\* **Quick Notes:** UIC and Loyola renew their city rivalry on Thursday night when the two schools meet for the 31st time...The Flames are playing the fourth game of a grueling stretch of five games in 10 days...UIC has won the last seven meetings with Loyola with its last loss to the Ramblers coming back on Jan. 17th, 2002...The Flames have won the last 13 games versus Loyola at the Pavilion with the Ramblers' lone and last triumph coming back on Jan. 7th, 1988...UIC claimed victory when these two schools last met in early January, when the Flames rallied from a nine-point second-half deficit...The game features two players tied for third in the Horizon League in scoring in UIC's Cedrick Banks (16.5 ppg) and Loyola's Blake Schillb (16.5)...Rookie Karl White is coming off his best outing of the season with a career-high 17 points on Monday night versus UW-Green Bay...UIC is 8-0 this season when holding its opponent under 60 points...The Flames are 7-0 when keeping their opponents under 40% field goal shooting in a game.

### RAMBLER NOTES:

Loyola enters Thursday night's game with an 8-16 record with wins in two of its last three games, including an 80-61 triumph over UW-Green Bay at home on Feb. 12<sup>th</sup>. The Ramblers, who are 2-10 away from the Gentile Center this season, are looking to notch back-to-back road wins for the first time since December 2003. On the floor, Loyola is paced by All-Horizon League candidate, Blake Schilb. The 6-foot-7 sophomore is averaging a team-high 16.5 points while adding 5.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game. Schilb is shooting 49% from the floor and leads the team with 41 three-pointers made. The Ramblers have been aided by the return of senior guard DaJaun Gouard. Gouard missed the last meeting with UIC after suffering a knee injury in Loyola's contest at North Carolina on Dec. 12<sup>th</sup>. Since his return to the lineup, the Ramblers are 5-4 with Gouard averaging 15.7 points per game. Head Coach Jim Whitesell is in his first season at Loyola after a successful stint as head coach at Lewis University.

### UIC vs. LOYOLA - SERIES NOTES:

- \* UIC is 22-8 all-time versus Loyola.
- \* UIC has won the last 13 meetings with Loyola at the Pavilion, dating back to 1988.
- \* The Flames have won the last seven overall meetings with the Ramblers and 10 of the last 11 confrontations.
- \* UIC Head Coach Jimmy Collins is 15-3 versus the Ramblers.
- \* These two teams have met once in the postseason with the Flames downing the Ramblers, 76-75, in overtime in the 2002 Horizon League Tournament title game in Cleveland, Ohio.

### BANKS VERSUS THE RAMBLERS:

UIC senior Cedrick Banks has enjoyed great success during his career versus Loyola, posting a 7-1 record in eight all-time meetings. He is averaging 20.3 points, 5.3 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game versus the Ramblers while shooting 52% from the field and 51% from three-point range. Banks' most memorable moment at UIC came versus the Ramblers, when he sank the game-winning shot with four seconds remaining to win the 2002 Horizon League Tournament Championship and send the Flames to the NCAA Tournament.

### LAST TIME WE MET:

#### UIC 64, Loyola 58

#### January 6, 2005 \* Gentile Center

UIC erased a nine-point, second half deficit to earn its second straight victory, edging host Loyola 64-58 at the Gentile Center. The Flames trailed 50-41 with 7:10 remaining, but went on a 14-2 run over the next four minutes to take a 55-52 lead they would never relinquish. Junior Rocky Collum's insertion into the lineup seemed to ignite UIC's second half resurgence. Seeing his first action of the second half at the 7:10 mark, the 5-foot-10 guard tallied

all of his career-high six points and three assists down the stretch. Five straight points by Collum during the Flames' key surge helped trim the Rambler's lead to 52-50. After a Loyola turnover, he then found sophomore Jovan Stefanov in the corner for a three-pointer that put UIC up for good. Senior Armond Williams led the Flames with 14 points, 12 of which came in the second stanza as he went 6-for-8 from the field. He also snagged seven rebounds and totaled three steals. Stefanov finished with 13 points while Cedrick Banks added 10 for UIC, which shot 55% from the field in the final 20 minutes. The Ramblers jumped out to their nine-point advantage in the second half behind a 21-5 run of their own keyed by Blake Schilb, who tallied 11 of his game-high 19 points during the rally.

**LAST TIME OUT FOR THE FLAMES:**

**UW-Green Bay 78, UIC 66**

**February 14, 2005 \* UIC Pavilion**

With second-place in the Horizon League hanging in the balance, UW-Green Bay combined a potent offensive attack with a smothering defensive effort to pick up the 78-66 Horizon League victory over the Flames at the UIC Pavilion on Monday night. The Phoenix shot a torrid 55.6% (10-for-18) from three-point range on the evening, while scoring 29 points off of 16 UIC turnovers. UWGB junior forward Benito Flores led the charge for the Phoenix with a game-high 22 points on 9-for-12 shooting. The Phoenix also received impressive performances from senior guard Brandon Morris (19 points, 4 treys), Matt Rohde (16 points) and Javier Mendiburu (12 points, 13 assists, 7 rebounds). Topping UIC offensively was senior guard Cedrick Banks, who tallied 20 points on 8-for-16 shooting. Freshman guard Karl White came off the bench to score a season-high, 17 points, connecting on 7-of-12 from the field.

**QUEST FOR THE FINAL BYE:**

With the top two seeds in the upcoming Horizon League Tournament already secured by UW-Milwaukee and UW-Green Bay, UIC is looking to secure the coveted third seed in the tournament and the first round bye that accompanies it. The Flames are currently a game ahead of a pack of three teams (Cleveland State, Detroit, Wright State) for third with three league games remaining. Loyola and Butler are also both still mathematically alive for the third seed just two games in back of UIC in the loss column.

**WHITE IS GOING TO BE ALL RIGHT:**

Freshman guard Karl White had his most impressive offensive showing in a UIC uniform on Feb. 14<sup>th</sup> in the Flames, 78-66 loss to UW-Green Bay. The Omaha, Neb., native netted a career-high 17 points, going 7-for-12 from the field, in 24 minutes off the bench. White also recorded two assists, two rebounds and a steal in the contest. The game marked the fourth time in his career that White has broken into double figures in the scoring column and the first since Dec. 12<sup>th</sup> versus UW-Milwaukee. For the season, White is now averaging 4.6 points per game as a reserve.

**BANKS PASSES LOYOLA'S BAILEY TO MOVE INTO HORIZON LEAGUE SCORING TOP 10:**

Senior Cedrick Banks cracked the Horizon League's career scoring top 10 on Feb. 14<sup>th</sup> with his team-high 20 points versus UW-Green Bay. Banks, who has now tallied 1,936 points during his tenure, passed former Loyola star and his old high school teammate at Westinghouse, David Bailey for the 10<sup>th</sup> spot. He is now just 36 points behind former Saint Louis University standout Anthony Bonner for ninth on the list.

**BANKS PUTTING UP STRONG ALL-AROUND NUMBERS:**

Senior Cedrick Banks, the Horizon League Preseason Player of the Year, has lived up to his billing this season not only as a scorer, but also as a steady all-around player. Besides leading the team in scoring for the fourth straight season and ranking third in the league at 16.5 points per game, Banks also ranks in the top 20 in the league in assists (10<sup>th</sup>/2.7 apg), steals (11<sup>th</sup>/1.4 spg) and rebounding (16<sup>th</sup>/5.1 rpg).

**KEEPING THEM UNDER 70 IS THE KEY:**

Keeping its opponent under 70 has proven to be the key to victory for UIC this season as the Flames are 0-8 when teams top the 70-point plateau. UIC is 12-3 when opponents score less than 70 points.

**INDOOR POOLE:**

Junior Elliott Poole has seen his game pick up at just the right time for UIC, as the 6-foot-7 forward is averaging 14.5 points and 7.3 rebounds in his last four games. Poole is shooting 56% (22-for-39) from the field during the stretch and his 33.2 minutes per game over the

### BANKS CAN PLAY ALL DAY, AND HE HAS:

UIC has counted on senior Cedrick Banks to log heavy minutes this season, and the senior has, logging a Horizon League-best 37.9 minutes per game. Banks has gone the entire way 10 times this year and has played in all but 49 of 920 possible minutes of action.

### BOWEN STEPS IN AND STEPS UP:

With senior Armond Williams limited due to the flu, junior Justin Bowen was called upon to step into the Flames' starting lineup at Cleveland State on Feb. 12th. The 6-foot-7 forward responded with 15 points and eight rebounds in 31 minutes on the floor. Bowen also helped in limiting the Horizon League's leading scorer, Omari Westley, to just 10 points. His 15 points was the most he has tallied since a 15-point outing versus Saginaw Valley State on Dec. 23<sup>rd</sup>.

### BOND ENJOYS HIS BEST OUTING:

Redshirt freshman Kevin Bond helped UIC pick up a critical Horizon League victory on Feb. 12<sup>th</sup> at Cleveland State with his best effort of the season off the bench. The 6-foot-5 forward totaled a career-high eight points, going 4-for-6 from the field, in a personal-best 13 minutes of action.

### BANKS AND WILLIAMS RATE AMONG HORIZON LEAGUE'S CAREER ACTIVE BEST:

Seniors Cedrick Banks and Armond Williams both find themselves among the active career leaders in the Horizon League record book. Banks is the active career leader in scoring (1,936) and three-pointers made (230) while Williams rates first in rebounds (656) and steals (162) while he is second to only Banks in scoring (1,170).

### THE SCOREBOARD WITH 5:00 LEFT IN THE GAME TELLS THE STORY:

UIC is 11-0 this season when they are in the lead at the five-minute mark of the second half and 1-10 when trailing at that time.

### HIS HALFS MAKE A WHOLE:

Many players never reach 20 points in a game during a season. But with his 22-point first-half outburst at UW-Milwaukee on Feb. 5<sup>th</sup>, UIC senior guard Cedrick Banks has now scored 20 or more points in a single half on 12 occasions during his career and three times this season. Banks finished the contest versus the Panthers with a game-high 29 points.

### ARMOND MAKES HISTORY:

Senior forward Armond Williams etched out his own spot in the UIC record books on Jan.

22<sup>nd</sup> at UW-Green Bay. With his two steals versus the Phoenix, Williams is now the only player in school history to have reached or surpassed 1,000 points, 600 rebounds and 150 steals in a career. In 114 games, Williams now owns 1,170 points, 656 rebounds and 161 steals. He ranks in the top 10 all-time in rebounds (7th) and steals (4th) while he ranks 12th on the school's all-time scoring list.

#### BANKS LOOKING TO MAKE HISTORY OF HIS OWN:

UIC senior Cedrick Banks is on pace to become the first player in school history to lead the team in scoring in each of his four seasons with the team. Former Flames Mark Miller and John Ellis were the only past three-time scoring leaders before Banks.

#### COLLINS UIC'S CAREER COACHING LEADER:

UIC headmaster Jimmy Collins became the program's all-time winningest coach on Sunday, Dec. 12th, with the Flames' 76-67 victory at UNC Wilmington. It was career win No. 134 for Collins, pushing him past Bob Hallberg (1987-96). In his ninth season as head coach, Collins now owns an overall record of 143-119.

Jimmy Collins  
(143-119, 9th season)**

Head Coach Jimmy Collins is in his ninth season at the helm of the UIC men's basketball program. The veteran mentor has compiled a current record of 143-119 making him the program's all-time winningest coach. Collins collected career win No. 134, which pushed him past former headmaster Bob Hallberg (1987-96) for the top spot, on Dec. 12th at UNC Wilmington.

He has captured a conference regular season title (1998) and two league tournament crowns (2002, 2004) during his tenure, and has guided the Flames to three straight 20-win seasons, including a school record 24 victories last year.

Named co-conference coach of the year after his first season with the Flames, Collins has also guided UIC to its only three NCAA Tournament appearances in school history, taking the team to the Big Dance in 1998, 2002 and 2004. He also guided the Flames to their first-ever NIT bid in 2003.

Collins, who served as an assistant coach at Illinois for 13 years prior to his arrival at UIC, earned All-American honors as a player at New Mexico State, averaging 20.1 ppg while leading the Aggies to the Final Four during his senior season.

- \* Collins is the second-longest tenured coach in the Horizon League behind Perry Watson of Detroit.

- \* Collins was an assistant coach at the University of Illinois under Lou Henson for 13 years, including the 1989 season in which the Fighting Illini advanced to the Final Four.
