half. Loyola owned a nine-point lead at intermission and then scored the first five points of the second half to own a 41-27 advantage. UIC would get no closer than 11 the rest of the way as the Ramblers shot 52% from the field in the contest.

LAST TIME OUT:

UIC 63, Detroit 57

February 4, 2006 * UIC Pavilion

UIC erased a nine-point halftime deficit to earn its fourth win in the last five games with a 63-57 triumph over Detroit in front of 5,008 fans at the Pavilion. The Flames trailed 34-25 at intermission, but came out firing in the second half. A 12-2 run early in the period, capped by a three-pointer from senior Justin Bowen gave UIC the lead. Sophomore Othys Jeffers paced the Flames with his fifth double-double of the year, finishing with a career-high 19 points and 11 rebounds. Junior Jovan Stefanov added 16 points, nine rebounds and four assists while freshman Josh Mayo chipped in with 12 points, including the final six points of the game. UIC committed just six turnovers in the game and out-rebounded the Titans, 44-32, including 21 offensive rebounds.

WHAT'S UP NEXT:

UIC begins a three-game road trip by taking on rival UW-Milwaukee on Wednesday, Feb. 15th, at 7:00 p.m. The Flames are looking for their first win over the Panthers since downing UWM in the 2004 Horizon League Tournament title game at US Cellular Arena. UIC follows the tilt with the Panthers with a trip to Murray, Ky., to meet Murray State on Saturday, Feb. 18th in a non-conference game.

UIC STARTING TO COME TOGETHER:

The Flames seem to be putting it together heading down the stretch, having won four of their last five games with three weeks left in the 2005-06 regular-season. Here are a few keys to UIC's recent resurgence:

- * UIC owns a +7.2 rebounding margin in the last five games and is averaging over 14 offensive rebounds per contest.
- * The Flames have committed just 9.6 turnovers per contest in the last five games.
- * Six different players are averaging more than seven points per game in the last five outings.
- * UIC's defense is limiting teams to just 62.4 points per contest in the last five games.

VON HAS GOT IT LOCKED ON:

Junior Jovan Stefanov has taken a more prominent role in the Flames' attack of late. The 6-foot-9 junior is averaging 14.5 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists in his last two games while shooting 52% from the field. Stefanov, who tallied a season-high 16 points in last Saturday's win over Detroit, has taken 23 shots in the last two games, the most he has ever taken in a two-game stretch.

IT'S COMCASTIC:

UIC has played well for the Comcast cameras this season, as the Flames are 3-0 in games broadcast on Comcast SportsNet, including wins over Ole Miss, Northern Illinois and UW-Green Bay.

DAN IS THE MAN:

Junior Danijel Zoric, who netted a career-high 19 points in the Flames' win at Youngstown State on Feb. 2nd, has been coming on of late for the Flames, averaging 11.4 points and 4.8 rebounds in his last five games while shooting 49% from the field. Zoric has gotten to the charity stripe early and often during the stretch, taking a team-best 33 free throws in the last five games, converting 23.

CASHING IN OUR BOND:

Sophomore Kevin Bond has given UIC an offensive boost off the bench, earning him the nod as top sixth-man for the Flames. The 6-foot-5 wing is averaging 7.8 points and shooting 54% from the field and 40% from three-point range in his last five games. Bond is now totaling 4.5 points per game this season while shooting 48% from the field and 40% from three-point range.

JUSTIN TIME:

Senior Justin Bowen is enjoying a standout final campaign for the Flames this season, leading the team in scoring (15.3 ppg) and field goal percentage (53%), and rating second in rebounding (7.1 rpg), while rating in the top 10 in the Horizon League in each category. Bowen, who entered the year with career averages of 5.9 ppg and 4.1 rpg, has scored in double-figures in 19 of his 24 games played and has a team-best seven double-doubles this season, including a 26-point, 10-rebound effort on Jan. 28th versus UW-Green Bay.

JEFFERS MAKING A BID FOR TOP NEWCOMER HONORS:

Sophomore Othys Jeffers has had an impressive start to his UIC career as he currently leads the team in rebounding (7.5 rpg), assists (3.0 apg) and blocks (0.7 bpg) while ranking second in scoring (11.6 ppg) and field goal percentage (50%). The 6-foot-5 forward, who owns five double-doubles this season, recorded a career-high 19 points and 11 rebounds in last Saturday's win over Detroit.

SATURDAY HAS BEEN OUR DAY:

The Flames have found Saturday to be their most successful day this season, owning a 6-1 record on the sixth day of the week.

FOREIGN FLAVOR:

Serbia & Montenegro natives Danijel Zoric and Jovan Stefanov, both 6-foot-9 junior forwards, have provided a strong one-two punch for the Flames in their last five games, combining for 23.0 points, 10.8 rebounds and 4.6 assists per outing.

FAB FROSH:

UIC freshman Josh Mayo has played beyond his years to start his collegiate career. The Merrillville, Ind., native took over the starting spot at point guard 20 games ago and hasn't looked back. Mayo, who has scored in double figures 12 times this year, currently rates third on the team in scoring at 9.0 points per game and is second on the team in assists (2.7 apg). Mayo also ranks first on the team in free throw shooting at 84% while he tops the squad in three-pointers made with 34. Two of Mayo's best performances have come in two of UIC's biggest wins this season as he recorded 21 points and four assists in the team's win at Georgia Tech and then netted 11 of his 16 points in the final minute of regulation and overtime in UIC's triumph over Ole Miss.

NOT YOUR EVERY DAY ASSIST MAN:

Sophomore forward Othys Jeffers is not only the Flames' leading rebounder at 7.5 rpg, but also leads the team in assists at 3.0 per outing. The 6-foot-5 forward has tabbed a career-high seven assists on two occasions this season and has had five or more assists in five outings. The last player to lead UIC in both rebounding and assists in the same year was Shawn Harlan during the 1995-96 campaign.

TAKING CARE OF THE BASKETBALL:

UIC has done a great job of taking care of the basketball in the last two games, committing just an average of 6.5 turnovers per game. The Flames have committed just 13 turnovers while racking up 27 assists in wins over Youngstown State and Detroit. UIC is 7-1 when committing fewer turnovers than its opponents this year.

PASSING THEIR BOARDS:

UIC has hit the boards hard thus far in 2005-06, pulling down 36.8 rebounds per game while owning a +4.4 rebounding margin. The Flames have out-rebounded their opponent in 19 of their 24 games this year and have snagged at least 15 offensive caroms in 11 outings. Sophomore Othys Jeffers leads the team in rebounding at 7.5 rpg while senior Justin Bowen is right behind him at 7.1 rpg.

COMEBACK KIDS:

UIC's comeback from 15 points down in the second half in its victory over Wright State on Jan. 25th was the largest deficit overcome by the Flames in a win this season. UIC's prior top comeback was against Ole Miss, when the Flames erased a 12-point deficit in the second half en route to an 87-75 overtime triumph over the Rebels.

ROCKY ON THE ROAD BACK:

After overcoming numerous setbacks due to injury and illness, senior Rocky Collum is beginning to make his way back into the Flames' rotation. The 5-foot-10 guard, who averaged 8.7 ppg last year, has seen action in seven games this season and is averaging 1.7 ppg with all of but one of his made field goals coming from behind the three-point arc.

PLENTY OF CLOSE GAMES:

UIC has had more than its fair share of nail-biters this season. UIC has already played four overtime games, had four contests decided by a single point and eight decisions by five points or less after a 62-57 win over Wright State on Jan. 25th. The Flames are 2-2 in overtime games and 4-4 in games decided by five points or less.

DID YOU KNOW:

UIC has 12 wins this season, but has only been in the lead with 5:00 left in the game on five occasions. The Flames have been tied at the five-minute mark four times, winning all four, and have erased a deficit in the final five minutes on four occasions as well. UIC is 4-1 when leading with five minutes remaining.

FINDING THE RIGHT ROTATION:

Through its 24 games this season, UIC has used eight different starting lineups. UIC has used its most recent starting lineup (Mayo, Jeffers, Bowen, Stefanov, Zoric) in six games with the group going 4-2. Sophomore Othys Jeffers is the only Flame to start in all 22 games this season.

NEW YEAR'S EVE DISHES:

UIC was in the giving mood on New Year's Eve versus Youngstown State as the Flames dished out a season-high 26 assists in their overtime triumph over the Penguins. The 26 helpers were the most dished out by any team in the Horizon League in a single game this season. Freshman Josh Mayo and sophomore Karl White each dished out seven assists to lead the team while eight different UIC players tabbed at least one assist.

ACC...CHECK...SEC...CHECK...BIG TEN...CHECK:

UIC recorded a pair of firsts already this season with the program's first-ever wins over an Atlantic Coast Conference and Southeastern Conference opponent. The Flames disposed of Georgia Tech in Atlanta, 73-51, back on Nov. 25th and then rallied past Mississippi in overtime, 87-75, on Dec. 10th. UIC added another impressive win to its resume on Dec. 14th with a 71-62 triumph at Northwestern. The Flames are the only team in the country that can boast non-conference wins over teams from the ACC, SEC and Big Ten this season. The Flames also bested preseason favorites from the Big Sky (Montana State), Mountain West (San Diego State) and Southern Conference (Davidson) during non-league play.

FLAMES SIGN A PAIR FOR 2006-07:

UIC inked a pair of players this fall for the 2006-07 season as Edwardsville, Ill., guard Spencer Stewart and Houston-area forward Jonathan Blake signed National Letters of Intent with the Flames. Stewart, 6-foot-4, garnered All-State honors last season at Edwardsville High School, averaging 9.4 points, 9.1 assists, 7.8 rebounds and 3.8 steals per game for the Tigers. Blake, 6-foot-5, was an All-District performer at Cypress Springs High School, totaling 13.6 points and 6.0 rebounds per contest.

JEFFERS COMES WITH A UIC PEDIGREE:

Newcomer Othyus Jeffers, who sat out last season while attending UIC after playing one year of junior college basketball, has a family legacy with the Flames basketball program, as he is the cousin of former standout Mark Miller. With his permission, Jeffers will don Miller's No. 12 jersey, which was retired by UIC in 2000. Jeffers is a product of Hubbard HS and averaged 22.3 points and 10.8 rebounds per contest back in 2003-04 at Los Angeles Southwest CC.

POOLE CLOSED FOR THE SEASON

UIC senior Elliott Poole was declared academically ineligible for the remainder of the 2005-06 season on Jan 6th. The 6-foot-7 forward was averaging 7.3 points and 4.4 rebounds for the Flames. Poole has exhausted all of eligibility thus ending his playing career at UIC.

UIC HEAD COACH Jimmy Collins (158-135, 10th season)

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his 10th season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor is not only the winningest coach in school history with 158 career wins, but is also now the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois. He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three 20-win seasons in the last four years, including a school-record 24 victories in 2003-04.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

- * Jimmy Collins was introduced as the ninth head coach in UIC history on March 27, 1996.
- * In the midst of his 10th season with UIC, Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball head coach in the state of Illinois.
- * Collins has propelled UIC to its first three NCAA Tournament bids (1998, 2002, 2004) and first NIT berth (2003) in school history.
- * Collins has led UIC to four 20-win seasons in his eight years on the sidelines: 22 (1997-98); 20 (2001-02); 21 (2002-03); 24 (2003-04).
- * Collins is the program's all-time winningest coach with 158 career victories.
- * Collins has guided UIC to a league regular-season (1998) and two league tournament titles (2002, 2004) during his tenure.
- * Collins is the longest tenured Division I men's basketball coach in the state of Illinois and the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.
- * Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
- * As Illinois' top recruiter, Collins' high-profile Illini signees included: Kendall Gill, Nick Anderson, Marcus Liberty, Deon Thomas, Kiwane Garris and Lowell Hamilton.
- * Collins is the co-chairman of the Chicago Special Olympics.
- * Collins, as well as the rest of his 1970 New Mexico State Final Four squad, were inducted into the school's Hall of Fame on Feb. 7th, 2004.
- * Collins is a former first-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls (1970).
- * Collins served as a hearing officer for the Cook County Probation Department prior to his appointment as an assistant coach at Illinois.
